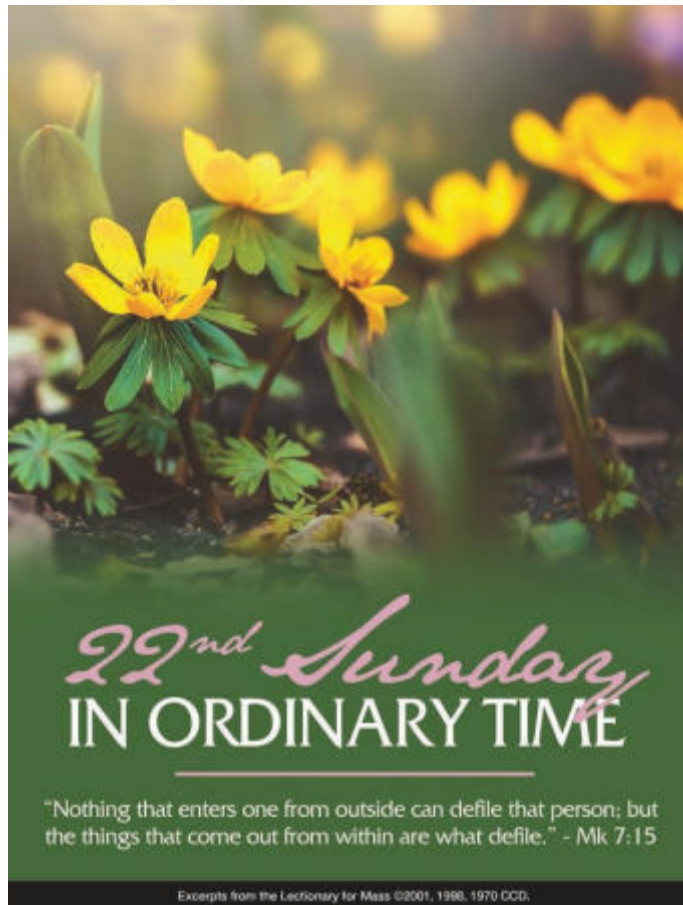

Dear Friends,

In the letter to Saint James, which we hear today, we are encouraged and challenged to be doers of the word and not hearers only. This challenge comes at a great time in our history; as a parish, a city, a nation and a world we need to cry the Gospel; we need to "do" the Word of God in our lives.

When I meet with my wedding couples - which I do quite regularly - I invite them (maybe more than invite them) to make Sunday Mass part of their lives together, and to get involved in the life of the Church. I believe with my whole heart that regular participation in the Eucharistic celebration in a parish strengthens us. Jesus comes to us in Word and Sacrament to heal our brokenness and to give us food for our journey. Recently Bishop Robert Barron wrote that the best remedy for our malnourished faith is the Eucharist. I agree. I go one step farther. The lectionary readings give us food for thought, recipes for better lives and fodder for better behavior. Coming to church is great food. I applaud you for making Mass part of your family lives.

In today's letter of Saint James we are told, "Humbly welcome the word that has been planted in you and is able to save your souls. Be doers of the word and not hearers only, deluding yourselves" and the Psalmist writes, "The one who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord." These two simple passages provide lessons to live by, and inspire an active faith as opposed to a passive one. The "doing of the word" and the "doing justice" require active participation in the mission. These passages call for generosity of spirit and the willingness to give time, talent, and treasure as true disciples of the Lord.

Can the readings - including our beautiful Psalm - about "doing" motivate us to action? If we simply listen to the words and allow them to wash over us and fail to touch our hearts, we miss the point. If we get stuck in our own way of thinking, our own agendas, wants and desires, we lose. But if the words of Sacred Scripture inspire us to action, to generous gift of self, then God's will gets done.

What gets in the way of your generosity? What prevents you from doing, from giving, from acting? Fear sometimes prevents us from giving generously of our time, talent and treasure. So does selfishness.

Are you afraid to give? Are you afraid to "do?" Why?

When we trust in the providence of God, we can abandon ourselves, and our time, and our money to God. God will always be there for us and take care of us. Think about what you are doing - and about what you are giving - in response to the loving providence of God. My math tells

me that we have many parishioners at Saints JFX who need to hear the call and to respond to be doers of the word. Are you one of them?

The Psalmist writes, "The one who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord." What does doing justice mean? I believe the justice spoken of in the Scriptures is a justice clothed in mercy, filled with generosity. The Psalmist continues, saying that the just one "walks blamelessly and does justice, who thinks the truth in his heart, and slanders not with his tongue." I also think it means reaching out to, and lifting up the forgotten.

To do justice, to have the promise of living in the presence of the Lord, we must rid ourselves of the things Jesus mentions in the Gospel today. "Evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, licentiousness, envy, blasphemy, arrogance and folly" all potentially can come out of us and prevent us from doing justice. Getting rid of whatever of those that are in us will aid us in our "doing" of the word.

I write this after a week of more news of senseless gun violence in our Chicagoland area. The killing of the poor woman on the Dan Ryan, as she drove home from the Sox game, should shock our city. Maybe you didn't even hear about it. A special education teacher, Denise Huguelet, now mourned by her family and friends, is one of the latest innocent victims. This must stop.

We must not become numb to the violence or forget that the victims of violence, here and throughout the world, are our brothers and sisters. These victims have names. We need to end gun violence. We need to create a more peaceful, loving country. In order for our world to be a better place, and for that matter our parish, more people must commit to be "doers" of the word. When we commit, the winners are many. And the great promise remains: we will live in the presence of the Lord.
