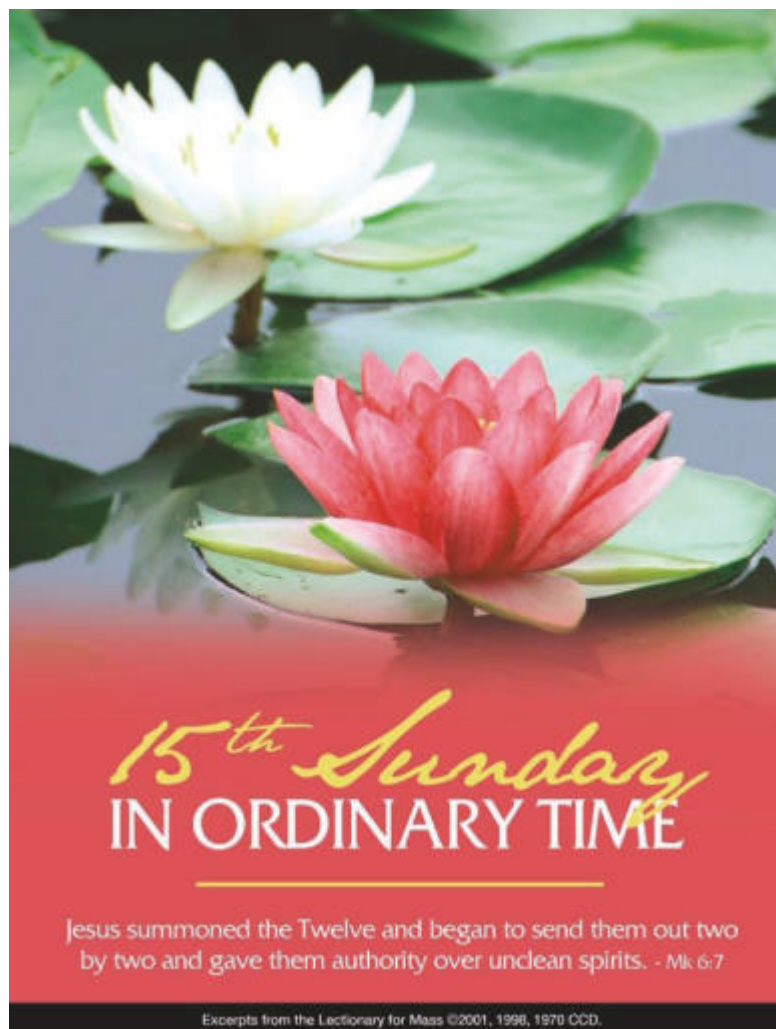

Dear Friends,

“God provides!” Those two words ring so very true, as they echo in my memory from my childhood days. My Mother often used those words to calm financial worries, or to remind her nine children of the goodness and the providence of God. If we really look at our lives, and the blessings therein, we will expose evidence of the graciousness of God. God really has given us, does give us, and will give us what we need.

Saint Paul recognizes the beneficence of God as he writes to the people of Ephesus, blessing and praising God. He says God has “blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens... and chose us to be holy and without blemish before him.” Think about it. God truly has showered us with abundant spiritual gifts. And God does invite us to be holy – and without blemish.

Consider the spiritual gifts God has given you. Reflect on the call to holiness. Think about the way you have shared - and are sharing your gifts. Jesus sends his disciples out to proclaim the Kingdom of God. That mandate lives today. The role of the Christian in the world is to proclaim the Kingdom. In fact, sharing the Good News is part of our mission statement. ***We honor the traditions of our parish and welcome all to unite in prayer and the Sacraments. Loved by God and guided by the Holy Spirit, we share the good news of Jesus Christ through joyful worship, faithful formation, and dedicated service.***

My hope is that every one of us will not only memorize our mission but also put it into action in our lives. When we live our mission, our parish bears abundant fruit. And we do what Saint Paul reminds the Ephesians they are called to do: exist for the praise of God's glory.

We are striving eagerly to “welcome all” back to worship at our weekend liturgies. Another great saying of my mother's was, “Many hands make light work.” I encourage you to raise your hands to make light work of the task of welcoming and serving as ushers at our weekend liturgies. You can volunteer by emailing reopenssjfx@ssjfx.org.

As Jesus sends his disciples out, he reminds them that they really do not have to burden themselves with “stuff.” He ordered them “to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick--no food, no sack, no money in their belts.” In a sense he was telling them not to worry because the God of Providence will give them all that they need.

Many years ago, on one of my annual pilgrimages to Lourdes with the young people, we encountered an Italian monk who was staying at our lodging site. The young people were enthralled by his story, because it was so different than the experiences we have. They came from

planned and perhaps over-programmed households. Their regular at-home schedules dictated their every movement during their days. Between school and sports, and every other co-curricular event, they lived well-planned lives. They always had money in their pockets for lunch and other needs and wants. Meals awaited them as they returned to their well-equipped houses.



The man we met was literally walking, from the southern tip of Italy to Santiago de Compostela, in central Spain. He had no plans, except to make the pilgrimage of faith. He had no hotel reservations, no cell phone, no food, and no money. He simply depended on the Providence of God and the generosity of the people he met along his six-month walking journey. Even as he left our place in the morning after we met him, after he slept for free, he refused to take a bag of food for his lunch. He radically trusted that God would provide, even for his next meal and his next night's stay. An inspiration to the young people – and their priest, indeed!

So, we need to let go of our reliance on stuff and depend on God - who provides abundantly. We must realize that we are made for God's glory and should praise Him with our words and deed. I think of Saint Ignatius' famous Suscipe Prayer, which helps me live my life of discipleship. I share it with you today.

*Take, Lord, and receive all my liberty,
my memory, my understanding
and my entire will,
All I have and call my own.
You have given all to me.
To you, Lord, I return it.
Everything is yours; do with it what you will.
Give me only your love and your grace.
That is enough for me.*

God Provides! Trust in Providence and share the Good News!

From the Loft

The Communion aria heard at the 9:30 and 11:30am SFX Mass is *Gelobet sei der Herr, mein Gott* from the church cantata (BWV 129) of the same title by Johann Sebastian Bach. Composed in 1727, the text of the cantata is a general praise of the Trinity. Pastoral and with dance-like joyfulness, the aria is scored in three parts: an obligato line (played on violin), a vocal line, and a continuo line (played on organ). While each part weaves independently of the next, Bach manages something quite remarkable. For just a brief moment, all three parts converge together in unison as the vocalist sings, “God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.” This is a musical representation of the Trinity, three in one. Below is a translation of the text:

Praised be the Lord, my God, who lives forever,
 whom all things praise, that soars in the air;
 praised be the Lord, whose name is called Holy,
 God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

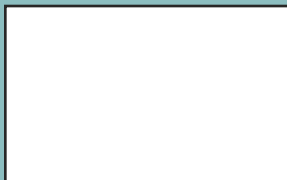
