Dear Friends,

As we celebrate the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday in ordinary time, we hear the rich and familiar letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians. "Strive eagerly for the greatest spiritual gifts." Paul's command to the people of Corinth provides a reminder to all of us of our Christian call. Later in the passage, we hear that the greatest spiritual gifts, the ones that remain, are faith, hope and love. The greatest of the greatest, though, is love.

As I wrote my article this week, just for fun, I "right clicked" on the verb "strive" and searched the computer's thesaurus for other terms to define what Paul was commanding the Corinthians and us to do. I found the following synonyms: *struggle, endeavor, attempt, try, go all-out, do your best, do your utmost, make every effort, try hard, do all you can, pull out all the stops, go all out.* Think about it. God calls us to go all out for love, to struggle for love, to *actually* do our utmost for love.

The love of the Saints SFX community is palpable. I certainly felt it last weekend as we enrolled the Confirmation candidates. At the 5 pm Masses at both churches, the candidates for Confirmation committed to continue the process. Not just at that Mass, but really at all of them, inside the walls of our beautiful churches, we can truly feel the love of God and that of our fellow parishioners. I look forward to the day, when Covid is behind us, and when will really be able to celebrate – unmasked – the amazing community that we're building here.

Last week, the reading to the Corinthians purported that if one part of the body of Christ suffers, all parts suffer with it, and if one part of the body is honored, all parts share its joy. We live that claim at Saints JFX. As your pastor, I thank God that you have taken that to heart. I praise God that you use those action verbs mentioned above in your pursuit of the greatest spiritual gifts. Your kindness, generosity and charity amaze me.

I had the great opportunity to come to know and love Cardinal George. Allow me to share with you some words from Cardinal George. He reflects on the words of today's second reading. He was a matter-of-fact type of man, who loved the Lord, and who experienced suffering and pain for much of his life. That suffering and pain did not deter him; it moved him deeper in love with our God and God's Church.

*When we are at Mass, we participate in the miraculous change of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This is a change for which we thank God with all our hearts. But we've all experienced other changes, changes that bring deterioration. After a while, machines don't work well or stop working altogether. A job that we thought would be a stable source of security can easily vanish. Even our very own bodies don't last forever. They age and carry the burdens of illness, and eventually deteriorate in death.*

*In this transitory and impermanent world, faith tells us that something lasts forever. In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul sings a great hymn of praise to charity or love. He proclaims, "Love never fails!" Love is the very life of God. The first letter of Saint John says, "God is love." Since genuine love is of God, it cannot fail.*

*That unfailing love comes to us in the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. That unfailing love by the power of the Holy Spirit forms us as the Church, a communion of love. We are in relationship to each other, and we love or ought to love one another. We are the effective sign of God's love in the world. We cannot stop being God's love in this world without losing our very identity as the Body of Christ and the communion of the Holy Spirit. Our words and our lives should proclaim **love never fails; God's love endures forever.***

*How exactly do we share the enduring and encouraging words, Love never fails? It certainly begins in our families and radiates outwards into our workplaces, our schools, our communities, and our nation and world as we try to be faithful to Christ in all circumstances.*

Today we begin Catholic Schools Week. I thank God for our great two-campus Catholic school, for those who fill it and all of you who support it. Thanks for making Saints JFX parish and school a place of unfailing love!

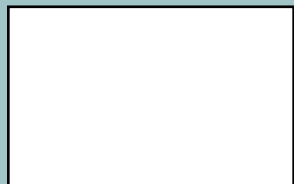

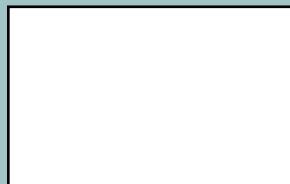

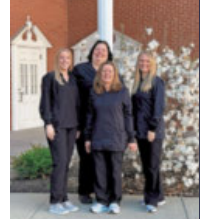
