

He saw the pile shrinking and panicked about what would happen when it dwindled to nothing. I told him that I was pretty sure that would not happen and that when we live generously, God provides. It took a little convincing, but he agreed to try it. He has supported Catholic Charities and many other philanthropic causes quite generously over the years, and, to his surprise, the pile has not shrunk. God has provided, as He always does.


