Dear Friends,

Happy Mother's Day! My mother used to say that every day is Mother's Day – she was probably right. Nevertheless, I wish mothers, godmothers and mother figures a blessed and joyful day today.

Love. The word of the day is love! As we come to church today with our mothers – or sensing that our mothers are with us in spirit – it is very appropriate that the scriptures of the day mention the word love nearly **20** times. The mentioning of love happens in two ways, as a reminder and as a command. Mothers do both too; they remind us of God's love and, by their example, command us to love one another.

Saint John tells us that love is **of** God because God is love. If we want to be **of** God, then we too must love. On this Mother's Day, I give thanks that I was blessed to have a mother who put this command into action. The way she lived her life, raised her children, taught her students, and opened her home to strangers - basically who she really was - exemplified the *love in action* that Saint John describes in today's second reading. I thank God that she showed me – albeit for only a short 18 years – what it means to be **of** the God who is love.

So today we honor all of our mothers, godmothers and mother figures, living and dead. I encourage sons and daughters to take the time to reflect on the love that they have been shown and to primarily thank God for that love shown and, as an act of gratitude, share some real Godlike love with people around us that seem to need love in a special way.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells his apostles that he has loved them in the same way that he experienced the Father's love. He also tells them to love each other – and others - in the way they experienced his love. He reminds them that they were indeed chosen and challenges them to bear lasting fruit. Whenever I proclaim those words I think of my mother's frequent admonition to her nine children (and the many others in her sphere of influence) to be charitable. In a sense she was telling us to remain in the love of Jesus. She not only told us to do that, she showed us how.

How do we remain in the love of Jesus? We remain in the love of Jesus when we keep the commandments – all of which hang on the law of love of God and neighbor. Jesus promises that if we keep his commandments and remain in his love, he will give us his joy. I have a family portrait taken in June of 1980 hanging in my sitting room. The portrait, with my then 47- and 48-year-old parents surrounded by their nine kids, tells a great story.

The back-story tells even more. When I look at the picture, I marvel at my parents. I can't imagine being in their position. The portrait was taken just weeks after my mother was diagnosed with cancer. Amidst her medical uncertainty, my mother smiled in that photo as if she were the luckiest person in earth. I think she thought she was. She lived with joy because she remained in Jesus' love. Mother Theresa once said, "Joy is a net of love by which you can catch souls." My mother had that joy, and she caught many souls. I thank God for my mother, who shared her faith, hope, joy and love with my siblings and me – and the hundreds (maybe thousands) of other young people to whom she was mother.



During the month of May, we honor Mary, Mother of God and Mother of the Church. We have three opportunities daily to gather for the Rosary - online at 7:30 and 9:30 in the morning and in the Mary Garden behind Saint Joseph Convent at 7:00 in the evening. We also will have Kevin Mathews speak to us on his journey of faith – as inspired by Our Lady and sparked by finding her broken image next to a dumpster. Kevin will join us this Thursday May 13, at 6:00 pm in the Saint Joseph School lot. We will use the great technology of the car Mass radio waves. Tune your radios to 95.7 FM.

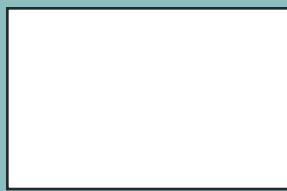
