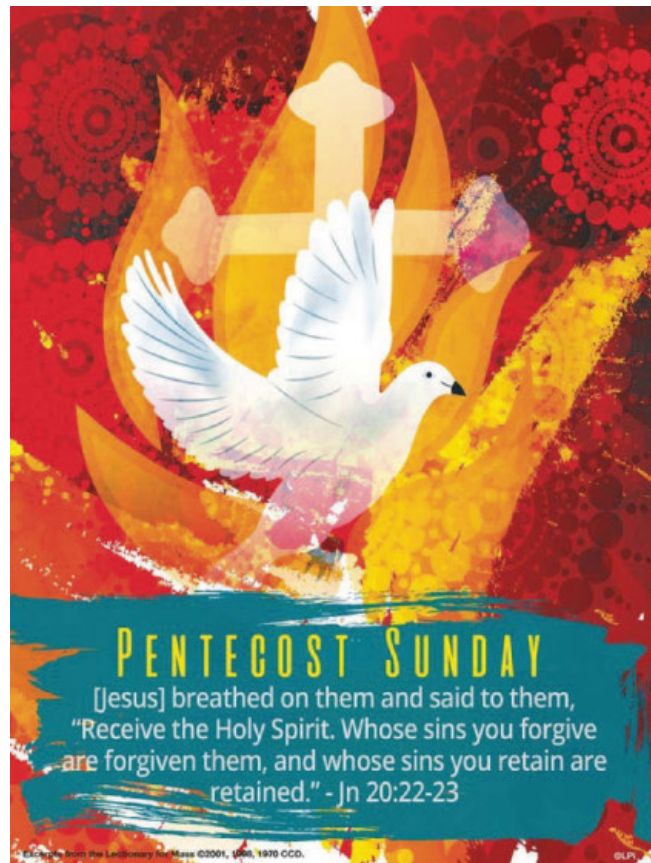

Dear Friends,

The HS! I cannot even count the number of times I have invoked, referred to, or relied on the person of the Holy Trinity represented by those two letters. Today, we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. We wish happy birthday to our living Church. We become aware of the power of the Holy Spirit and its movement and action in our universal Church and in our local Church. Without doubt the Holy Spirit is moving, acting and urging at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier

Today we commemorate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the disciples, the fulfillment of Jesus' paschal mystery. For centuries, the Saints of the Church have rejoiced in the power of the Holy Spirit and what it can do to the Christian. We must allow the Spirit to move in us, to change us and to fill us with the fire of His love.

In the Collect for Mass this weekend, we pray, "O God, who by the mystery of today's great feast sanctify your whole Church in every people and nation, pour out, we pray, the gifts of the Holy Spirit across the face of the earth and, with the divine grace that was at work when the Gospel was first proclaimed, fill now once more the hearts of believers. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever." What a great prayer! Now we just need to show God that we mean it.

We need to really demonstrate our openness to having our hearts filled with the gifts of the Spirit, and our willingness to receive that great gift. We can do that by ridding ourselves of our own willful spirits, the egocentric ones that say, "My will be done," rather than, "Thy will be done." We need to lose the fear that prevents us from acting according to the will of God. Our willingness and God's generosity combine to prepare a heart ready for the Spirit.

God is ready to pour out the Spirit. Jesus, repeatedly in the pre and post resurrection narratives, assures his disciples that the gift of the Spirit will come. Once they finally open their hearts to the gift (It took Jesus more than one try, you know.) amazing things happen in the Church. We hear about those amazing things in the readings today. Trust and openness to the guidance of the Holy Spirit demand action. Are you ready to act?

Saints JFX parish and school continue to grow and thrive because people are willing to allow the Spirit to move them and urge them to act. We share the gifts that God has given us.

This week we kick off an intense push to **Share Our Gifts** with the students of Saint Thomas of Canterbury School. **The Invest in Kids Tax Credit Scholarship Program** is one of Illinois' best kept secrets. For the cost of 25% of the donation, all Illinois taxpayers can receive a full tax credit (not deduction!) off the bottom line of their tax liability to the State of Illinois. Donors can designate the K-12 school where they want their donation directed. Wouldn't you rather see your tax dollars directly supporting Saint Thomas kids than go into the black hole of the Illinois government?



We solicited and have funded the nearly \$70,000 TCS money needed for Saints JFX School. All eligible students will receive the scholarship. As partners with Saint Thomas, we commit to helping them too. In a sense, we live the spirit of Pentecost – honoring the universality of the Church. 100% of the 320 Students at Saint Thomas are eligible for this great scholarship opportunity. As of May 31<sup>st</sup> 106 students remain on the waitlist. Did you know that 47 different languages are spoken in the homes of Saint Thomas students? Pentecost really comes alive in that place.

We would like to **Share Our Gifts** to eliminate the waitlist and provide educational opportunities to these deserving students. Please see the materials in today's bulletin and in the eblasts this week. The process (especially for first time donors) is a bit tedious, but we have dedicated people to help, and providing a Catholic education to a child growing up in poverty in the city of Chicago is well worth it. We hope to raise \$600,000 to fill the gap. We have lead TCS donors from our great community who have challenged us to give. While the goal is lofty, no TCS gift is too small.

Open your hearts. Receive and share God's gifts of love. And live always with the ever-faithful HS!

## Share Our Gifts with Tax Credit Scholarships

“Our relationship with St. Thomas offers Saints JFX parishioners incredible opportunities to live their discipleship...We are one body of Christ and one church, no matter what the ZIP Code.” - Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Sharing Parish Commitment

Illinois' bipartisan Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program provides need-based scholarships for students to attend K-12 private schools, like our sharing parish partner St. Thomas of Canterbury. Donors who give through our scholarship granting partner Empower Illinois in support of these scholarships receive a 75% state income tax credit on their gift and can direct their donation to St. Thomas of Canterbury.

And there has never been a better time to take advantage of the Tax Credit Scholarship Program.

A generous group of parishioners have pledged gifts for a Cornerstone Match to help clear the waitlist of students eligible for tax credit scholarships at St. Thomas of Canterbury School. Gifts made to St. Thomas of Canterbury through the Share Our Gifts campaign will be matched \$1 for \$1 to clear the waitlist of students, which means that **for every dollar you donate an additional dollar will be donated to St. Thomas of Canterbury, our Sharing Parish School.** But we must act fast! The matching gift program will only last through June, or until matching funds are depleted.

With this match, if you make a \$3,000 tax credit scholarship gift:

- You earn a \$2,250 state tax credit
- You are only out of pocket \$750
- Your donation will be matched (\$1 to \$1) to become \$6,000
- You fund a FULL scholarship for a child in need
