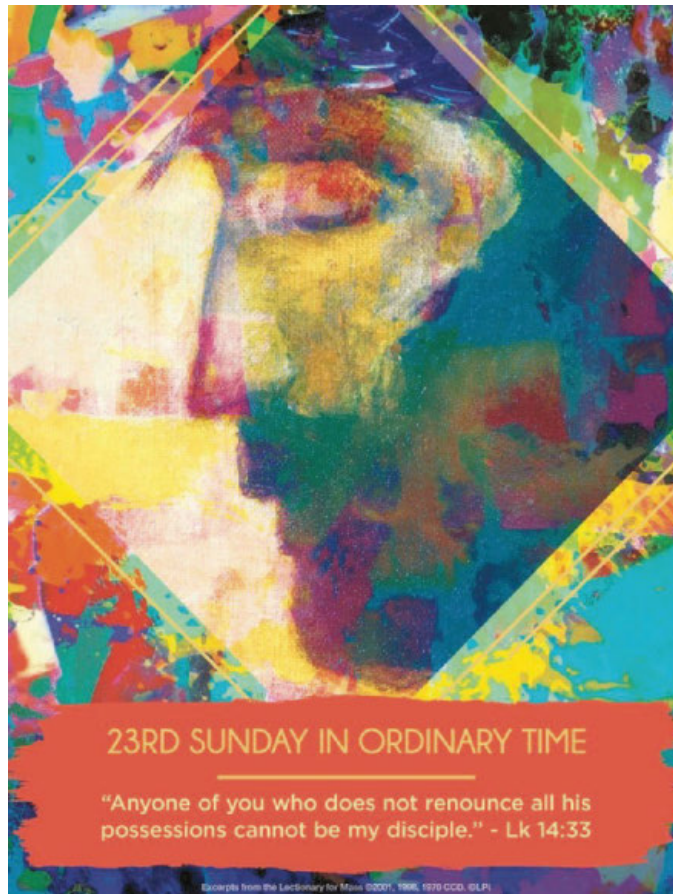

Dear Friends,

On Tuesday, I had a quarterly meeting with Bishop Bartosic, his vicariate team, and the other deans of Vicariate 2. One of the topics was “tilling the soil” and another dealt with the Cross. We conducted the meeting at the residence of the Little Sisters of the Poor, and it happened to be on the feast day of the founder of the Little Sisters of the Poor, Saint Jeanne Jugan. Talk about providence! Earlier that morning on the online Rosary, the leader invoked Jeanne Jugan. Her name sounds like “John” in English. I had never heard of that saint before.

When I arrived at the home of the Little Sisters of the Poor, Bishop Bartosic announced that it was the feast of their founder, and that her statue was right outside the front door. I thought, “That’s the one we asked to pray for us this morning,” I thought by the pronunciation on the Rosary in the morning that Jeanne was a man! Knowing the charisma and the great work of the religious order she founded, I was happy to “meet her” on her feast. These wonderful sisters care deeply for the ones that God entrusts to them. They welcome the poorest of the poor. Their mission and vision speak volumes and resonate with the love with which Jeanne Jugan filled her life.

*Together with a diverse network of collaborators, we serve the elderly poor in over 30 countries around the world. Continuing the work of Saint Jeanne Jugan, our **MISSION** is to offer the neediest elderly of every race and religion a home where they will be welcomed as Christ, cared for as family and accompanied with dignity until God calls them to himself. Our **VISION** is to contribute to the Culture of Life by nurturing communities where each person is valued, the solidarity of the human family and the wisdom of age are celebrated, and the compassionate love of Christ is shared with all.*

The poor elderly in over thirty countries have enjoyed the fruits of the tilled soil. Jeanne Jugan succeeded in tilling the soil because of her closeness to Christ. She led by example and shared her wisdom with her sisters. She once told her sisters, “*Jesus is waiting for you in the chapel. Go and find him when your strength and patience are giving out, when you feel lonely and helpless. Say to him: ‘You know well what is happening, my dear Jesus. I have only you. Come to my aid....’ And then go your way. And don’t worry about*

knowing how you are going to manage. It is enough to have told our good Lord. He has an excellent memory.” Saint Jeanne Jugan tilled the soil and carried her cross.

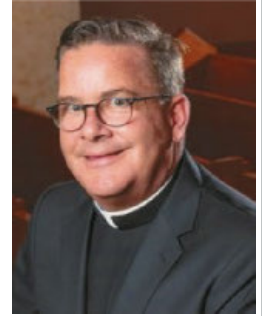
Crosses. Many people carry them. Some do anything they can to avoid the burden of sacrifice or cross carrying. Today Jesus makes it completely clear. “Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple.” A cross demands sacrifice. If we want to call ourselves disciples, we must seek the wisdom of God as Solomon did in the first reading today and really aspire to do God’s will, not our own will – a tough task.

If Jesus is our all in all, if our relationship with the Lord really is the most important of our relationships, then we must continue to learn from his words and actions. In his living, acting, welcoming, preaching, teaching, healing, forgiving, loving, and promising, Jesus reveals a big heart, a generous spirit, a complete surrender to the will of the Father.

One priest at my meeting reminded us that the Cross of Jesus is total surrender to God. Jesus invites us in the Gospel to come after him, to join him in surrendering to the will of God. We, “coming after” him, can surrender if we allow ourselves to die to selfish desires and willingly and with a big soul, take up our own crosses. Sure, it is counter cultural, but it will produce great fruit, especially those of peace and joy.

Think of the cross you carry. Do you bear the burden with hope? Do you accept the cross uncomplainingly? Our Lord said we must follow Him. Coming after Jesus, following the Lord requires much of us, but will lead us to great joy.

Please note...the following communication was shared with our Saints JFX School community earlier this week:

We regret to share that the Field and Sport Court at Saints JFX School have been continually littered and vandalized over the past several months. Fireworks have burned holes in the turf, the sport court screen has been broken numerous times, benches have been left hanging from basketball hoops on bungee cords, and trash has been left almost daily strewn across the field. On the recommendation of the Wilmette Police Department, our school has added "No Trespassing" signs to our Field and Sport Court. As we work to control this recent problem and to protect our school field, **we ask that children only use our outdoor spaces when supervised by a parent, and when these spaces are not being used by After Care, athletics, or other school programs.** While we strive to make our outdoor facilities available to everyone, we are focused at this time on repairing and recovering these areas so that they remain functioning and safe spaces for our K-8 students during the school day. 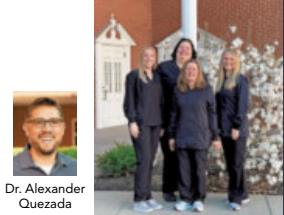
