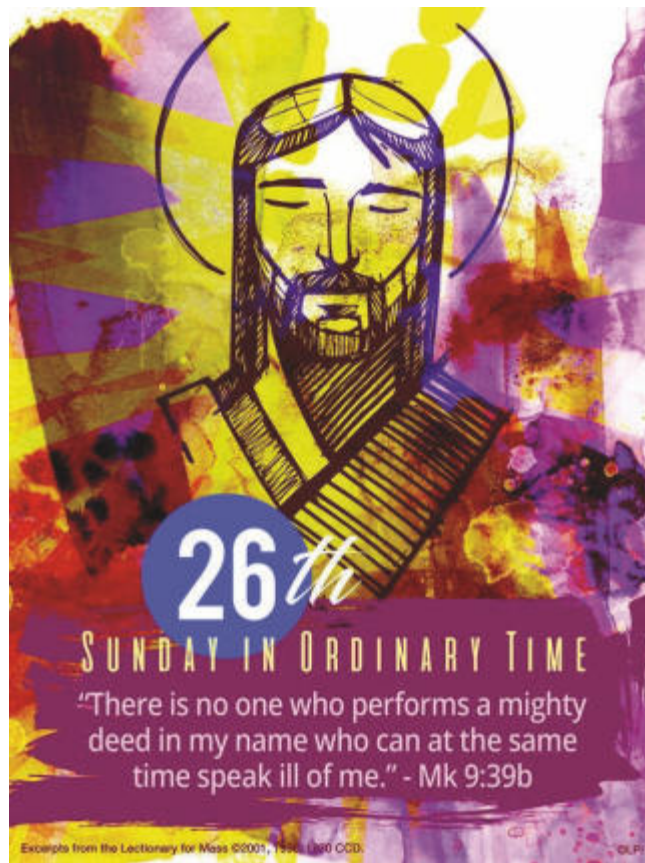

Dear Friends,

So often we can be quick to judge. Even when we claim to have the best of intentions, we judge others who are different from us or who don't do things exactly as we do or as we would like them to do. The "my way or the highway" mentality stifles the spirit. Our Scriptures for today illustrate that quite clearly.

Just because Eldad and Medad were not in the tent at the time of the descent of the spirit on the elders, Joshua couldn't believe the righteous power of the prophesy. He wanted to stop them. He wanted to stifle the work of God's Spirit. And Moses would have none of it. Moses, in his wisdom, prayed that God would bestow his spiritual gifts on everyone so that everyone could be a mouthpiece for God. God heard his prayer.

I believe with my whole heart that God does send his Spirit to all who are open to it. God does give us gifts that we need to build up in the Kingdom of God. The gifts, as varied as those receiving them, demonstrate God's power, creativity, and love. God does not hold back. God gives and gives and gives! We cannot limit God's generosity by our own closed mindedness. The Holy Spirit is at work - even now, and even among people we'd least expect to receive the gifts.

As we continue the season of recognition and purification in the Church, our lectionary provides good food for thought. Repeatedly our Holy Father warns of the dangers of a Church closed in on itself. It's been a theme of his papacy. "An institution that is self-referential," the Pope said in 2013 and again in 2015, "is sick." He also said, "It is better to have a church that is wounded but out in the streets than a Church that is closed in on itself." Our universal Church has been too closed in on itself. Abuse of power and failure to really shepherd and protect those entrusted to our care are real signs of the illness. Divisiveness, that which seems to be running rampant in our society and in our Church (including among the hierarchy) is the work of the devil.

Turning outward, really being open to the other, the one who is different, the one with whom we disagree, follows the example of Jesus. It also enriches us and makes our vision broader and brighter. When we stop highlighting our differences, and allowing those differences to divide us, we, as Church, can do what Christ calls us to do. Jesus invites us to open our hearts and open our doors. "**Whoever is not against us is for us,**" Jesus tells us. In other words, "Let's work together to build the Kingdom!" Our world is in desperate need of the proclamation of the Kingdom. God's people need to hear mercy, love, understanding and peace.

The Pope takes his welcoming cues from the Gospel. Jesus, throughout his earthly ministry, welcomed all and went to the fringes of society to bring the Good News of God's mercy and love. He didn't live a finger-pointing and judgmental ecclesiology. He included all and invited all to participate in the building of the kingdom. This philosophy of life was even difficult for his disciples to understand. They wanted to prevent someone from doing good because he was not part of their little group. Can't we sometimes be like them? Don't we sometimes want people to think and act exactly the way we do or the way we want them too? The blessing of our Church, from the time of Jesus until now, is the unity we find in our diversity.



That's the blessing of the Saints JFX community too – unity in diversity. Remember our mission statement? *We honor the traditions of our parish and welcome all to unite in prayer and the Sacraments. Loved by God and guided by the Holy Spirit, we share the good news of Jesus Christ through joyful worship, faithful formation, and dedicated service.*

We welcome all. We are one. As one, we reach out in welcome to the stranger and to the neediest. As one, we support each other in times of trial. As one, we go out to Wilmette and beyond to share the good news of Jesus Christ.

There is a temptation, though, to become myopic, to focus on self - *what's important to me, what I want, what I think should be done and how I think we should do it...* we sometimes want everyone to fit into our little box. We can do that individually and as a community. It is then when we can accuse ourselves of turning in on ourselves. And we can become bitter and disappointed. When we let go of ego and allow Christ to be the center of our lives, peace enters, understanding comes, and charity prevails. What must be done during this time of communal reflection and purification is to focus on Christ and to bring his mercy to the people who need it most. I have no doubt that you will join me in that effort.

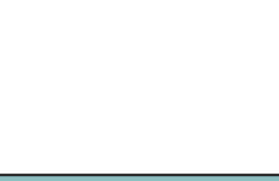
