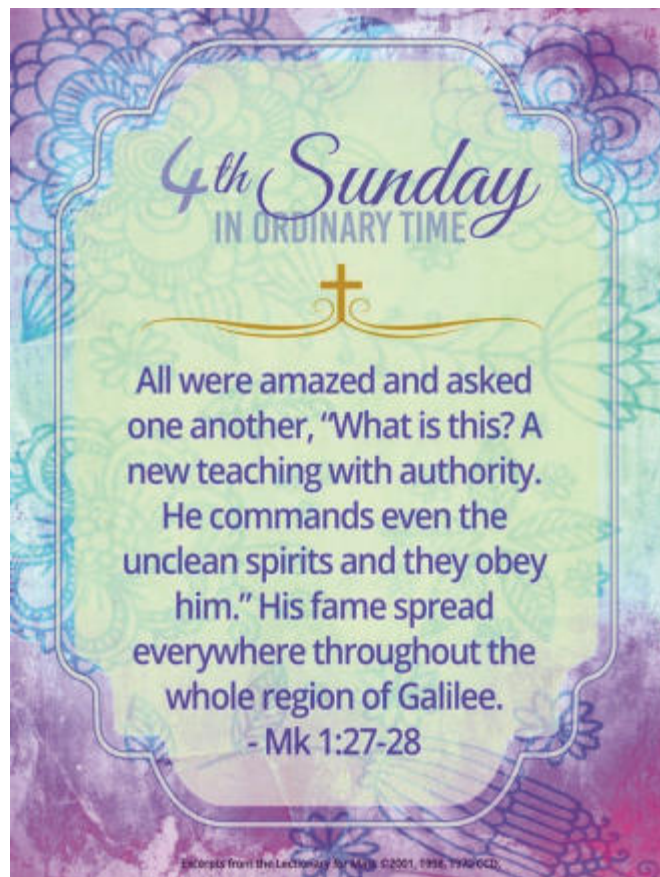

Dear Friends,

As we begin Catholic Schools week, and as we open the application process to the general public, I want to acknowledge the school staff for the great work the team does, especially in this year of pandemic. Our school continues to draw interest from many families, from Wilmette and beyond. Perhaps the news of our successful in-person learning has reached the community; maybe the enthusiasm of our school families and the great community they have built have extended to the Village of Wilmette. For whatever reason, we are growing, and demand for space in our school soon will exceed the seats available.

As I write this, we have nearly 300 students from the school community already re-enrolled, pretty good for the last-minute Wilmette crowd! Over 75 prospective families have expressed interest in joining our school community. Twelve three- and four-year-olds joined in a midyear launch of a new classroom last Monday. The news continues to spread! Great things are happening at the Schools of Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier!

Today's Psalm invites us to hear the word of God with a soft heart. The psalmist actually writes, "If today you hear God's voice, harden not your heart." I hope you listened as the cantor sang the verses, because they have a powerful message for all of us. In case the words of the verses escaped you, I print them here

*Come, let us sing joyfully to the LORD;
let us acclaim the rock of our salvation.
Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving;
let us joyfully sing psalms to him.*

*Come, let us bow down in worship;
let us kneel before the LORD who made us.
For he is our God,
and we are the people he shepherds, the flock he guides.*

What is the psalmist telling us to do? He gives us great advice on living the life of faith. He tells us to sing joyfully. Countless times our Holy Father has reminded us about the importance of living joyfully. We have reason to be joyful, but often times we run around negatively, or being just plain crabby. Pope Francis even named his first major publication *The Joy of the Gospel*. I share with you a few of his words from the Angelus talk on Sunday December 14, 2015, Gaudete Sunday – *Be Joyful Sunday*. When I read it, I saved it and return to it often. "*The human heart desires joy. We all desire joy, every family, every people aspires to happiness. But what is the joy that the Christian is called to live out and bear witness to? It is the joy that comes from the closeness of God, from his presence in our life. There is no need to look further!*"

So, let's be joyful and grateful, allowing God's voice to fall on our soft hearts, ultimately allowing the shepherd to guide us, his chosen flock.

I'm praying that every household and school family will respond generously and make a substantial pledge to this year's **Annual Catholic Appeal**. Cardinal Cupich reminds us that as Catholics in today's world, we have been entrusted with great responsibility. Responsibly and generously let's share our gifts.

The theme for this year's Annual Catholic Appeal, "Come Follow Me and Bring Hope to the World," encourages us to join the mission of Jesus; it invites us to discipleship. I have been a long supporter of the ACA; in fact, I give half of my personal yearly budgeted gift to Saints JFX via the ACA. I do it that way for a number of reasons. Ask me sometime, and I will tell you why.

Our parish goal for the ACA, 7% of our Sunday and Holy Day collections, is just under \$160,000. Anything over that amount comes back to us as a rebate. We use the rebate dollars to complete unbudgeted capital projects or to add to our capital fund. Last year's goal was \$154,000. We collected \$230,000. We used (or are using) the rebate money to complete many great capital projects over the last several months.

Happy February. Happy Catholic Schools Week! Spring is coming.
