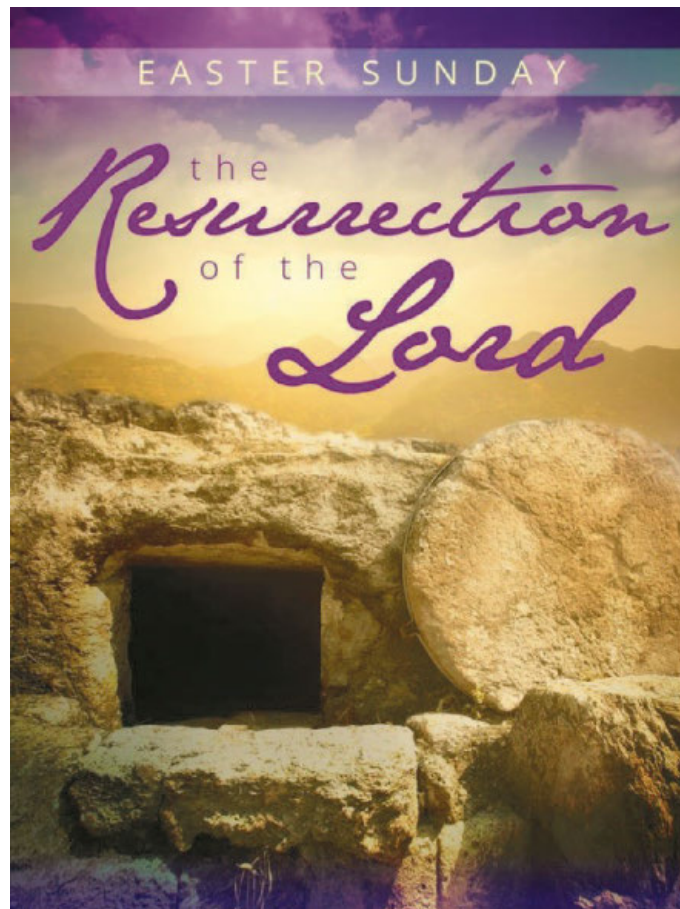

Dear Friends,

Break out your Glorias; unpack your Alleluias! Jesus' power over sin and death gives us reason to sing. Jesus has robbed death of its victory.

At the Easter Vigil, after hearing the seven beautiful accounts from the Hebrew Scriptures of God's hand in Salvation history, we listen to Saint Paul's confident address to the people of Rome. He says clearly, *"If then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him."*

The past few days, even weeks, we have witnessed in the Gospels – and throughout the globe - a sense of competition, between good and evil, between life and death, between God's ways and the ways of the world. The competition heightened during the Paschal Triduum. From the Last Supper to the crucifixion, to the tomb, one might think that Jesus was losing the contest, that evil was conquering good. In these difficult, war-torn times, it might be easy to believe that the story ends on Friday. So many people, this year more than ever, are feeling like they are on the losing end, that they really could die, or have died, with Jesus.

The fact remains. In Baptism, we all die with Jesus. We die to original sin; we die to an old way of life. *That* death offers life. On this Easter weekend we rejoice and sing our long-lost alleluias because of the life offered. At the beginning of the passage from his letter to the Romans, Saint Paul asks, *"Brothers and sisters: Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?"* He reminds us of God's divine reasoning. *"We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life."* Jesus Wins! So do we.

I wonder what it means for you to live in newness of life. Living in Christ demands a change, a different way of living. Passion, compassion, and mercy constitute life in Christ. In the Easter Gospels, those that first heard the good news of the Resurrection immediately and urgently conveyed the news to anyone who would listen. Allow their contagious enthusiasm to infect you. As we are invited to live in newness of life, let's do so compassionately, passionately, mercifully, and enthusiastically.

If you are here for the first time this weekend, please know that you are welcome here. All are welcome at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier. Consider making this parish your spiritual home. The people of Saints JFX are truly alive in the love of Christ. Great things happen here. Join us. Become part of the victory. Become part of our parish community. Share your self, your gifts. I promise that if you do, you will not be disappointed.



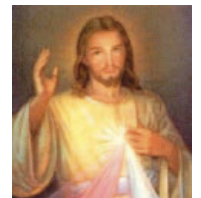

## Easter 2022

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,


As we gather this year to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection, we cannot avoid our circumstances. Shadows of sin and death loom large over us. The pandemic, our experience of social unrest and daily violence on our streets, and, of course, the horrors of war in Ukraine and other parts of the world—all remind us how much we need the Lord's redemptive and healing power in our lives.

Our source of hope amid these challenges is anchored in all that we have witnessed in the liturgies of Holy Week. We have celebrated that the Lord Jesus entered into the fullness of our human experience. He went to the very darkest edges of that human experience. He entered into our suffering, struggle, and even our desperation, when he cried out on the cross, "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?" He squarely faced sin and death on the cross.

And it was precisely in the moment he fully emptied himself, placing himself totally in the hands of God, that he was raised up from the dead victorious. But, his rising from the dead is not just a matter of his personal vindication. He came back from the dead for us, to give us a share in his victory. This is what takes place in our Baptism, which is confirmed in the Holy Spirit, and sustained by the Eucharist. He lives in us, and his victory over sin and death lives in us as well.

As Pope Francis reminds us, we need to share the victory of the resurrection with others, as Jesus did with us. We do this by being sisters and brothers to one another. As Church, we are a family of faith that walks with each other in moments of pain, struggle, and grief, keeping alive the promise that Jesus, the victor over sin and death, remains with us. We are never abandoned. My prayer for all of us in the Archdiocese of Chicago is that we will stand firm in hope, confident that the One who has gone before us in death has come back from the dead for us. May the peace of the Risen Lord be with you and those you love.
