Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Happy New Year! I look back and can't believe our parish has just had its third anniversary. It's amazing to think about where we started, where we are now, and the continued potential in front of us. Over the course of the next year, I have three major projects planned that will help keep our parish moving in a positive direction.



First we are in the midst of a payroll and HR systems transformation. In the spring we learned that the Archdiocese awarded a new system contract and that the first stage of implementation (payroll) will go live in October. This should not affect any outward facing operations of ours but as with any system transition, I expect there to be bumps along the way. I mention this as it will help bring much efficiency to our back-end operations, and the time savings will allow us to redirect even more effort toward the more important things we do.

Speaking of system transitions, we have recently partnered with ParishStaq and are in the process of launching a new parish database. We talked to a number of parishes that started using this system over the past few years and have received nothing but positive feedback. It's truly a modern, integrated solution that will allow an amazing amount of data unification. We currently have multiple stand-alone systems that we will integrate. As part of this system transition, we will be able to provide our parishioners with log in access to view information about their household as well as their giving history and parish news. The system will also allow our ministries to form groups to track in a central location what our people are involved in and allow us to better communicate specific and timely information to people. Lastly, as part of this process, we are also building an app! The app will give people access to the system right on their phone. Please keep an eye out for future updates.

Lastly, we will be working on a detailed deferred maintenance report. We have made a number of improvements to our campus over the past three years. These improvements addressed some of the most obvious needs across our facilities. With that said, we still need to make a number of additional, major improvements. We will finalize this report over the course of the next 12 months and share the findings with all of you. Keeping our buildings in good working order is something that can fly under the radar but is critically important.

I'm looking forward to the year ahead, and hope to see you at our parish party on Tuesday at St. Joseph.

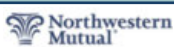
