



Dear Friends,

I mentioned last week that I visited Mexico City to baptize the child of a friend who lives there. We had a wonderful time, and I was able to pay a visit to our Lady of Guadalupe Basilica, where I prayed for the families of this great parish. I did, though, experience a sober reality. On Saturday I attended Mass at San Jose de las Palmas in Mexico City. I always thought the faith was strong in that country and was moved by it as a seminarian. When I entered the church for the Sunday anticipatory Mass, I was shocked to see fewer than a dozen other worshippers for Mass. *"Where are all the faithful Mexican Catholics? Why are they not coming in droves to receive the Bread of Life?"* I wondered.

I have often considered standing out in front of Saint Peter's in the Loop or Holy Name Cathedral and doing an informal focus group. I often wonder what draws people to Mass – especially daily Mass. Between those two busy downtown parishes, before Covid, they celebrated *twelve* daily Masses. Twelve. Covid has reduced that number to four. Having been to both places during Mass times, I can tell you that while not standing room only, the Masses are full. And no one is there out of obligation. Why are these busy downtown people taking time each day to go to Mass?

Granted, the Masses are much shorter than the weekend ones, but it still is a commitment of time daily. What draws all those people to daily Mass? Some might say it is the stellar preaching at those places, or the music. I contend that those who commit to regular, frequent reception of the Eucharist have come to know its power and its promise in their lives. I speak as a person who has lived and loved the Eucharist for as long as I can remember. I'd love to inspire in others, especially youth and young adults, a love for and dependence on the Eucharist. With a love for, and dependence on the Bread of Life, we can weather storms and build the Kingdom.

Throughout salvation history, God has provided for God's people. In our covenantal relationship with God, we experience God's benevolence and generosity. Last week, we heard of God's providing manna in the desert to feed the grumbling Israelites. And this week we hear of God's providence showering goodness on Elijah. Just when he was about to give up, when he was wishing death upon himself, starving, Elijah awoke to find a hearth cake and water, food to sustain him for his journey. God sent an Angel of providence to give him what he needed. After consuming the food and drink provided for him, he continued the journey set before him, indeed strengthened by the food and the providence for the journey.

Our journeys today probably will not ever require us to walk forty days and forty nights, but these somewhat dark days in our city, world, and, yes, Church require strength and courage to persevere. The Eucharist, the Bread of Life that promises we will live forever, can and does embolden us to work for the good, in our Church and in our world.



As a college kid, I went to Mass every night after a couple hours of studying and before having a beer or two with my friends. That time of my life was both the most difficult and the happiest of my life. My mother was dying, or had just died, of cancer. Through her illness and after her death, I was strengthened by the Bread of Life and given the courage to make life decisions that were not popular or necessarily easy ones. The Father drew me to the Son and the Son strengthened me with his Body and Blood.

The Father still beckons. He draws us, calls us and welcomes us. And the Son still offers us himself, the Bread of Life, as food for the journey. For some reason people are not hearing the call. Perhaps the scandals once again besetting the Church are preventing the people from being drawn in. For those scandals, and to all who are hurt by them, I am sorry. My hope and prayer are that an openness to the strength that the Bread of Life offers will allow people to return to regular, frequent reception of the Eucharist. I pray that parents may join me in instilling in their children a great love for, reverence of, and dependence on the Eucharist. The gift of faith in the One the Father sent is probably the best gift a parent can give a child.

Won't you please join me as I sing the psalmist's song, and invite those you love to "Taste and see the goodness of the Lord?" When we taste and see God's goodness and then enthusiastically invite others, God will provide the rest.


