Dear Friends,

Happy Pentecost! Today is called the Birthday of the Church. I call it the Birthday of School Leadership because 15 years ago on Pentecost Sunday, I asked a parishioner to be the principal of Saint John Berchmans School as she walked out of Mass. I said, "The Holy Spirit just told me to ask you to be my principal." She laughed and kept walking. I called her later and told her the Holy Spirit wasn't kidding, and Peggy Roketenetz assented to the Spirit's will – she is still principal there today.

When Colleen Halaburt decided to spend time at home with beautiful Molly and said she would not return next year as the principal of the Schools of Saint Joseph and Francis Xavier, we began the search to find the perfect candidate to try to fill her unfillable shoes. I asked our director of middle school Christine Elliott to throw her hat in the ring. She laughed. I told her to listen to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Almost every time we passed in the school hallway, I would sing a bar or two of "Come Holy Ghost!"

Today I am thrilled to share that, with the enthusiastic support of the Principal Search Committee, Christine Elliott will serve as Interim Principal during the 2021-2022 academic year in collaboration with Amy Butterworth as Early Childhood Director and Mia Montemurro as Assistant Principal. Christine brings unrivaled talents and a cultural awareness of our community that ensures a seamless transition into the new year. She will continue to devote focus and energy to middle school with additional supports in place to meet the needs of teachers and students.

This exciting announcement is the result of a careful, thoughtful process on the part of many. Over the past two months, a committed and talented team has been hard at work leading our search for a new school principal. I am grateful for the countless hours and conversations they have invested into this incredibly thoughtful process. As our committee shared in early May, we were pleased to welcome a recommended candidate to our campuses recently for an interview and tour. We learned immediately following this visit that our candidate would be accepting a position at another deserving Catholic school.

But the Holy Spirit works in mysterious ways.

Working along a parallel path to that of our search committee, our great school administrative team has also been reflecting on the year ahead and the diverse roles and talents of the faculty we have in place. I have been in conversation with this team especially over the past week to explore an emerging leadership structure that empowers our extremely capable and dedicated school administrators to grow and lead into the years ahead. Our Principal Search Committee agrees that this structure allows for a beautiful transition that honors our community and rewards a culture of development and investment in great need across all our Catholic schools.

I look forward to sharing more over the coming weeks about this leadership structure and how it will transition us to a new, enduring platform for future years of leading and loving your students. This strategy provides us with the gift of a new academic year to invest in the growth and development of our administrators and time to supplement our leadership team with additional hires to complement our team.

In the meantime, please join me in congratulating and *THANKING* Christine, Amy, and Mia for their bountiful gifts, and our devoted Principal Search Committee for the care and concern they have invested into this process.

I am humbled by the numerous meaningful ways our families share their gifts with the Saints JFX community. This stewardship is evident in the time and talent our parents and parishioners devote to our leadership boards and committees. Whether through the school board, Youth Faith Formation Board, Home School Organization, finance council, endowment committees, or other leadership groups dedicated to the vibrance and sustainability of our community, these individuals are answering God's call!

As you know, we begin to emerge this fall from several years of unrivaled change. Through the merger of our schools and parish, and amidst a global pandemic, we have come together to teach in the Catholic tradition, celebrate as a faith community, and serve one another and those we are called to support. It is fitting that those who will lead us into the coming year have walked with us and loved us through this unique time. I hope you join me in my excitement and gratitude for the great promise of the year ahead!

"Crime, Punishment and Human Dignity"

Sheriff Dart will address what incarceration means for those accused or convicted of crimes in Cook County, how the system tries to ensure that the human dignity and rights of each prisoner are respected and what programs are available to help prisoners develop skills and networks which could aid them after they are released.

As Cook County Sheriff since 2006, Tom Dart is responsible for overseeing the police department and more than 10,000 inmates and 3,000 correctional officers at the Cook County Jail – the largest single-site jail in the nation. A former state prosecutor and legislator, he has long fought for the rights of others and protecting the most vulnerable of our society.

A Chicago native, Sheriff Dart graduated from Providence College. He earned his law degree from Loyola University of Chicago. He and his wife, Patricia, live on Chicago's South Side and are the proud parents of five children.
