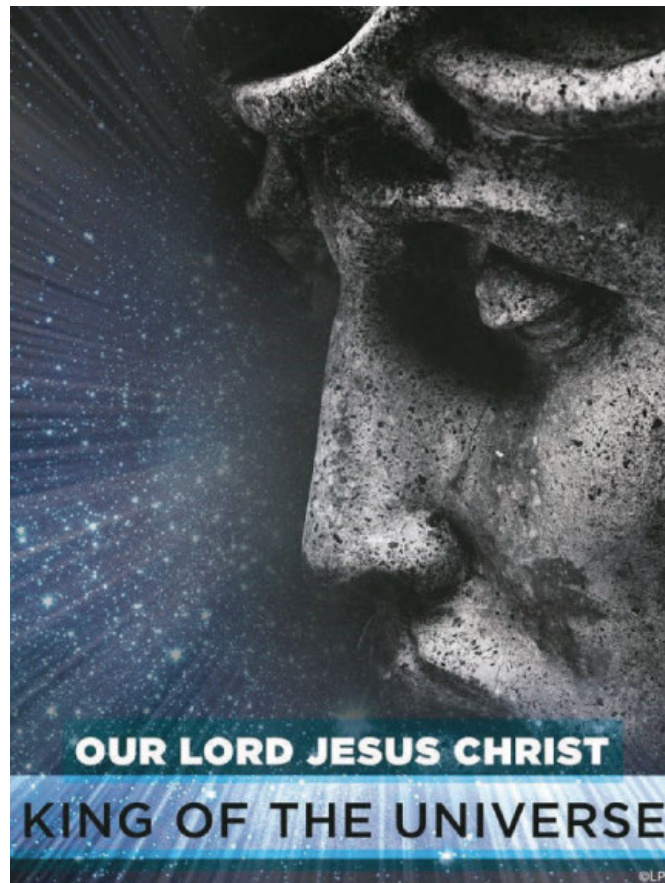

Dear Friends,

Allow me to say it a few days early. Happy Thanksgiving! As I write this I think of the gratitude I have in my heart for the great things people have done around this parish to make it the great community that it is. I hope you enjoy the day. In this year's Thanksgiving card, sent to the homes of all school families, parishioners and donors, we said, "Together, as one family... we give thanks!" So many people give of their time, talent, and treasure to make great things happen at Saints JFX. We mean it when we say thanks. We are truly grateful for the generosity. I hope I say it enough. If I listed every name of those to whom I am grateful, I would fill the bulletin. Suffice it to say, if you are reading this, I am likely grateful for you. So, thanks! And remember, gratitude is the foundation of the spiritual life. Thank someone today.

Last Saturday, I was able to join almost two hundred school parents at the appetizer portion of the "progressive dinner." The camaraderie and joy of togetherness filled the air. I thank all those who worked hard to put the event together, and those who hosted the dinner or dessert portions in their homes. We have a great community here. When I joined them at A. Perry's event space, which Anthony generously donated, I thanked the parents for their commitment to Catholic Education, and I reminded them that we at the school are simply partners in the faith formation of their children. Parents are the primary educators of their children in the ways of the faith. I pray for the day when we are all together, experiencing the joy of that evening, at Mass, around the Altar of the Lord, receiving together his precious Body and Blood, truly present in the Eucharist. **Regular reception of the Eucharist is the best gift a parent can give a child.**

This weekend we end another liturgical year with the annual celebration of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Every time I announce or read the title of this weekend's solemnity, awe fills my heart. The Son of God came to Earth as a little poor child, ate, drank, taught, healed, loved, cried, forgave, suffered, and died. He became our king! Why? I think Jesus became our king out of God's infinite love for the human race. We needed a king. We expected a king. We wanted a king.

When Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus refers to the kingdom that does not belong to this world. He refers to the kingdom that is yet to come. As he makes those references to the kingdom, he makes a great assertion, one that challenges me,

"For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth.

Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

With all that is happening in our church and in our political world, the "truth" needs to be held in high esteem.

Transparency, goodness, righteousness, openness, will

serve us well if we really want to listen to the voice of Jesus.

Belonging to the truth demands us to let go of "my truth" and "your truth." There really is only ONE truth – God's truth. Our Church and world get in trouble when we make up our own truths. I'm sure you can think of dozens of examples of disasters resulting from people living their relative truths. Abuse of power, disrespect of others, and significant pain are just some of the results of living relative truth. Belonging to the real truth results from hearing the voice of the King, and that belonging helps us to hear that voice more clearly.



When we pray the Lord's Prayer, the one Jesus himself taught the disciples, we pray that God's kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven. Jesus taught us to say those words. We pray them every day. What are we meaning, what are we saying when we pray those words? If we pray them, then we must work for the building of the kingdom here, in expectation of its fullness to come. We must make Jesus our king, and allow him to rule over our thoughts, words and deeds. We must look at the middle bits of Jesus' life to guide us. Our king is a loving and merciful king who invites us to build the kingdom. Our king tells us to remember him every time we eat his Body and drink his Blood. Let the word of the great hymn be ours. "To Jesus Christ our Sovereign King, who is the world's salvation, all praise and homage do we bring, with thanks and adoration! Christ Jesus Victor! Christ Jesus Ruler! Christ Jesus Lord and Redeemer!"
