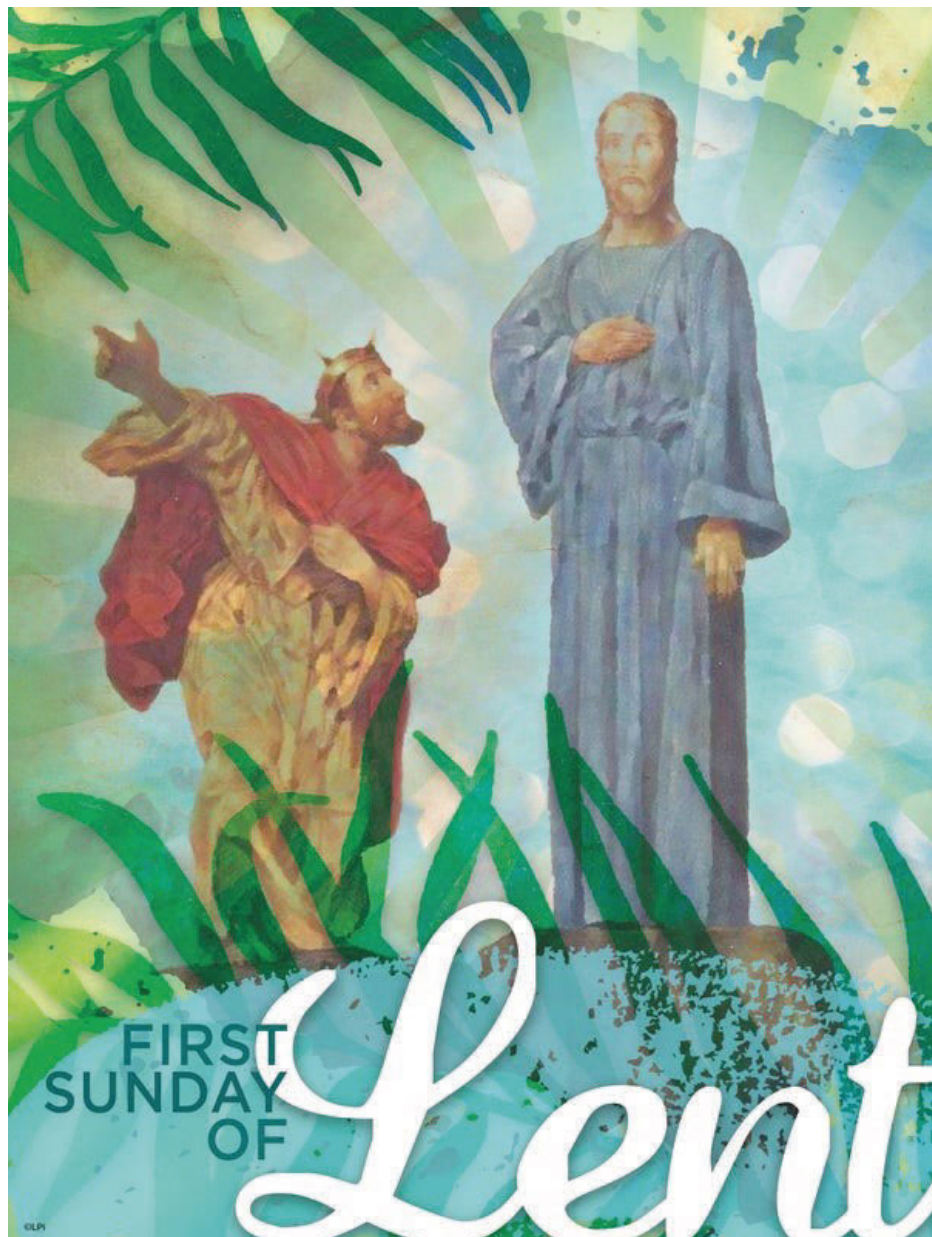

Dear Friends,

We have done it again. We gathered on Wednesday to mark our foreheads with the ashes, the sign of repentance. Are we ready to return to God with our whole hearts? Are we ready for a joyful, life-giving season of Lent? Are we ready to become righteous? Pope Francis, last Sunday, offered a couple of guideposts for us this Lent: The Sacred Scriptures and daily life. We can know our Lord in the Scriptures, proclaimed at daily Mass, and in our Bibles at home, and if we open our eyes, we can encounter Jesus in everyday life situations.

This Lent, we join Jesus in the desert and confront our own temptations and the false gods that vie for our attention, adulation, and worship. In today's Gospel, in his humanness, Jesus shows us how to resist the devil, who was and is a real menace in the spiritual lives of those who love God and want to follow the path of holiness. In each temptation, Jesus resisted the lure of Satan. Jesus knew that God's life, God's way brings real joy and true life.

Hungry, thirsty, and spiritually exhausted, Jesus encountered the Devil in the desert. He relied on his relationship with the Father to help him to resist the temptations the Devil set before him, the same temptations that the Devil sets before us in today's world. The Holy Spirit led him to the desert, and the Holy Spirit gave him what he needed to stand firm against the invitation from the Devil to turn away from the Father. Let's learn from Jesus. Let's allow the Spirit to lead us this Lent.

Let's allow God's mercy to penetrate our hearts and change our lives this Lent. We can open our hearts to those who annoy us or those who disagree with us. We can forgive those who have hurt or betrayed us. We can be aware of the crosses others carry. We can help them to carry their crosses, by lending a hand or a compassionate, nonjudgmental ear. We can recognize our own failures and need for reconciliation with God and our neighbors.

The Scriptures on Wednesday reminded us to fast, pray and give alms. Jesus, instructing his followers, including us, did not say "if" when he was speaking of the three pillars of the spiritual life. He said "when." Jesus expects each of us to do those three things, and he says when we do them - not if - we are to do them with humility and without fanfare.

During Lent, we pray, fast, and do good works. We do these traditional works both individually but also together. As a parish we are called to keep Lent as a season of prayer, sacrifice and service. I pledge to do just that and invite you to join me (at the reconciliation service, daily Mass, increased almsgiving, Soup and Stations, Adoration, and in many other ways).

As we walk with the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults candidates toward the Easter Sacraments, we also must recognize our own need for conversion. We are sinners. We plead along with the Psalmist, "Be merciful, O Lord, for we have sinned." As we listen today to the reading from the book of Genesis, the story of the fall of Adam and Eve, we cannot distance ourselves from them. They sinned. We sin. We, as they did, often try to rationalize our sinful actions. What is needed is a spirit of contrition and conversion.



The Sacrament of Reconciliation should be part of our Lent (and really throughout the year). In addition to weekly opportunities to celebrate the Sacrament (after the morning Mass Saturdays at Saint Joseph), we'll have a Parish Reconciliation Service on March 24 at Saint Joseph. It takes real effort and determination to "keep the Lenten Season". It takes both planning and perseverance. Jesus gives us a great model of perseverance in the Gospel today.

Please, please invite alienated or inactive Catholics to join you. This is a special time to "return home." Let them know they are welcome here (All are welcome here!). Let them know we are together on the road to conversion and new life.

I strongly encourage everyone to complete the survey. Our last survey produced great results. The DMI promises to do the same.

Calling all Saints JFX Men!


