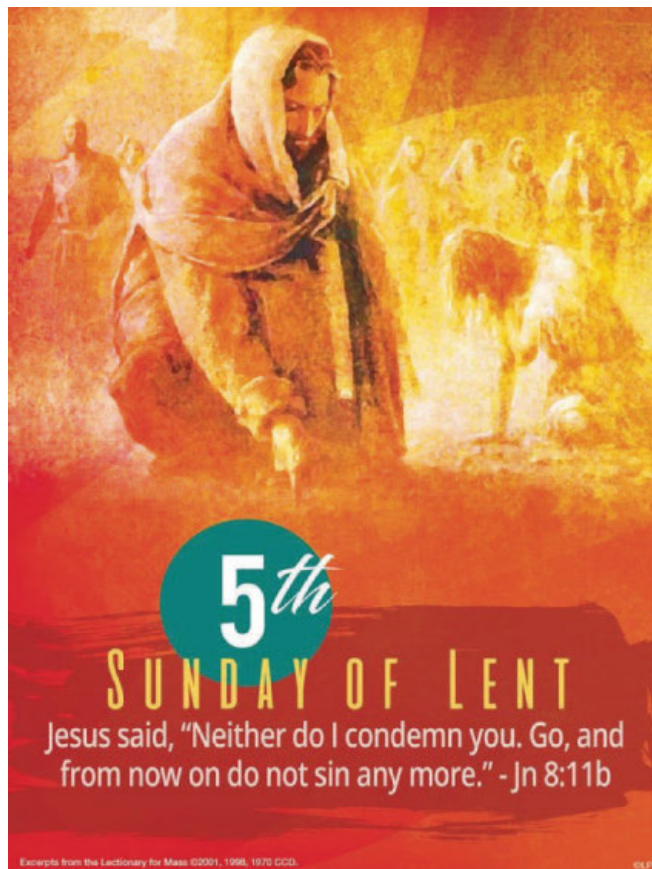

Dear Friends,

“Has no one condemned you?” In his conversation with the woman accused of adultery, seeing none of her accusers around, Jesus asked the poignant question. Was he surprised, or was he speaking tongue in cheek? So many people, then and now, are quick to judge, to call names and to turn on another. It's been going on for centuries. Jesus counters the not so innocent accusers with his own challenge. “Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone.”

This Gospel makes me think of one of Cardinal George's great one-liners about today's society. He said, “We are living in a society that permits everything and forgives nothing.” Think about it. How often do we catch ourselves, figurative stone in hand, ready to harshly condemn or judge someone? Maybe it is someone we don't agree with politically. Perhaps it is someone who has intentionally or unintentionally wronged us. Perchance it is someone of whom we are envious. Conceivably it is someone who looks different than we do or comes from a different place, or lives a different lifestyle, or speaks a different language. Jesus tells us, “Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone.”

Those powerful words of Jesus must challenge every Christian in today's world. They echo words of Jesus in Matthew 7 that say, “Judge not lest you be judged.” Today's society, especially the politically charged society of late, really allows, permits, and maybe even encourages harsh judgment and finger pointing. Jesus' behavior and his words in the Gospel remind us of how we are called to live. I think the words and actions of our Lord can inspire and challenge.

Sinless as he was, Jesus also refused to condemn the woman (and her nameless and un-accused partner!) caught in adultery. He also refuses to condemn us. In the Sacraments of the Church, Jesus offers the mercy and love of God. We have just a short time before we celebrate the Easter mysteries. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a great way to hear the words that Jesus spoke to the woman, “Nor do I condemn you,” and the words of the confessor, “Through the ministry of the Church, may God grant you pardon and peace... I absolve you of your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” On Tuesday at 6 pm at Saint Joseph Church (and every Saturday at 9 am) we have the opportunity for individual Sacramental Reconciliation. I encourage you to make time for the Sacrament in the next couple of weeks or during the Easter Season. Then, forgiven, we can do our part to forgive others, and bring peace to our fractured global community. We can put the stones down. We can allow God's love to prevail. When we do, we win.

From the Pastor's desk...

Over the past several months, a committee comprised of parishioners and staff members has been looking at all our facilities, from 805 Greenleaf on the east to The Saint Joseph School Annex on the west. Early last week the committee shared with me its recommendations. They were somewhat alarmed at the amount of deferred maintenance on the campuses and were struck by the need for space for gatherings, classes, and meetings. We will create a comprehensive list of capital needs and present them to parishioners soon.

The major immediate recommendations from the committee are the divestment of the residential property (now being rented) at 805 Greenleaf, and the demolition (or divestment) of the convent adjacent to Saint Joseph School. I brought the recommendations to the Parish Pastoral Council and the Finance Committee. There is unanimous agreement among the members of these advisory committees that this is the time to divest 805 Greenleaf. Working with selling brokers who have agreed to donate 100% of their proceeds from the sale, we have begun the process to explore the sale. The Finance Committee will weigh in during its next meeting regarding the use of the proceeds of the potential sale. The cost to demolish the convent at Saint Joseph promises to be more than \$400,000. It will take fewer than 10 years to recoup that cost. We still are determining how to finance the demolition, which is our preference, to add green space to the early childhood center of our school.
