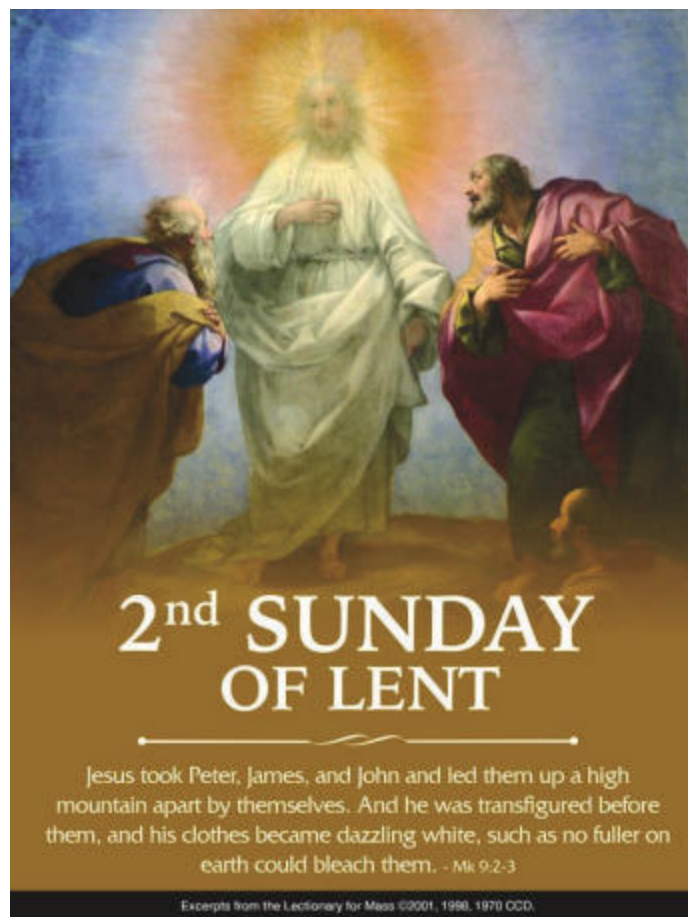




## Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Parish

Dear Friends,

We have begun our Lenten fast. We join Jesus in the desert, and we strive to align our lives with his.

The Scriptures lead us to closeness with our Lord. Abraham lived a life close to the Lord and obedient to God's will even to the point of being willing to offer his son as a sacrifice to God. He heard God calling and followed the command. He heard God's messenger calling and ceased the sacrificial offering of Isaac. The image of a father being willing to sacrifice even his own son strikes me. The question arises, "What are we willing to sacrifice out of love for, and obedience to God?"

Today we join Jesus on the Mountain of the Transfiguration, and I echo Saint Peter who says, "Rabbi it is good that we are here." It is good that we are here today, celebrating Holy Mass as part of our Lenten observance. As we continue our journey, we need to hear clearly the voice that came from the cloud that tells us, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." We often spend a lot more time talking, in life and in prayer, than listening. We want to make our point rather than understand another's. We fill our lives with useless noise that blocks out the voice of the Lord. We spend so much of our time running from this place to the next that we don't allow ourselves even a moment to hear his voice. This Lent let's make a point to listen to what our Lord is saying to us.

Take some extra time in the morning or the evening in quiet. Turn off the television. Mute the cell phones and silence the computers. I know as well as you do that is a tall order for modern day Christians. Another great way to listen to the Lord is to come to Mass more often. Make a visit. Spend some time with our Eucharistic Lord. Weekday Masses allow for walk-ins during this pandemic time. On Fridays at Saint Joseph, we will pray the Stations of the Cross after Mass.

In order for us to be transfigured, to be transformed this Lent, we need to let our Lord work on our hearts. We need to eliminate the babble, the voices that compete with God's. The collect for today's Mass says it well when we pray, "O God, who have commanded us to listen to your beloved Son, be pleased, we pray, to nourish us inwardly by your word, that, with spiritual sight made pure, we may rejoice to behold your glory."

As we purify ourselves this Lent, let's fast and feast. I reprint this litany that many of us have seen before. It helps me each Lent; I hope it will help you.

- Fast from judging others; feast on the Christ dwelling in them.

- Fast from emphasis on differences; feast on the unity of life.
- Fast from apparent darkness; feast on the reality of light.
- Fast from thoughts of illness; feast on the healing power of God.
- Fast from words that pollute; feast on phrases that purify.
- Fast from discontent; feast on gratitude.
- Fast from anger; feast on patience.
- Fast from pessimism; feast on optimism.
- Fast from worry; feast on trust in God.
- Fast from complaining; feast on appreciation.
- Fast from negatives; feast on affirmatives.
- Fast from unrelenting pressures; feast on unceasing prayer.
- Fast from hostility; feast on tenderness.
- Fast from bitterness; feast on forgiveness.
- Fast from self-concern; feast on compassion for others.
- Fast from personal anxiety; feast on eternal truth.
- Fast from discouragements; feast on hope.
- Fast from facts that depress; feast on verities that uplift.
- Fast from lethargy; feast on enthusiasm.
- Fast from thoughts that weaken; feast on promises that inspire.
- Fast from shadows of sorrow; feast on the sunlight of serenity.
- Fast from idle gossip; feast on purposeful silence.
- Fast from problems that overwhelm; feast on prayer that undergirds.
