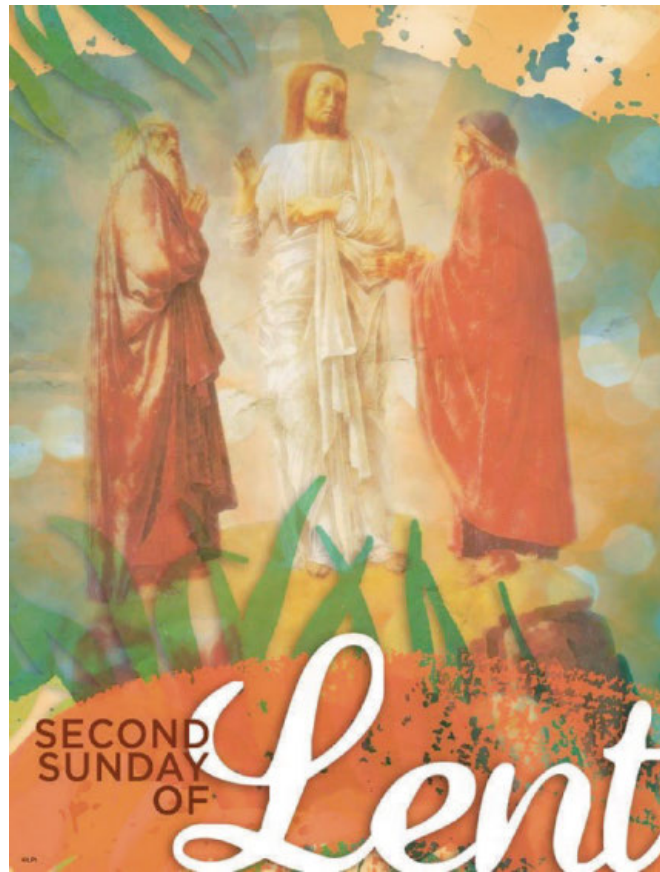

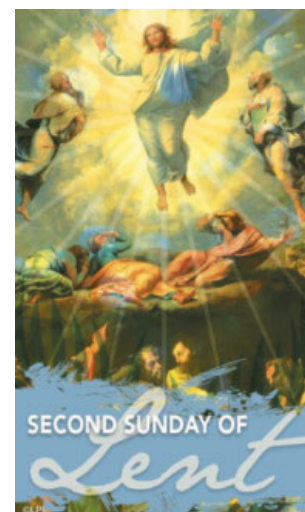

Dear Friends,

Hope amidst trials -- God's voice offers hope to prepare us for trials. His voice offered hope to Abram and offered hope to the disciples. As I write this, I am moved by the trials and suffering in Ukraine. The bloodshed and the devastation resulting from evil choices break my heart. The Church, in her wisdom, gives us the stories of God's encounter with Abram and the Transfiguration to afford us hope during suffering, to embolden us to stay close to Christ, and to see his face in the faces of those who suffer.

On this second Sunday of Lent, we catch a glimpse of sleeping watchmen and overhear celestial conversations and stupefied comments. We witness the faithfulness and benevolence of God's relationship with Abram and Jesus. This week's readings challenge us to listen, trust, and act. Peter's words, "Lord, how good it is for us to be here," ring true. Jesus knew he had to come down that hill and get ready for the next one.

How good it is for us to be here! Lately, as I look out at the ever-growing congregation returning to Mass, as we strive to return to normalcy, those words come to my mind. It *is* good for us to be in church, worshipping, thanking, and praising our benevolent God. It *is* good to see mothers and fathers bringing their infants and toddlers to Holy Mass. It *is* good for us to hear the words of Sacred Scripture. It *is* very good to receive the true presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist. Peter recognized the goodness being in the presence of the transfigured Lord.

The voice from heaven, heard in the first reading and in the Gospel, invites listening and trusting. The voice told Abram, wandering landless and childless, that his inheritance would be a vast region of land and his descendants would be as numerous as the stars. Children and property, signs of God's loving blessing, had eluded Abram for some time. He never lost hope in God. He simply accepted his lot and followed God's commands. He left his homeland to do God's will. Abram listened and trusted. God remained with Abram as he promised.

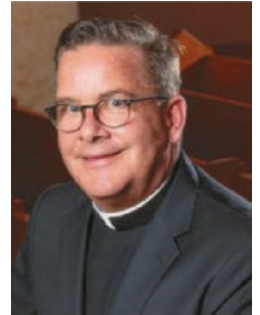
This Lent let's listen to the Lord. To accomplish the command given to the disciples on the Mountain of the Transfiguration, we need to stop rushing, running, and gabbing. Perhaps we can try to get to church a little early each week and spend some time in quiet, allowing the Lord to speak to us. As we listen, we must trust the words Jesus says to us. Sometimes what we hear may challenge us to change. Perhaps we need to change a habit of ours. Maybe the voice of the Lord will call us to do something that is uncomfortable or inconvenient. Jesus does speak. We must listen.

At Saints JFX we celebrate, honor, and thank God for the witnesses of listening, trusting, and acting in the men and women of the OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) program. They listened, as the voice of Jesus spoke to them in their hearts. They trust that the voice is leading them to communion with the Roman Catholic Church. And, even when it has been difficult, they act. They've followed the voice of the Lord and are actively participating in the process. I applaud their courage and faith.

At Holy Name Cathedral on Sunday, we will celebrate the Rite of Election. Our friends in the RCIA who are preparing for Baptism will head to the Cathedral for the formal "election" and "call to continued conversion." Leaving the period of inquiry (when the catechumens and candidates study our Church and her traditions and precepts), they will enter a new period in their preparation for the Easter Sacraments. Cardinal Cupich will officially declare them "elect."

I hope our candidates for Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion will not be the only ones seeking conversion this Lent. I pray that we all may listen, trust, and act in our relationship with the Lord. I expect that this Lent will be fruitful not only for them, but for all of us. Join me, please, in praying for and with these fine women and men. Join them, please, in their pursuit of holiness of life and a closer walk with God and the Roman Catholic Church.

Honoring St. Joseph at Saints JFX

St. Joseph is one of the most venerated saints in Christianity: He is the patron saint of immigrants, workers, unborn children, refugees, fathers, and craftspeople, among others. According to tradition, the practice of creating large food altars, or St. Joseph's Tables, dates to the Middle Ages, when there was a severe drought and famine in Sicily. The peasants prayed to St. Joseph, and when the rains arrived, they organized a celebration in his honor. This event became an annual tradition held around St. Joseph's feast day, March 19.

For more than fifty years this parish has held a St. Joseph Table on the weekend closest to his feast day. The Testa family has supplied us with fruit, the women of the parish have baked, and all have been welcomed to come share the bounty. Parishioners have made a free will offering which has been donated to the St. Vincent DePaul Society. Sadly, we cannot gather for a feast for the third year in a row due to the pandemic. We hope next year all will be well and we can celebrate in style. We would like, however, to ask you to donate to the St. Vincent DePaul Society in honor of St. Joseph.
