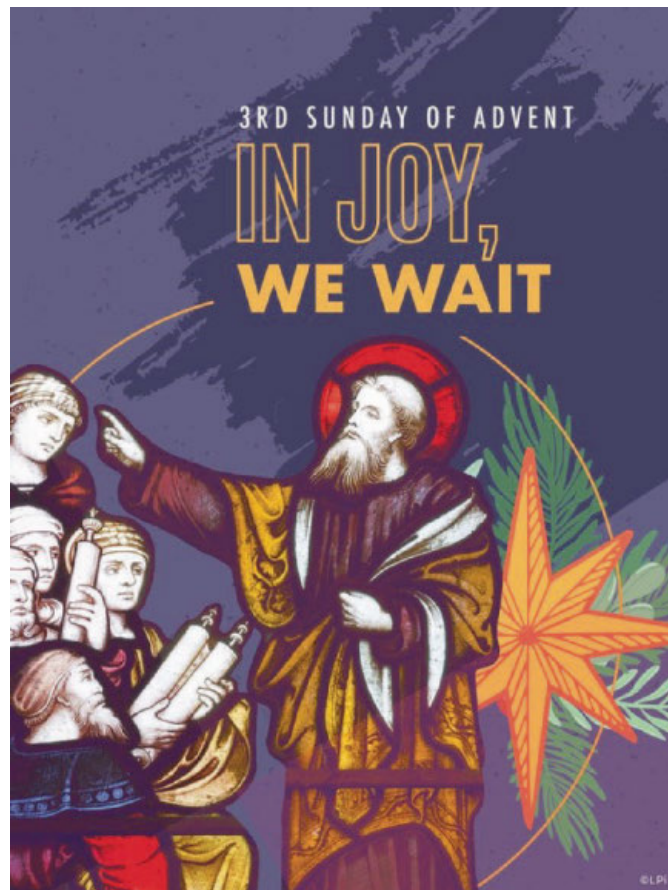

Dear Friends,

Be joyful! Today we celebrate Gaudete Sunday. Two weeks from today we will proclaim that Emmanuel has come, and invite all to adore him. Violence still plagues our city and harsh words still fly regarding race, law enforcement and politics (among other things). We still have to experience the darkest days of our calendar year, yet the liturgy calls us to rejoice. Why should we?

My joy starts with gratitude. For so many reasons, I thank God. Mostly, I praise and thank God for your goodness, your generosity, and your willingness to lend a hand, to support those in need, to commit to making great things happen in this parish and beyond.

One thing that is new and exciting and is on the horizon is the renewal and revitalization of the Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Men's Club.

The survey we took a year ago indicated a longing for community. We identified the need to engage and support men of the parish more actively. The Parish Pastoral Council made the reinstitution of Saints JFX Men's Club a priority. Using the tools and the history of the Men's Club and the Dad's Club, we are combining resources and need your help.

I call all men of the parish to get involved. I'm asking you more than just to consider; I'm asking you to actively participate. Whether you're a dad or not, no matter your age, your children's age, whether you're married or single, we need and want you.

The Saints JFX Men's Club will build community, with a three-pillar focus on spirituality, service, and social events. There will be something for everyone and all are welcome to share their gifts. The attached plan for the men's club describes 15 leadership positions along with their respective responsibilities and the required time commitment. Once these positions are filled, we will begin hosting meetings in 2023.

Building community is essential to the proclamation of the kingdom of God. It's a key leg on which we stand to becoming a vibrant faith filled parish. Know that I pray for you and your families daily and that I am honored to walk with you as your pastor. I look forward to the rapid growth and development of Saints JFX Men's Club.

Over the last few weeks, hundreds of wish list ornaments were taken from our "Giving Tree." At last week's Masses, we brought, along with the gifts of bread and wine, presents for children and families to brighten their Christmas. December 25th will be a great day for those enrolled in the program - and really for all of us - because the spirit of giving, inspired by the gift of the Christ Child, lives on here.



None of this is done on our own. With my whole heart, I believe that all the great things that happen here directly result from God's power and the gift of the Holy Spirit. God authors, guides and protects the work. Jesus told John's disciples when they questioned whether he was "the one who is to come," "Go and report what you see and hear." In a sense, that's what I do in this piece. I report the power of Christ moving in the hearts of this great community. As I reflect on it, I am grateful - and my gratitude causes my joy.

Finally, the solemn blessing at the end of the advent Mass says in part, "As you run the race of this present life, may God make you firm in faith, joyful in hope and active in charity." Let's live that blessing during the busyness of these final fourteen days of Advent.

Rejoice. The Lord is near.

Dear Friends in Christ,


On the Third Sunday of Advent, our parishes will be conducting the Retirement Fund for Religious collection, an annual appeal that benefits nearly 25,000 elderly sisters, brothers, and religious order priests. Our senior religious are a treasure—both for their service to our Church and for the ways their prayer and witness enrich our faith. “Planted in the house of the Lord, they shall flourish in the courts of our God. 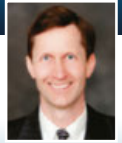
