

Dear Friends,

Today we hear the beginning of Saint Luke's Gospel. He That rings true in the light of this begins the Gospel by setting out the purpose of his writing. week's Gospel. We are free to He addresses this Gospel, and the Acts of the Apostles, to love. We are free to listen to Theophilus (the lover of God). As members of his body, God's will. we too are called to be lovers of God.

Then Luke gets right into the purpose of Jesus' earthly become his disciples, to bring glad ministry. Luke portrays Jesus, before the elders, teachers, tidings to the poor, to proclaim and leaders of the people, reading a very familiar passage liberty to captives, to proclaim from the book of the prophet Isaiah. Last week I met up with some Catholic Charities doing to build up the body of Christ? volunteers at a downtown restaurant. That was nearly thirty years ago, and it made a big difference in my life too. As I thought numbers of every one of the trip's participants. In 1993, I traveled with about a dozen young people, mostly from Wilmette, to world Youth Day in Denver Colorado. In Mile High Stadium, as the helicopter carrying the great John Paul II came into view of the nearly hundred thousand faithful young people, we waved, swayed, and sang a song written for the occasion. The song is called We Are One Body. Throughout the last week, the refrain and the verses of that spirited song have been running through my head. Today we hear Saint Paul reminding the people of Corinth that we indeed are one body. He tells them and us that when one member of the body suffers, we all suffer.

The simple refrain of the song sung in Denver states: "We are one body, one body in Christ, and we do not stand alone. We are one body, one body in Christ. And He came that we might have life." One verse asks, "Can you hear them crying, can you feel their pain? Will you feed my hungry, will you help my lame?" Amidst everything that is happening in our world, we need to hear the strong simple statement, and we need to hear and answer the questions posed by the song.

We are free to respond. We are free because Jesus has made us free, free to


