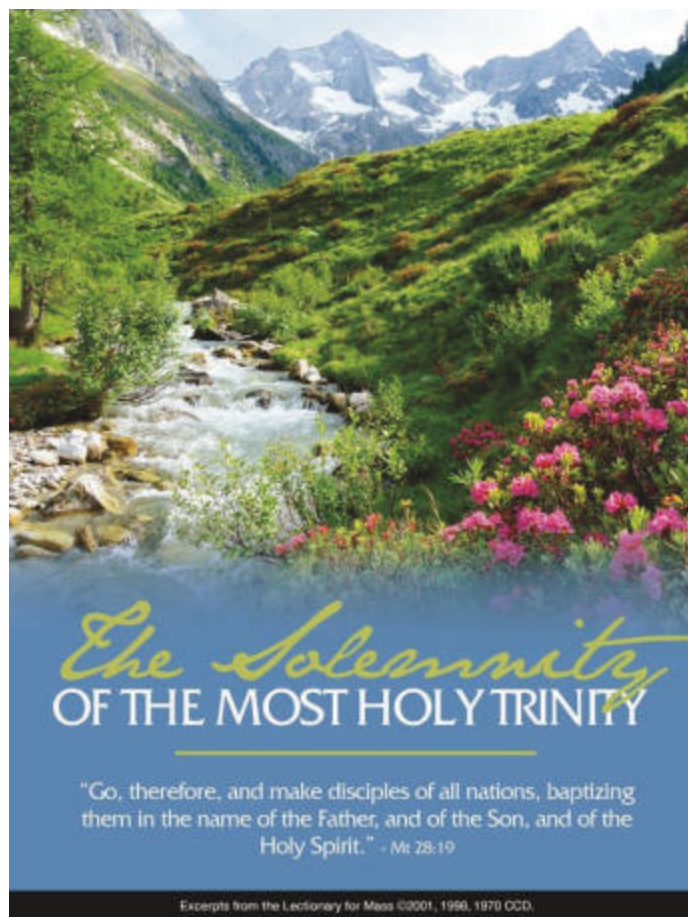

Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. We celebrate the love relationship among the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. We thank our Triune God for inviting us to revel in that relationship as well. Some choose to call the persons of the Trinity Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier. While it is accurate that respectively that is indeed what the persons do, I think to call the persons by what they do limits them. Indeed, the Father creates, and the Son redeems, and the Holy Spirit sanctifies. They are, though, so much more than that. And today we celebrate who those persons are, as we recognize their oneness in being. And we especially rejoice that out of the love of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, we partake in the relationship in this world and will fully know each person of the Trinity in the life to come.

Saint Patrick used the Shamrock to help catechize the Three In One. We invoke the Trinity almost as often as we start or end prayer. We call on the Trinity as we seek blessing. It certainly is a mystery of our faith, a joyful mystery to be sure. The great 20th-century Catholic Theologian Father Karl Rahner, SJ, was supposedly asked once by a priest friend how he should explain the Holy Trinity when preaching. Father Rahner's reply was simple: "Don't!"

The mystery we celebrate in today's feast defies not only explanation but also comprehension. A teacher's simple explanation: "Our God is far beyond the grasp of our intellect. All we can say is: God, the Father, our Father, is Omnipresent and so I live in Him because the universe exists in Him. The Son, Jesus is Emmanuel – God with us - - and so He is always with me; I live with Him. The Holy Spirit is the One Who inspires us all, from within us and so The Holy Spirit lives in my heart. There is only one God. "

Pope Francis urges the faithful to celebrate the Feast of Most Holy Trinity which leads us to contemplate the mystery of a God who ceaselessly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and out of love. Speaking about the love of our Triune God, Pope Francis said, "From the beginning He has chosen to walk together with humanity and form a people that are a blessing for all nations and for all people, no one excluded" he said, urging all believers to go forth with the saving message of God's love that relieves sins, heals the wounds of the soul and gives salvation."

The Preface of today's Eucharistic Prayer sums up this relationship in a beautiful concise way.

It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks,

Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God.

For with your Only Begotten Son and the Holy Spirit you are one God, one Lord:

not in the unity of a single person, but in a Trinity of one substance.

For what you have revealed to us of your glory we believe equally of your Son and of the Holy Spirit,

so that, in the confessing of the true and eternal Godhead, you might be adored in what is proper to each Person, their unity in substance, and their equality in majesty.

For this is praised by Angels and Archangels, Cherubim, too, and Seraphim,

who never cease to cry out each day, Holy Holy...

As we focus on the relationship of the Holy Trinity, and the invitation to participate in the immensity of that love, let's also realize, that our relationship with God challenges us to relate to one another in love. That is the final Message of Jesus in the Gospel today: "Go into the world. Baptize in the name of your Triune God. Teach those that you baptize. And always remember I am with you." He gives the recipe of love: stay connected to the Triune God, and to one another, and all shall be well.
