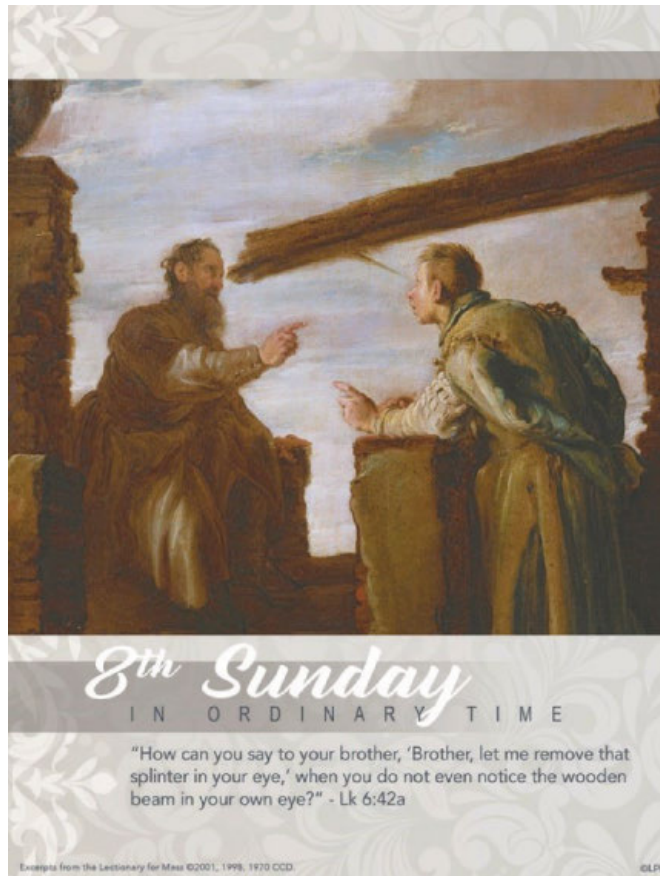

Dear Friends,

By the time you read this, I will have just returned from time away in Costa Rica. It is a beautiful country, rich with the blessings of God's creation. The flora and the fauna impress like no other place I have been. Year after year, my friends generously lend me their home, and I in turn share it with family and friends. This year, we had a dozen together most of the time.

Just outside of the lovely home in Costa Rica is a tree. The tree appears unremarkable. I wouldn't call it the most beautiful tree I have ever seen. In fact, in comparison to the others, it looks half dead. Throughout the day, though, many different animals, winged ones, and crawling ones, come to its branches to feed on its fruit. As I watched the toucans, monkeys, pesotes and others feast on the fruit of the tree, this weekend's readings come to life. That unremarkable tree certainly was known to many in the rainforest by its fruit.

So, too, are we known by our fruit, by what we produce, by what we think, say, or do. We cannot claim to be generous if our actions do not show generosity. We cannot claim to be merciful if we do not practice forgiveness. We cannot claim to be charitable if we involve ourselves in negativity and gossip about another.

When we produce good fruit, others are drawn to us, and we can bring them with us as we strive to come closer to Christ. We can feed them with the fruits of generosity, mercy, kindness, and love. Our world needs the peace and love of Christ, and you and I can be emissaries of that peace and love, but only if we focus on producing those fruits in our lives. That tree in Costa Rica gives much to many while asking for very little. So can we.

As I write this, the uncertainty in the Russia/Ukraine conflict looms large. The dialogue, or lack thereof, around peace talks and ultimatums makes many uneasy. The calls for prayers for peace resound.

I'm all for praying for peace (I do so in every Mass I celebrate), but I think real peace starts small, and requires humility. Too often, on the small scale, peace evades us because of our own pride and unwillingness to see the point of the other, to stand in his or her shoes. We cling to grudges and allow the wounds caused by the other to fester. The refusal to understand the other prevails, in politics and in many relationships.

Our own parishioner, Harry Kraemer, a mentor and a friend to me, teaches at Kellogg and travels the world lecturing on values-based leadership. He often reminds his listeners, in one of his self-described "opinions," of the importance of a line in the Prayer of Saint Francis. The prayer states,

"O Master, let me not seek as much to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love..."



Harry speaks of the importance of *seeking to understand*. We spend a lot of our time trying to make others understand *us*, and our points of views. When we seek to understand the other, we pave the way for peace. Harry will speak this Thursday on **Faith in the Workplace and Beyond**. This is a hybrid event. In a few short days we will begin our Lenten journey. In this pivotal time of our faith community in Wilmette, perhaps we, as individuals and as a community, can take the time to look at the fruits of our own spiritual trees. As we enter this holy season, let's be open to its transforming power and allow it to open our hearts to the change that true discipleship will require of us. You can find the Ash Wednesday Schedule in the bulletin today and in the daily eblasts. I always recommend a renewed commitment to the Sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation during the season. Join us for daily Mass (6:30am at SFX and 8:30am at SJ) and plan to come to one of the many opportunities we have for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

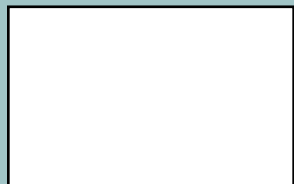

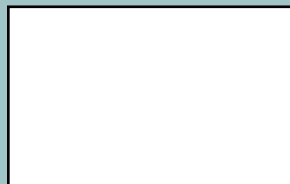

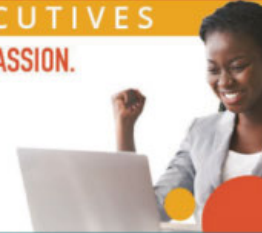
