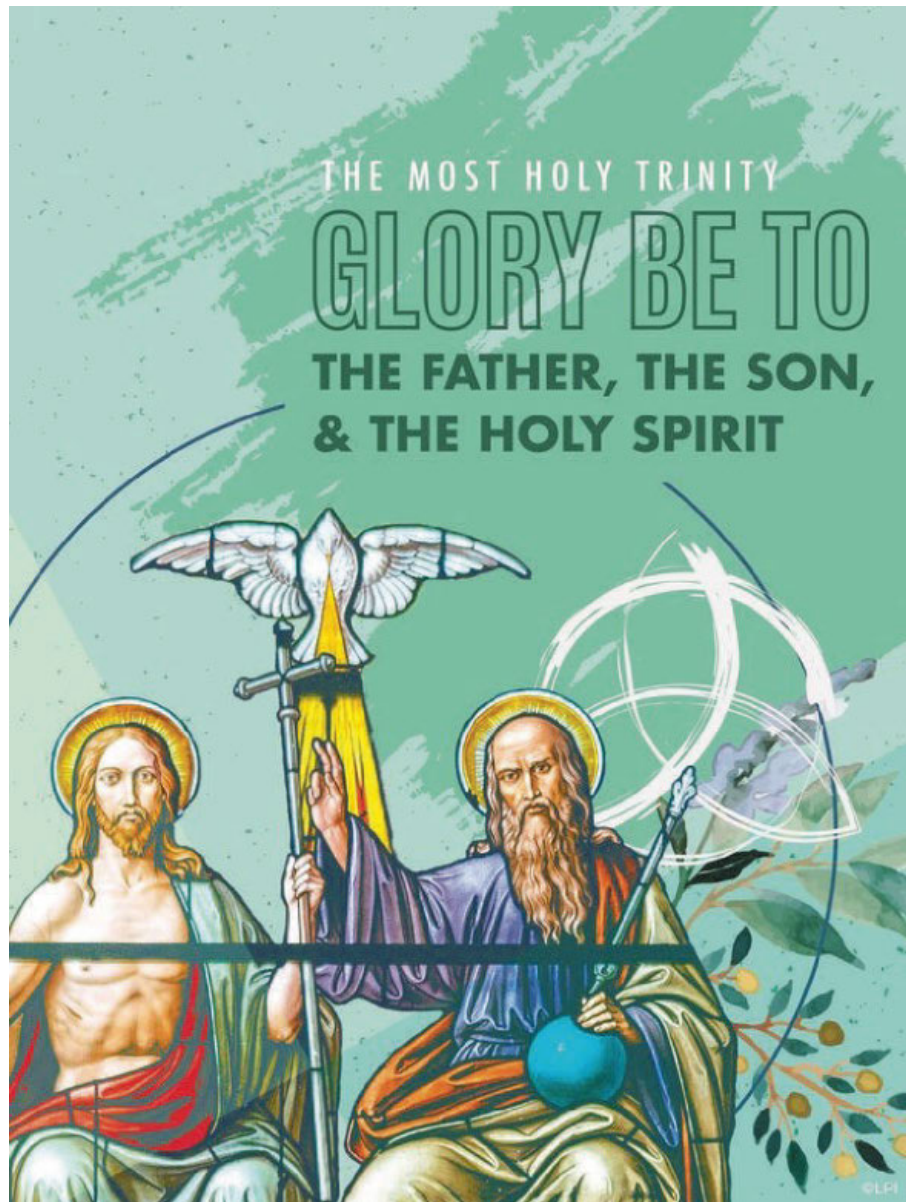

Dear Friends,

Trinity Sunday, the day we reflect on our Triune God, allows us to really think about the meaning of our relationship with the persons of the Trinity, and that being said, our worship of those persons. In so many ways we do share in the exchange of God's love. We participate in the relationship of the Trinity whenever we avail ourselves to prayer, whenever we enter a church or chapel, and bless ourselves with Holy Water, whenever we look at a cross and see that great love poured out. The Cross epitomizes the love of the relationship into which we are invited, a total giving of God's self so that the ones that God created, redeemed, and sanctified might live a fuller life.

Today's solemnity celebrates not an event, but a reality and reminds us that all we are and all we do as Christians must be done in the name of (and with the inspiration of, and guidance of, and relying on the power of...) the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The solemnity of today also teaches that we are invited to be in relationship with God, and one another. At Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier, we try to do just that!

The Incarnation of the second person of the Trinity and the coming of the promised gift of the third person of the Trinity allow us to experience the unity that the "three – in – one" enjoy. It is truly part of God's great plan. He sent his Son, who promised and gave the Holy Spirit. When we call upon the Trinity we unite ourselves in the love and the mutual life that they share.

To be participators in the love relationship of the Trinity, we must learn from the persons of the Trinity and be willing to give of ourselves in the same way. When we are relating with each other, as spouses, parents, children, siblings or friends, we must do so "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." We must make *their* love relationship come to life in *ours*. We must love in their name. And when we do, our love will be complete and our relationships will be whole.

The love relationship of the Trinity serves to be a great paradigm for us. As a community of faith, we Saints JFX parishioners must live in that love, and share that love with each other. If our words and actions do not reflect that love, then we need to amend them. If we are not doing what we do in GOD'S name, we must change.

So, this week, I challenge you, as I challenge myself, to reflect on our relationship with the persons of the Trinity, to consider their relationship of love, and to mirror it in our lives, in what we think, what we say and what we do.



Next week, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. We will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament from Saint Joseph Church (after the 10:30am Mass) to Saint Francis Xavier Church (arriving at the end of the 11:30am Mass for benediction). We will stop at a few homes along the route for prayers and adoration.

As we prepare for the Eucharistic procession, my mind goes back to the other times we did this as a Saints JFX community. Before I was installed as pastor of this great combined parish, we followed our Eucharistic Lord from Saint Francis Church to Saint Joseph Church. When we allow our Eucharistic Lord to lead us and to be the center of all that we do, amazing things happen. During the height of the pandemic, when church doors were locked, and no one could receive our Lord in the Eucharist, we had a procession of the Blessed Sacrament so that even though we couldn't receive our Lord, we could at least adore our Lord. I remember seeing the faces of the faithful as we walked through our town, suffering, hopeful, and full of love for our Lord.

So, we will do it again next week. I invite you to join in the procession and allow our Eucharistic Lord to touch your heart. Meet us at or after the 10:30 Mass at Saint Joseph or wait for us after the 11:30 Mass at SFX. Walk with us. Pray with us. Adore our Eucharistic Lord of the Feast of his Body and Blood.

We are very excited to share with you the current Youth Faith Formation program that our parish has been using is moving to a new approach to teaching your children called **Family of Faith**. Families will enjoy learning and celebrating our faith together.

*Family of Faith Formation* is a new model based on an old idea (parents as primary catechists of their children). This represents a role reversal in typical Catholic Religious education, but it's really just an application of the Church's mandate to form adults so that families can catechize their young. When this occurs, children are taught the faith as a way of life and not just as a weekly class.

*Family of Faith* is basically the principle of subsidiarity applied to children's catechesis. The parish's role is one of equipping – not replacing. The focus is on giving parents tools to help them succeed at being the religious educators that they already are. The *Family of Faith* program makes for a program flexible enough to accommodate a wider range of schedules, learning styles and abilities.

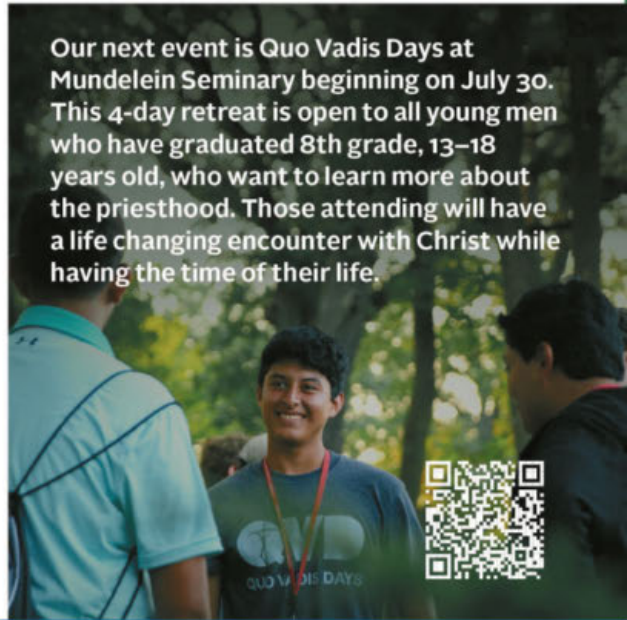
