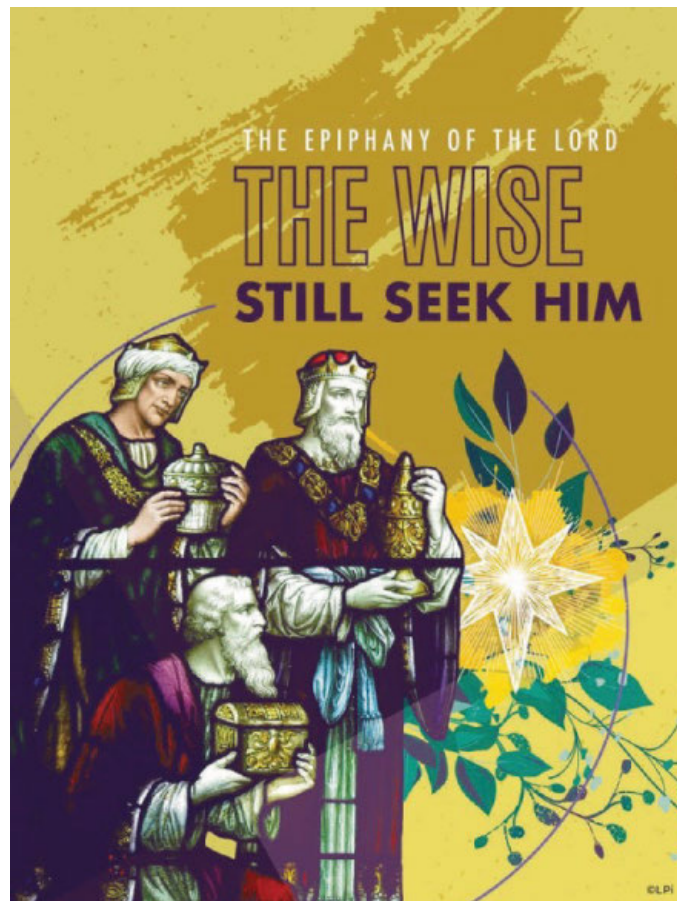

Dear Friends,

***And they opened their treasures and offered him gifts.*** We've been doing a lot offering of gifts lately. I think about two thousand passed through the rectory and the churches as we prepared for Christmas, providing gifts to the needy families of Catholic Charities. The generosity of the gift-givers amazed me. I thank the Women's Club for spearheading this project. So, as you offered gifts this year, you helped families that needed it this year more than ever. On their behalf, and on behalf of the staff of Saints JFX, I offer heartfelt thanks.

Allow me to thank you, too, for your incredible response to the boiler appeal. As I write this on Tuesday evening, just two weeks after the failure of the SFX church boiler and the news that it couldn't be repaired - and needed to be replaced, as I listen to the humming of the generator out my window, I thank God. I thank God that Joe D' Arco found a quick temporary solution to heat the Church at Christmas, the busiest - and coldest days of the year. I thank God because the great people of Saints JFX responded with open hearts. We have ***collected*** \$125,000 of our \$130,000 expected cost. And the donations for the boiler keep coming in. You amaze me.

As we begin a new year, and celebrate the feast of the Epiphany, we can allow the magi to give us an example of perseverance, faith, and generosity. They longed to see the newborn king of the Jews. They followed the star. They never gave up. And, once they encountered the Christ, they offered him what they had. Too often we allow other things to take priority over encountering the Lord. We get too busy. Passing things take precedence. God-with-us waits for our encounter and we run about doing everything else. Jesus, no longer in a manger, but found in Sacred Scripture and on the Altar at Holy Mass, and in the tabernacle twenty-four hours a day, still awaits us. The messiah resides in our encounters with the poor. Let commit to paying him the homage the magi did.

They never gave up. The magi knew the right thing for them to do was to pay the newborn king homage. They remind us that the Christ Child came for all nations. The King of the Jews is a universal king. Their pilgrimage surely offered them hardship. They did not allow the hardship, (or Herod's hardness of heart) to deter them. Determinedly they set off to find him and urgently they sought him. They knew what they were supposed to do, and they did it. I think in our heart of hearts, we know the right thing for us to do in life situations. Sometimes when it is inconvenient or difficult, we're tempted to give up, to abandon the task at hand, however right it is.

The perseverance of the magi inspires me. I hope it does you too.

Finally, they offered what they had. They did not hold back. They gave the Christ Child gifts of themselves. Fear gets in the way of our giving what we have.

We think we have to hang on to our possessions, time and talents, rather than giving them freely. My experience tells me that when we freely give, we abundantly receive. In this New Year, let's try to give more, more of our time, more of our talents, and more of our treasure. I will. Will you?

Each year, as people are tempted to end the Christmas season on the 26th of December, I remind them and myself that the season of Christmas continues until the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord, this year, Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup>. Keep celebrating Christmas. And as the season winds down, commit to doing the work of Christmas throughout the year.

***When the song of the Angels is stilled,  
When the Star in the sky is gone,  
When the princes are home,  
When the shepherds are back with their flocks,  
The Work of Christmas Begins  
To find the lost,  
To heal the broken,  
To release the prisoner,  
To rebuild the nations,  
To bring peace among people  
To make music in the heart.***

### “May Christ Bless this House”

The Epiphany Door (or House) Blessing is associated with the Feast of the Epiphany. Blessed chalk is used to mark the inside of the main door with the initials of the Magi and a code of the current year, connected with crosses.

This year the markings are: **20 + C + M + B + 23**

While the three letters are the first initial of the names of the three kings (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar), C-M-B also stand for the Latin blessing **Christius Mansionem Benedicat** which means “May Christ Bless this House.”

Small bags with a piece of blessed chalk and the blessing will be available at all Masses this weekend. Please take one home for your family.

Kubicki's bio is below.

Fr. Jim Kubicki was born and raised in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He entered the Jesuits in 1971, was ordained in 1983, and has served his community as vocation director and assistant to the provincial for formation and Native American ministry. From 1989 to 1995 he worked at the Sioux Spiritual Center, a retreat house for Native people and the center for the Rapid City Diocese's Deacon and Lay Ministry Formation program. From 2000-03 he was the Assistant Director of Demontreville, a Jesuit retreat house in Minnesota. He also served as Director of St. Francis Mission on the Rosebud Reservation in western South Dakota from 2017-2022. In 2003 he became the national director of the Apostleship of Prayer, the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network, and traveled around the country giving talks, parish missions, and retreats. He is a regular contributor to the national Catholic media network, Relevant Radio, and appears regularly as well on Catholic radio stations in Nebraska and Ohio. His book "A Heart on Fire: Rediscovering Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus" was published by Ave Maria Press in 2012 and was awarded third place in the category of "Best Prayer and Spirituality Book of the Year" by the Association of Catholic Book Publishers. His second book, "A Year of Daily Offerings," was published in October, 2016. Currently, Fr. Kubicki gives retreats around the country while serving as a spiritual director at the Milwaukee Archdiocesan Seminary.

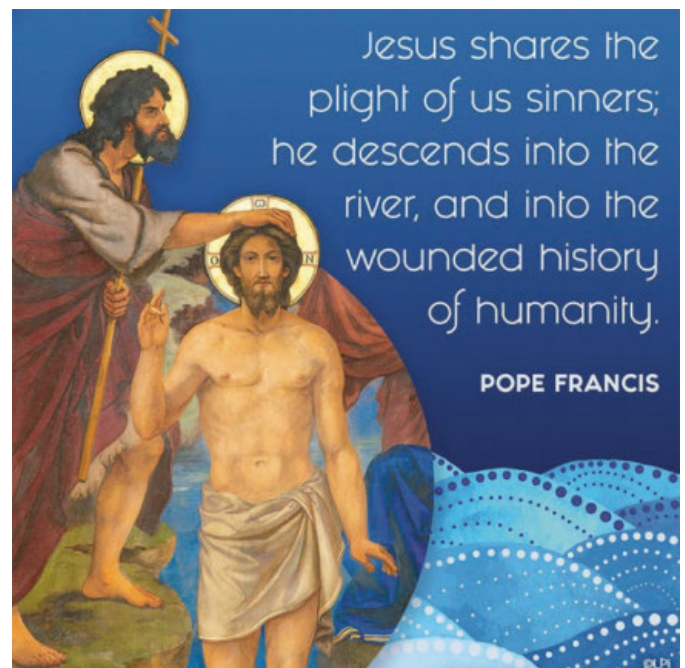
