Dear Friends,

We continue our Lenten fast. We remain committed to pray. We still call ourselves to generosity and almsgiving. If you are reading this on Sunday, you only have ten official days left in the Lenten season. I hope these final days will bear fruit for each of us. Hopefully the fruit we bear will be bolstered by the promises we hear from God in the readings of this day.

As we enter these final days, we hear one of my favorite communications from God from the Prophet Jeremiah. Jeremiah tells us what the Lord says. "I will be their God and they shall be my people." The sentiment from this line appears more than a dozen times throughout the Scriptures. The message carries both a promise and a challenge.

We are God's people. He loves us as his own. Through our shared baptism with Jesus, we are sons and daughters of God. As God's children we enjoy God's steadfast love and everlasting mercy. As God's own, we receive the benefits of God's providence. God always wants the best for us and gives us blessing after blessing. That's part of the promise of being God's people. We benefit from his untiring love in ways that sometimes we recognize and often we don't.

Secondly, that sentence from the Prophet expresses God's desire that He be our God. I think envy enters our hearts when we make other things false gods. Money, popularity, comfort, travel, good looks... I could go on and on. When we make any of these passing things our gods, we lose sight of what is important. The once popular song *Our God Is an Awesome God* expresses it plainly: "*Our God is an awesome God. He reigns from heaven above, with wisdom, power, and love. Our God is an awesome God!*"

Our triune God, the God who made heaven and Earth, the God who made covenant after covenant with His people, the one who sent His Son to live with and die for us... He *is* an awesome God! Why would we want another? Try to really measure any of the false gods against our awesome God, and they will always fall short. Once we fully admit and realize that, we can rightly claim that He is our God. Rightly making the claim requires us, then, to act accordingly, with gratitude, humility and confidence. When we have God as our God, Saint Teresa of Avila tells us, we find that we lack nothing.

Recently, I have had conversations with two different people from two different generations. Both discussed their struggles with envy. They look at what their friends and relatives have and are able to do and they measure themselves against that bar. When they determine that they don't have what others have or that they are unable to

do what others are able to do, they get jealous. Envy rules their hearts and clouds their vision. Maybe we all face envy from time to time. My constant response to people like them is to invite them to count their blessings. I do that myself when I start to compare myself with others. First and foremost, our greatest blessing is that we are God's people, God's own, God's beloved. What a blessing!



As you continue your Lenten journey, I invite you to consider what those words from the Prophet Jeremiah mean to you. Do you live as if you are God's and God is yours? If not, this homestretch of Lent is a perfect time to change. God so wants us close. He watches and waits because we are his people. He wants to place his law on our hearts. When we allow God to do so, our hearts brim with love.

The "B" year in the liturgical allows us to hear a bit more from Saint John's Gospel. Most of the time we encounter Jesus in the Gospel of John, Jesus appears strong and confident. Today's Gospel allows us to glimpse the rarely seen weak side of the Johannine Jesus. But as soon as Jesus admits being deeply troubled, the voice from above gives direction and confidence to the mission of Jesus. Jesus shows us the intimate relationship between him and the Father and the Father's response to his request. God gives us what we need.

Take the time this week to consider your own relationship with God. As we prepare to enter the holiest week of our liturgical year, ask yourself if you are ready. Let's rid ourselves from envy and anything else that will get in the way of a joyful celebration. Let's count our blessings. Make plans ahead of time to *really* mark Holy Week. There are special services Thursday April 1, Friday April 2, and Saturday April 3. Most of those have been fully subscribed. I'm working with the Archdiocese to expand the numbers of worshippers at these and other Masses and services. Plan ahead to be with us, either in person or virtually. You'll be glad you did.
