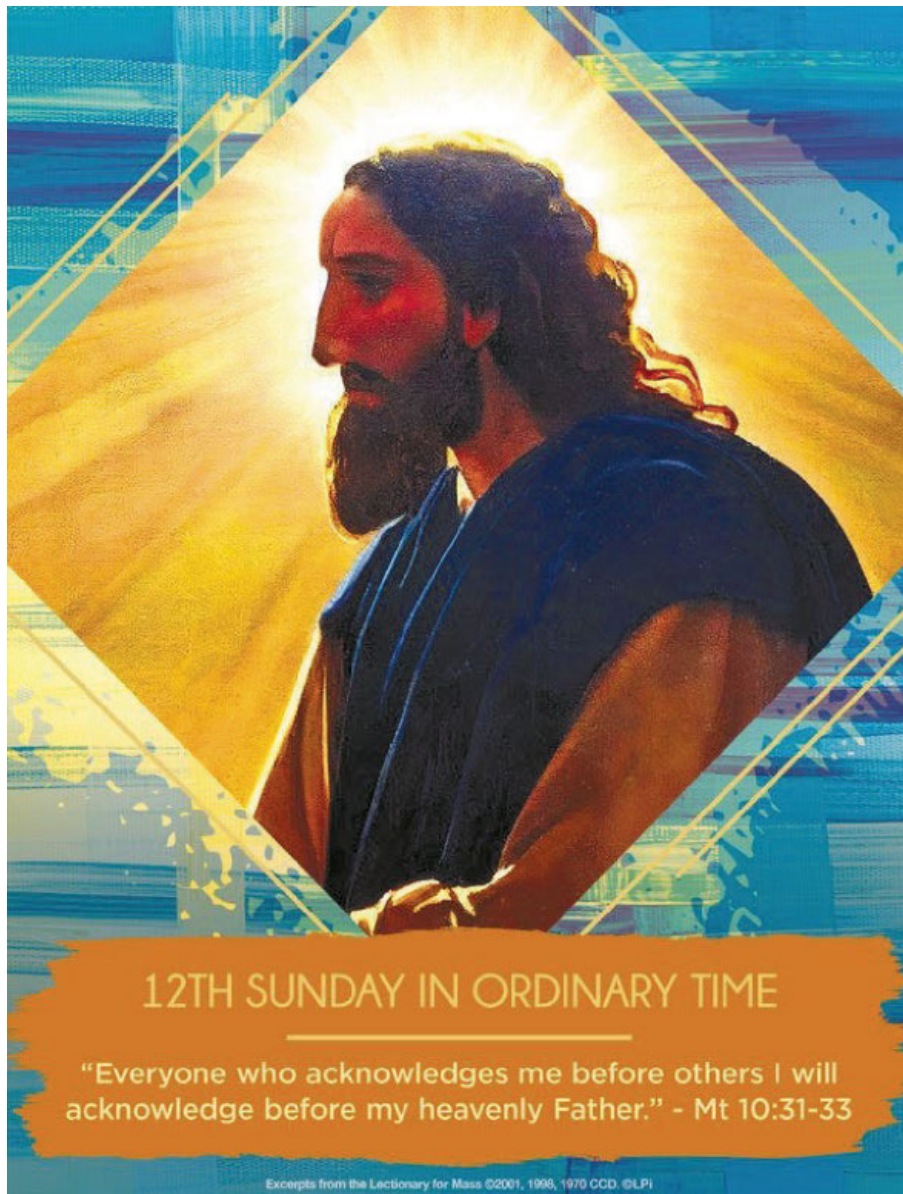

Dear Friends,

Jeremiah exudes confidence during trying times. Paul proclaims the greatness of the grace of God made manifest in Jesus Christ. And our Lord himself reminds us of God's omniscience, omnipresence, and benevolence. These scriptural messages give us reason to hope, to trust and to take up the call to evangelize in this world that needs to know the love, kindness, and mercy of God.

This week, even early in the week as I write this, I have seen the confidence of Jeremiah, the trust in the Grace of God made manifest in Jesus and a willingness to take up the call to evangelize. On Monday, a college friend of mine, a man who grew up in the parish and whose parents still live here, had serious cancer surgery at a hospital in California. As I prayed the online Rosary (we now have between 35-40 participants every day!) I added him to the intentions in a specific way. I texted him to let him know that. With confidence and enthusiasm, he responded immediately, even though it was 5:30am his time. He responded with gratitude, an instruction to greet the people I told him were praying, and a reminder to keep an eye on his parents.

Later that morning another mutual college friend of ours texted me to invite me to join the college roommates of my friend's wife in praying another Rosary during the time of the surgery. Imagine a conference call with a dozen friends from around the country stopping the busyness of their day and praying for their friend and her husband. At the end of the day, I received a note from the patient's Wilmette mother. *Thank you so much for all the prayers for my son. He is in recovery now and his wife can go see him. The doctor was pleased with the results. There were many people praying for him, we are so blessed. Shows the power of prayer. We are blessed with so many caring people. They did a great job.* Confidence, trust, gratitude, and care for the other make manifest God's love.

As I sit down to write this note, I am just returning from 6:30am Mass. At Mass I saw a father and daughter, obviously with a lot on their minds praying intently during and after Mass. I recognized them and had a slight idea of what could have been on their minds. After Mass, I visited them for a bit, and they informed me that his son, her brother, a preteen, is in the hospital for a battery of tests. Their presence at Mass and their powerful praying inspired me. They could be bitter, or frozen in fear. Instead, they turned to the source and summit of the Catholic Faith, the Eucharist. And they put their trust in the God who tells us that we are worth more than many sparrows, and who knows us so intimately that every hair on our heads is counted by God.

Boards and Councils of the parish turn over in June. So much great work has been done by each. It amazes me to witness the forward-thinking work of unification, evangelization and building of community done by these great groups of dedicated parishioners.



On the Parish Pastoral Council, chaired by Deepak Devaraj, and charged with advising me on the community and ministerial life of the parish, I thank Catherine Sullivan, Fina Riddle, Jenny Schade, and Terry Porter for their years of service to the community. I welcome the following who have agreed to serve a three-year term: Genevieve LeFevour, Kate McNally, Nina Bittick, Gene Solmos, and Rich Kirkendall.

On the Finance Council of the parish, co-chaired by Deacon Bob Kerls and Conor LeFevour, and charged with advising me on fiscal matters of the parish, I thank the following parishioners for their fine service, as they end their terms: Loreen Mershimer, Herb Marros, and Patrick Sheedy. I welcome Javier Santacruz, Andrew Housley, Steve Whisdosh, and Will Gano.

The School Board, chaired by Chantal Petherbridge, advises Christine Elliott and me in matters of policy and vision for the school. Mike Henn, Tasha Wallace, and John Hardt have served well and have finished their term. I thank them. Molly Harris went home to God after sharing her light with the School Board – and so many others. May she rest in peace and may her family know God's love and our support. I welcome the new members of the board: Jennifer Bransfield, Meghan Murphy Dooley, Matt Johnson, Lynne Sterrett, and Kate Shanahan.

A FAMILY OF Faith

You may already have heard the news that this upcoming school year our parish will be moving away from the traditional “Sunday YFF/RE/PREP classes” to a new program called Family of Faith.

Family of Faith is a family-based catechesis program that our parish will begin utilizing. It is available to all families of the parish with children in public schools or Catholic schools. This family-based Catechism series covers the entire Catechism of the Catholic Church in four years and assists parents in teaching their children the Faith. One special advantage in teaching children catechism at home is that it is an opportunity to draw your family closer together.

On the first Tuesday of each month (October through June) parents and catechists will meet to discuss one chapter of the Religion series from Sophia press; the parents will be able to share this lesson to their children. There are activities in each chapter to help the children learn the key points of each lesson. At the end of the month there will be a family meeting where families will gather for fellowship and have a chance to share with each other the material they’ve learned.

The goals of the program are to support and nurture strong Catholic families who image the Blessed Trinity; to provide parents the opportunity for continued growth in faith; and to build community and celebrate Catholic life together through common prayer, service to others, social activities and liturgical celebrations.
