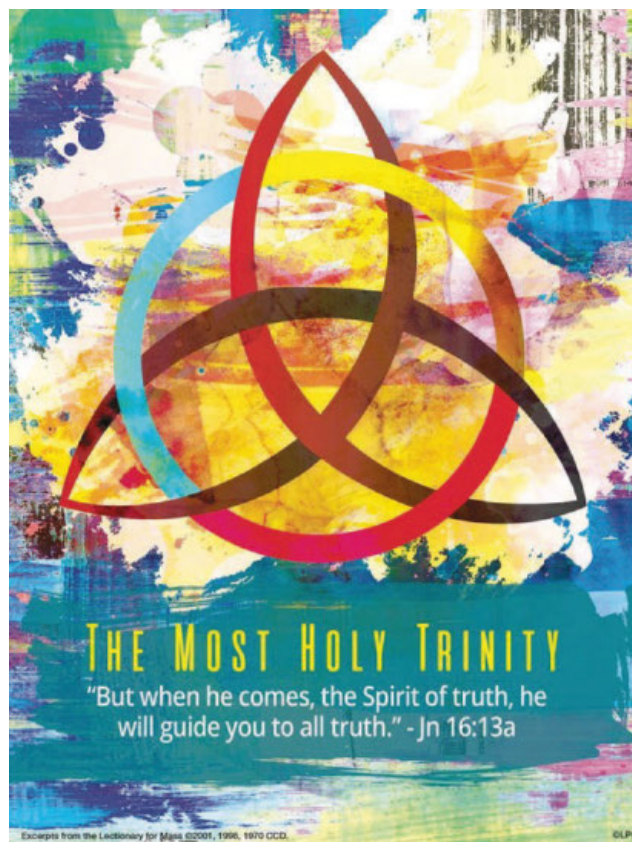

Dear Friends,

You may remember our parish survey. In that survey, we learned that members of Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier look for community. You value community and place high value on relationships. We are making decisions and plans based on your feedback. We will find ways to foster community and build relationships. Deepak Devaraj, our Parish Pastoral Council chair, exclaims that the survey results demand that we deliver "community with a fire hose." The "we" who must deliver community is all of us.

The Stewardship Committee, the School Board and the Parish Pastoral Council all have set the building of community and fostering relationships as primary goals. When we come together as the body of Christ, when we share fellowship, when we hold each other up, we become the relational community Jesus calls us to be. Underlying our human connectedness, though, must be our connection with God, who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

We connect with our Triune God when we pray. Even the sign of the cross constitutes prayer. It reminds us of their relationship, and ours with them. It makes sense to stop and reflect on the power of the relationship and the power we have when we immerse ourselves in that relationship.

Today's solemnity celebrates not an event, but a reality, and reminds us that all we are and all we do as Christians must be done in the name of (and with the inspiration of, and guidance of, and relying on the power of...) the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The solemnity of today also teaches that we are invited to be in relationship with God, and one another. At Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier, we try to do just that!

We need and want you to be involved, to act, and to relate one with the other. We cannot have a passive community. We need an active one. We need a relational community that moves and acts and gives and shares. This is not a service station, where people just come and take what they need and drive off. We are a family of faith, a community in relationship. We need the connectedness and affiliation, involvement and dedication of all the members to be successful.

The community of the Father and Son and Holy Spirit, in an interrelated way, promotes action and involvement. The Father creates. The Son redeems and the Spirit sanctifies. Those verbs are not passive ones. Everything the Triune God does is done out of pure love. Pure love acting in relationship makes great things happen. Pure love created

the world. Pure love came down from heaven to be one with us and to suffer and die for us. Pure love moves in the Church, to guide and protect us. Pure love invites us to participate in the love of the Triune God and to bring that love into the world. Relating, though, with the Triune God, I mean really relating, requires selflessness and conversion, and absolutely demands action. Are you ready to act?



We must put our hope in our Triune God—even when we face affliction. Because, as Saint Paul reminds us, "Hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us."

So, we allow the love of the Father, Son, and Spirit to motivate us and to call us into action. For the Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier community to grow and succeed, we must, I repeat, we *must* focus on how we are relating to one another and to God. When we allow God to impel us into action, we will be unable to avoid relationships with one another. Because the Holy Spirit has poured the love of God into our hearts, we must share that love with those around us. That's the challenge of the Christian life.

Think about your relationships, especially your relationship with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Build that alliance. Pull out the fire hose and deliver community. Live the love!

Illinois' bipartisan Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program provides need-based scholarships for students to attend K-12 private schools, like our sharing parish partner St. Thomas of Canterbury. Donors who give through our scholarship granting partner Empower Illinois in support of these scholarships receive a 75% state income tax credit on their gift and can direct their donation to St. Thomas of Canterbury.

And there has never been a better time to take advantage of the Tax Credit Scholarship Program.

A generous group of parishioners have pledged gifts for a Cornerstone Match to help clear the waitlist of students eligible for tax credit scholarships at St. Thomas of Canterbury School. 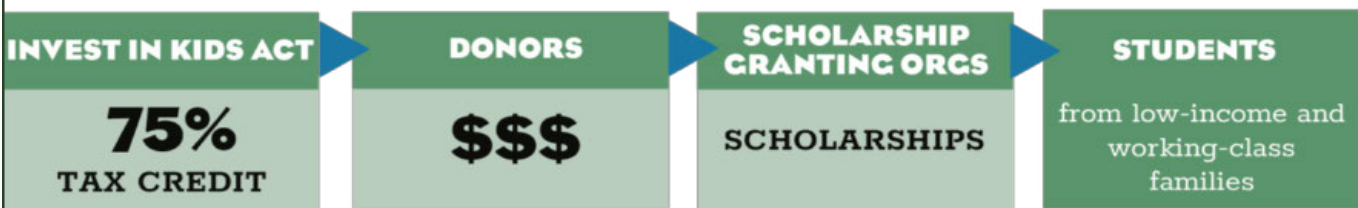

**THE TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM: HOW IT WORKS**



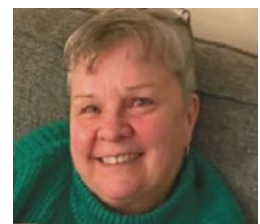

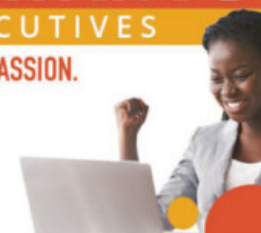
