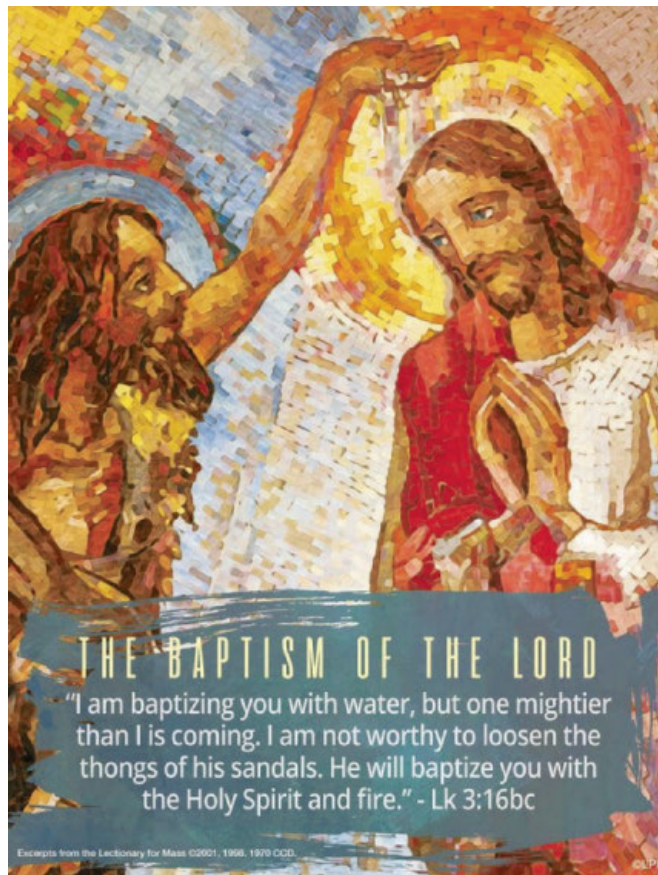

Dear Friends,

“After the people had been baptized, and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from the heaven, ‘You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.’”

Saint Luke adds the action of Jesus’ praying to the story of his baptism in the Jordan. To me it highlights the importance of prayer in the life of those who share his baptism. It is as if the Holy Spirit came to Jesus because of his praying. Saint Teresa of Avila’s words “Prayer changes things” come to mind.

“*How’s your prayer life?*” I have a priest friend that I visit from time to time. Each time we meet, the first four words that come out of his mouth are the same. He returns to the question three or four times during our conversation. His persistence in questioning serves as a warning, a reminder, and a nudge.

When I talk of the good things that are happening, here and in other areas of my life, he asks, “*How’s your prayer life?*” The question challenges me to be sure to take time in prayer to thank God for all the blessings God gives me. God does, you know, give great gifts to those who love him. Too often, we take those gifts for granted. Our life, family, talents, and experiences – really all we have - come from God. My friend’s question gently says, “Don’t forget to say thank you.”

When I speak of the concerns and worries that sometimes fill my mind and heart, my friend wonders aloud, “*How’s your prayer life?*” All of us will possess some concerns or worries this year. All will experience anxiety in their own time and way. When we do, my friend opines, we need to turn to prayer.

God hears the voices of those who call on him. That is a promise given to us from the beginning of time. From the time of creation to the covenant, to the prophets, to Jesus, God tells us we are his people, and he is our God. When we remember this promise we can do nothing but respond by building the relationship between God and us. We do this, for our part, through prayer. When we are stressed, then, let’s ask ourselves the question, “*How’s your prayer life?*” Let’s remind ourselves of God’s promise. Let’s turn to God in prayer.

Jesus heard the voice on the day of his Baptism. He heard the voice that came from heaven. Right after hearing the voice, Jesus began his ministry. Responding to the voice from heaven telling him that he was beloved and that the Father was pleased with him, Jesus lived his life as a beloved child of God seeking always to please the Father. In verse 16, the voice came (after Jesus was praying, remember) and in verse 17, Luke tells us of the beginning of Jesus’ earthly ministry. As a result of the prayer, the Holy Spirit came. As a response to the gift of the Spirit, Jesus committed his life to the service of God and God’s people.

Prayer led Jesus to commit. The word commitment came to me a few times this week. Several years ago, there was a campaign called “Catholics Come Home.” Many have commented that as we hopefully emerge from the pandemic in this new year, we should have a similar campaign now. Too many people for too long have been away from regular reception of the Eucharist - the source and summit of the Christian life. Maybe over the holidays you decided to return to church. If that’s the case, I say, with a joyful heart, Welcome home!”

I would like to start my own campaign, here at Saints JFX. I would like to start something called Catholics Commit. We share Jesus’ baptism. We are beloved Children of God. God has sent us the Holy Spirit as a gift. What is the level of our commitment?

Think about it. Have you volunteered to participate in a ministry of this parish? If not, why not? If you have volunteered, what is the level of your commitment? Do you show up, prepared for your assignment? Do you get a substitute when you are unable to attend to your assigned duties? Jesus had a great prayer life. He recognized his gift and responded. He COMMITTED to serving the Father - when it was convenient and when it was not. What about us? Catholics Come Home, and Catholics Commit!

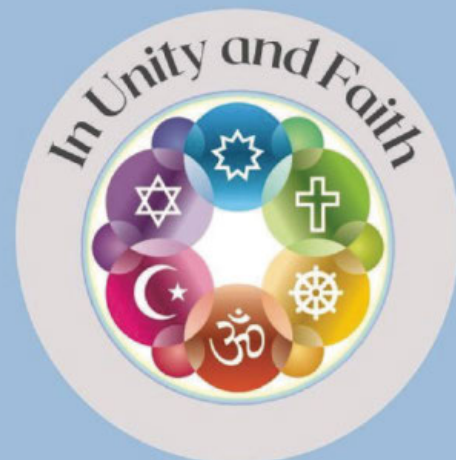
Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Women's Club 2022 Scholarship Announcement

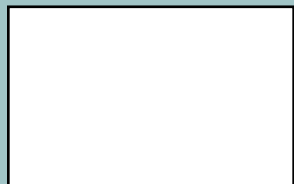

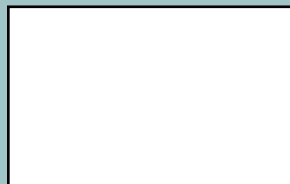

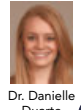
