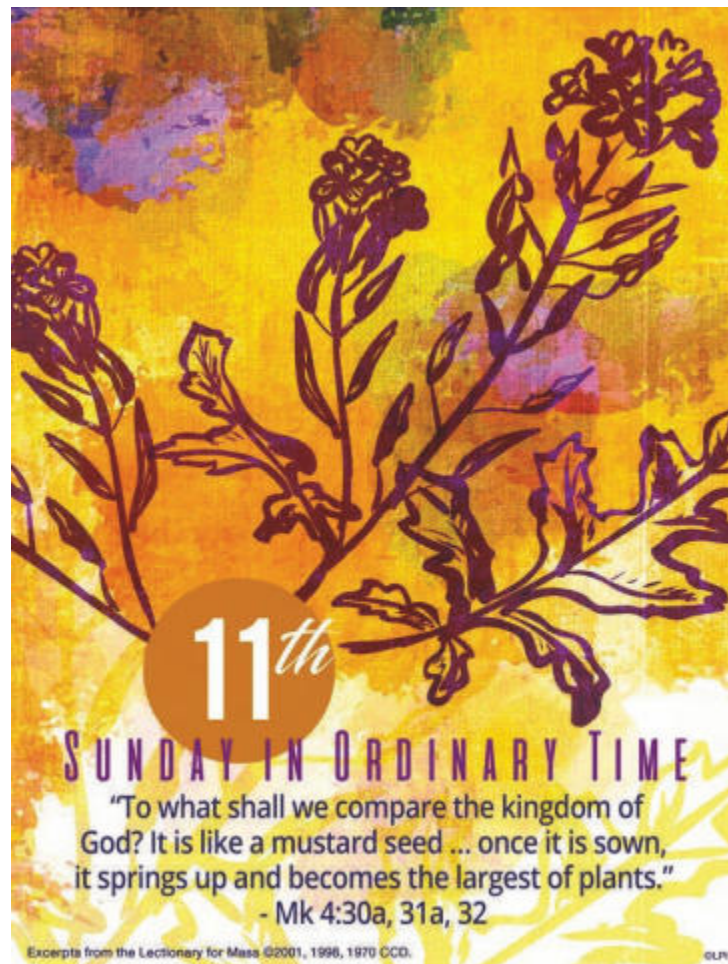

Dear Friends,

Saint Paul reminds us, in a very familiar reading, that, ***"We all must appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense for what he did in the body, whether good or evil."***

That statement from Saint Paul, though, does make me think about how we live today. So many of us live as if there will be no judgment for our actions. Too many of us believe that no one, not even God, can judge us, and that we can and should do whatever makes us feel good at the time. Saint Paul tells us that we will be judged by what we do in the body. So, what are we doing while we still exist in the body? Are we doing good? Are we doing evil? Are we giving our all? Maybe Saint Paul's reminder about judgment day will inspire action. Get involved. Share your gifts. Know you're loved and needed. Give your all. And God will do the rest.

I always get nervous when I read the parable of the mustard seed. When people read the "smallest seed," they might get tempted to give the smallest portion of their time, their talent, or their treasure as their contribution to the building of the Kingdom of God. The mustard seed gives its all and God provides the rest, and the resulting bush becomes grand. The mustard seed does not give just a portion of itself in the making of the bush; it gives its whole being. So should it be with us in the building of the Kingdom of God.

The psalmist writes, ***"Lord it is good to give thanks to you."*** No statement can be truer. For so many reasons it benefits us to thank the Lord. First of all, thanking the Lord presumes having things for which we can give thanks. So, thinking about it, making a gratitude list daily helps check a person's attitude. Do you realize how blessed you are? Do you count your blessings? Too often I hear people complaining about this or about that. I'm often inspired by the homeless or near homeless people I see regularly at Catholic Charities who are "blessed" or "grateful" whenever I ask them. For what are you grateful today? Make a list. Do it daily. Don't forget.

Secondly, it is good to thank the Lord because it reminds us that God is the giver of the gifts. The Lord gives gifts freely and without counting the cost. All that we have and all that we are comes from God. Often, we forget that. We give ourselves or some other human being credit

when really everything good comes from God. Thanking the Lord prevents us from becoming egocentric and myopic. It allows us to reflect on the source of our blessings and recognize our proper place in salvation history. Remember, God gives the gifts!



It is good to thank the Lord because thanking the Lord can take the place of self-pity, complaining, or finger pointing. In our world, sadly, we often focus on what we don't have, what someone didn't do for us, how someone offended us.... I could go on and on. I hear it all the time. When we replace the pity party with a joyful song of thanks, our life gets brighter and we're able to share joy, light and gladness rather than gloom and darkness. Out of thanking the Lord comes a realization of indebtedness and a desire to give back. Grateful people become givers. Thankful people bring light to our world!

Saint Paul reminds the people of Corinth that we all will receive recompense according to what we did in the body, whether good or evil. My simple thought is that if we focus on gratitude and we thank the proper person (God), we will be able to do great things in this body our souls temporarily live in. And when we leave this body, we will go home to the Lord. We are promised a great reward - just another thing for which we can be grateful. It's a joyful, thankful, generous cycle! Let's do it!

So, it's easy. Count your blessings. Realize from whom the blessings come. Acknowledge the gifts and the giver. Give back. Be joyful. Smile. Change the world.
