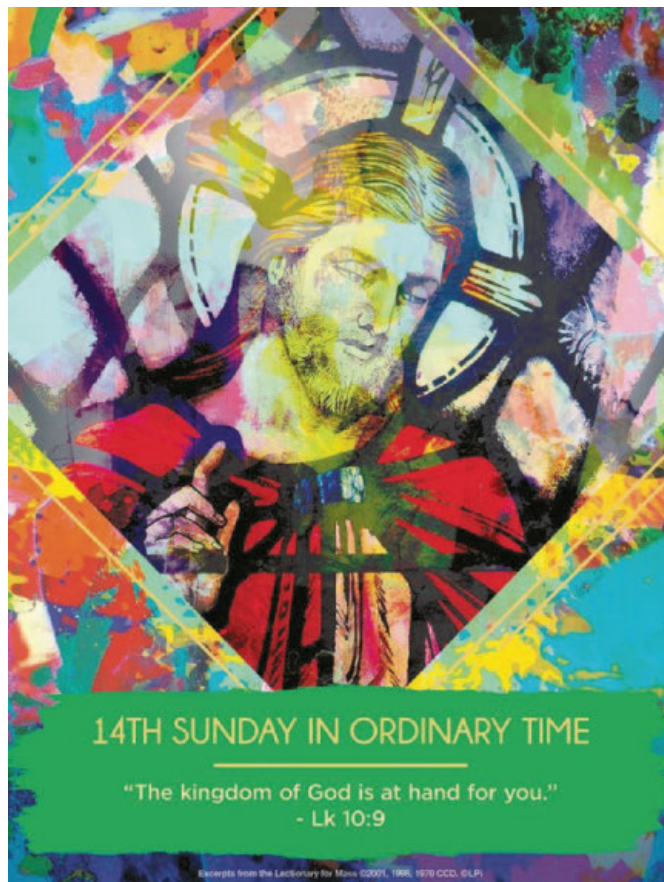

Dear Friends,

Rejoice! A few times in the readings for this weekend, we are reminded to rejoice. I love the final line of the Gospel, when Jesus says, "Nevertheless, do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

Isaiah reminds his people, and us, that God's power and mercy should cause us to rejoice. He says, "*When you see this, your heart shall rejoice and your bodies flourish like the grass; the Lord's power shall be known to his servants.*"

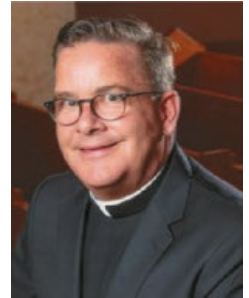
And the psalmist sings, "*Let all the earth cry out to God with joy. Shout joyfully to God, all the earth, sing praise to the glory of his name; proclaim his glorious praise. Say to God, 'How tremendous are your deeds!'*"

As we mark three years as a unified parish this weekend, I reflect joyfully on all that God has accomplished here. Even during a pandemic unlike anything we have ever seen before, this parish has experienced the love and mercy of God and the guidance of the Holy Spirit. I have countless stories of the ways that God has moved hearts here - and changed lives. Certainly, the transition has been difficult for some, but coming together praising God, and working together for the good of the Church, we have accomplished so much, thanks to God's tremendous deeds and his merciful love.

As we reflect on God's merciful love, and rejoice in all that God does here, we still must do more. We must continue to strive for individual and collective holiness, and for daily conversion. We cannot rest until each of us claims a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and commits to living a life with Christ and allowing Christ to work through him or her. Jesus did work with him through his disciples. He gave them power. He trusted them with his mission. And they rejoiced when they saw his power working through them.

On Pentecost Sunday, we launched an ambitious campaign, *Sharing Our Gifts*. For more than 30 years people from Wilmette have been helping the refugees and immigrants in the uptown area of Chicago who are served by Saint Thomas of Canterbury (STC). We do this by donating to the food pantry, rolling up our sleeves and distributing the food there or at the soup kitchen, tutoring and mentoring school students, and contributing to the monthly second collection on Sunday to support Saint Thomas of Canterbury school. On June 5th, we commenced the *Sharing Our Gifts* campaign - a way to direct our tax dollars to STC school.

For several years now, the state of Illinois has had a tax credit scholarship program (TCS). Instead of paying taxes to the state of Illinois, anyone with tax liability can donate to a scholarship granting organization (SGO). Working with Empower Illinois, we hope to eliminate any waitlist for the eligible students at Saint Thomas of Canterbury. Chris Wallace has worked tirelessly encouraging donors to create a match fund from our parish. We now have reached the \$300,000 match goal. These match dollars were contributed by a small group of parishioners. I am so grateful for their generosity and their dedication to Catholic education.



Now that we have met the \$300,000 match goal, we must raise \$300,000 more from the rest of us to eliminate the waitlist at STC. I remind you that 75% of your donation comes off the bottom line of what you owe to the State of Illinois. It's an amazing way to support Catholic education and ensure a bright future for the refugees and immigrants who make up the student body at Saint Thomas of Canterbury. I encourage you, if you've not done so, to start the process as soon as possible. We hope to get the needed commitments this month or next so that the tuitions can be guaranteed before the start of school. If you need help with the process, you can contact Empower Illinois by phone at 800-616-7606 or their website www.empowerillinois.org.

Father Ryan and I have already made our TCS pledge to Saint Thomas. I've used this philanthropic vehicle for the past four years. I just figure out what I project to owe the state, add 25%, and donate that amount to Empower. I pick the school to which the donation will go (this year - Saint Thomas of Canterbury) and Empower Illinois does the rest. No gift is too small. We hope that people will consider a \$3,000 TCS donation (with a net cost to the donor of \$750). That amount, added to the match will cover one student's tuition for a year at STC.

Share Our Gifts with Tax Credit Scholarships

Illinois' bipartisan Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program provides need-based scholarships for students to attend K-12 private schools, like our sharing parish partner St. Thomas of Canterbury. Donors who give through our scholarship granting partner Empower Illinois in support of these scholarships receive a 75% state income tax credit on their gift and can direct their donation to St. Thomas of Canterbury.

And there has never been a better time to take advantage of the Tax Credit Scholarship Program.

A generous group of parishioners have pledged gifts for a Cornerstone Match to help clear the waitlist of students eligible for tax credit scholarships at St. Thomas of Canterbury School. Gifts made to St. Thomas of Canterbury through the Share Our Gifts campaign will be matched \$1 for \$1 to clear the waitlist of students, which means that **for every dollar you donate an additional dollar will be donated to St. Thomas of Canterbury, our Sharing Parish School**. But we must act fast! The matching gift program will only last through June, or until matching funds are depleted.

With this match, if you make a \$3,000 tax credit scholarship gift:

- You earn a \$2,250 state tax credit
- You are only out of pocket \$750

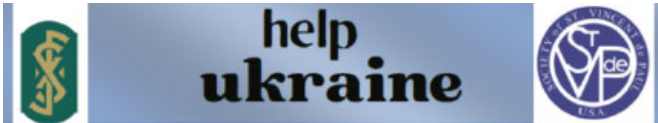
