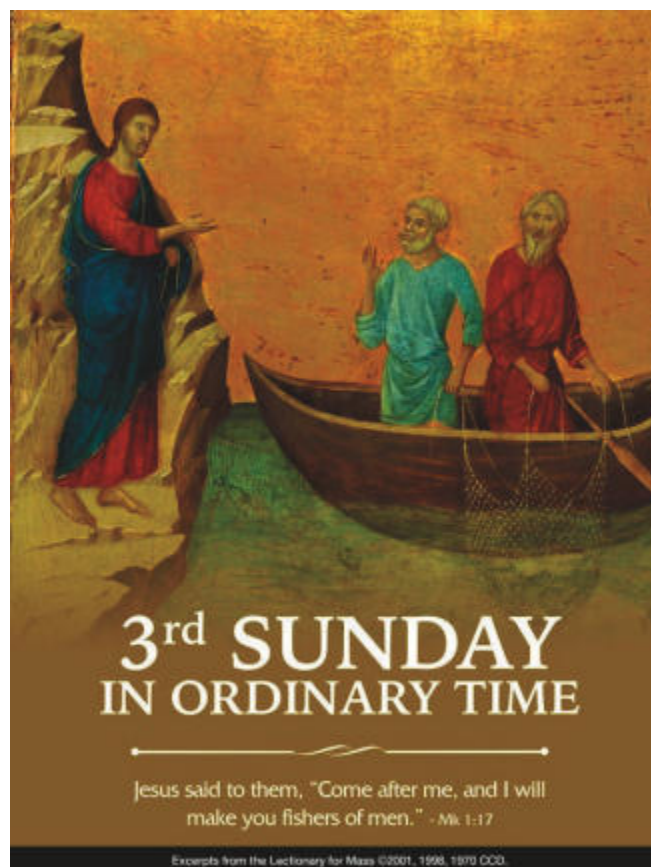

Dear Friends,

Have you ever heard your name being called, in the house or in your office, and felt tempted to pretend you were you unable to hear the call? Have you ever looked at the caller ID on your phone as it rang and decided, because of the identification of the caller, not to answer? Do you screen your calls?

I am amazed by the willingness of the disciples to hear the call of the Lord and their eagerness to drop everything and respond to the call of the Lord. They didn't say, "please hold," or pretend that they didn't hear Jesus. Jonah, too, heard the word of God and immediately set out for the great city of Nineveh to do the bidding of God. Too often we allow things to prevent us from hearing the Lord's call. Maybe we're afraid of what he might ask of us; perhaps we are too busy doing what we want to do.

I'm struck by the immediacy of the response of those being called, along with the response of the Ninevites to Jonah's call to conversion. What's getting in the way of our response to God's call? I'm sure the Ninevites were happy doing what they were doing and could have ignored the invitation. The fishermen could have said they were too busy with their daily tasks to accept Jesus as he beckoned them.

What about us? Are we being called to change our ways? Do we possess attitudes unbecoming of a child of God? Are our actions or words in need of a reality check? The call to conversion is as real today as it was in Jonah's time and the call to discipleship - intentional discipleship - rings today as it did when Jesus said, "Come follow me" to those he met on the seashore.

In today's terms it means being generous with who we are. Our time, talent and treasure belong to us but are gifts from God. It's time to forget excuses and answer the call to share them. Hear the call. Follow Jesus. Give of self. You will be happy you did.

So, the Lord continues to call us. Pope Benedict XVI challenged young seminarians from the United States with the following words. I think the words work for all of us. Hear the words of our Emeritus Pope.

"Friends, again I ask you, what about today? What are you seeking? What is God whispering to you? The hope which never disappoints is Jesus Christ. It is from within the Church that you too will find the courage and support to walk the way of the Lord. Nourished by personal prayer, prompted in silence, shaped by the Church's liturgy, you will discover the particular vocation God has for you. Embrace it with joy. You are Christ's disciples today. Shine his light upon this great city and beyond.

Show the world the reason for the hope that resonates within you. Tell others about the truth that sets you free."

The challenge for Christians today is to stop saying we are too busy to be involved in the life of the Church, in the mission of Jesus Christ. We all have busy lives, and full schedules. I encourage you to prioritize participation in the mission of Jesus as you plan your schedule in this new year. There are so many ways to get involved at Saints JFX. I was simply stunned, and continue to be, at the number of people involved in the reopening squad for our liturgies.

The Saints JFX Bereavement Ministry, a valued ministry that is the first impression many receive of our parish, seeks committed volunteers. The time commitment varies according to one's availability. The important thing is to get new ministers trained.

Next Saturday, Eva Bustamonte will offer a virtual training for those who serve and will serve in this important role. You can RSVP for the training by emailing ebustamonte@cathcemchgo.org or calling 708-236-5442. With more bereavement ministers, the number of funeral intakes can be spread out, ridding any one person of being overly burdened.

As we greet grieving families, we represent the compassionate face of Jesus and his Church. I know of many people who have joined or rejoined this community because of the compassion offered them by bereavement ministers in their time of loss. This is your opportunity to serve, to live one of the Corporal Works of Mercy.

Hear the voice. Don't ignore it. Respond immediately.

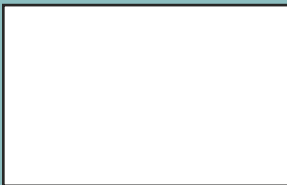

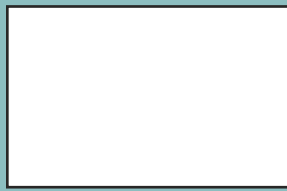
