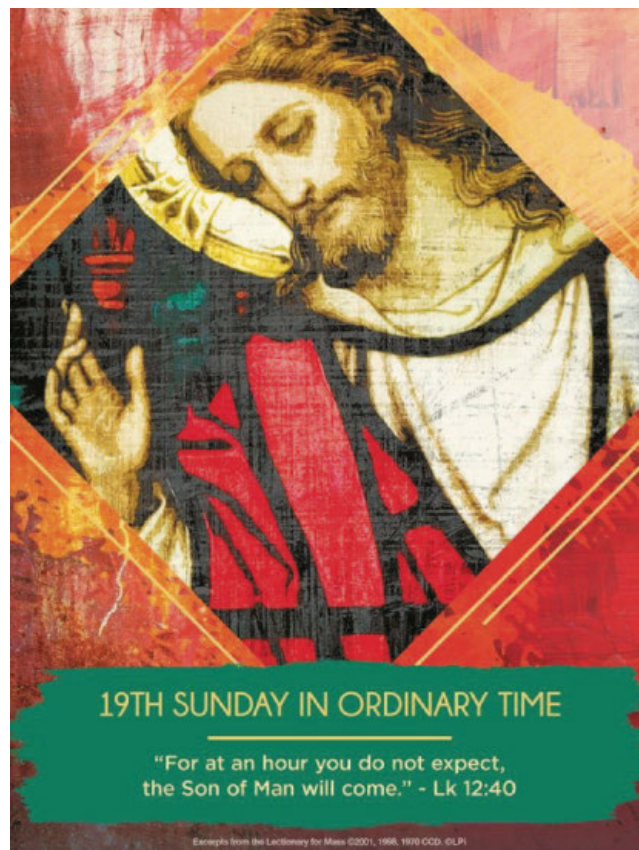

Dear Friends,

“Faith is the realization of what is hoped for, and evidence of things not seen.” Those words of Saint Paul ring very true. They can be summarized by saying, “Faith believes that no matter what, God will give us what we need.” I write this as we wind down our pilgrimage to Lourdes and Fatima. Pilgrimage, in general, requires faith. This year, more than ever, our pilgrims (and their leader!) needed to put their trust in God.

Some of you may have heard the story of this year's pilgrimage beginning. We found out, about sixty hours before departure, that our 32 seats on TAP Portuguese Airlines had been removed from the airline's passenger list. We received no explanation as to why, but we had to scramble and find flights for 32 people to get to Lourdes on time to do our service work. We originally were going to fly in and out of Lisbon. Our original itinerary had us arriving in Lourdes the day before the diocese of Belley-Ars did. We try to get to Lourdes early so that I can prepare the pilgrims for the work ahead. We were supposed to go to Fatima first. TAP dashed those plans.

Getting flights to Europe has been especially challenging this year, so we had plenty to fear. The prospect of having to cancel the whole pilgrimage was real. Before Mass on that Friday morning, the 22nd of July, when I was retelling the information that I had received minutes before Mass, one of the regular 6:30 Mass goers challenged me to put my cares and fears at the feet of the Lord and to have faith. I did just that, and as I should have expected, God provided what we needed.

We left on the day we had planned, arrived Lourdes the day before the Belley-Ars did, and returned one day later than we planned, but still on time for me to be home for Sunday Mass and for the people on the pilgrimage to make their obligations back home. We were able to help the sick at Lourdes and visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. We flew into Paris and out of Lisbon (at least we all have confirmed seats on United for Saturday as I write this!). The pilgrimage was fruitful, and lives were changed. God is good and God provides.

I am sure everyone reading this missive has had an experience of the providence of God, of God entrusting us with much. Jesus tells us in the Gospel that, “Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be required of the one entrusted with more.” That's us! God has entrusted us with much and more. We must be ready when the master comes and knocks at our door.

Jesus says, “Gird your loins and light your lamps and be like servants who await their master's return from a wedding, ready to open immediately when he comes and knocks... You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come.” I read this passage from



Saint Luke's Gospel often. Interestingly, the creators of the Catholic Funeral Rites Book provide this Gospel for the Vigil Service for the deceased. I stand in front of the deceased proclaiming these words. The words shake me, and I bet they shake those people whom I face at the wake.

Jesus doesn't use this image to frighten us, but to remind us that since we have been given much, we should respond with the same benevolence and generosity that we have received from our God, who is the giver of all good gifts. Since we know not the day nor the hour, we must live like it could be today, which it very well could.

Jesus describes the one who thinks that the master will be delayed in coming; the one who mistreats those around him, and fails to respect them; the one who abuses the authority and the gifts that the master has given. He says that one will be punished severely.

So, on this nineteenth Sunday in ordinary time, we celebrate God's providence, and we focus on preparedness. In gratitude, we act like those servants, and our readiness will display itself in kindness, mercy, and love.
