Hello Fellow Parishioners,

This week you have the pleasure of hearing from a guest writer. Hopefully you all know me in some capacity, but for those who don't, my name is Joe D'Arco, and I am the Saints JFX Operations Director. I have had the pleasure of working in the parish since January, 2019. As I look back at these last four years, I'm struck by what an incredible time of change we have experienced. This past year was easily the most "normal" and yet so many great things (and of course challenges) happened. Several things really stick out in my mind. First was the return to nearly normal education post COVID in our school. It was great to see many of the things that make our school so special, return. The second was the introduction of the 4:45pm Sunday "last chance" Mass. It has quickly grown to be one of the most popular Masses we have! Finally, there was the painful challenge of having the boiler go out at St. Francis Xavier Church in the days leading up to Christmas. What a time for the boiler to go out...but thanks to both the generosity of our parishioners and availability of the ONE exact replacement we were able to get back up and running in just a few weeks.

While we were already exploring the idea of a campus master plan, the boiler replacement really put an exclamation point on not only doing a needs assessment, but a deferred maintenance plan as well. We are currently at the halfway point of our master planning process. In the coming weeks we will host two town hall meetings where you all will have the opportunity to hear from The Lakota Group and provide feedback for what they have been creating. Following those meetings, Lakota will be working up a final draft of the master campus planned called the "One Plan."

We currently expect that this work will be completed before the end of calendar year. I am looking forward to both the town hall feedback and completion of the One Plan. It will be used as the road map to make our parish even stronger.



While our transition to PushPay didn't make it to the top of things from last year that stuck out, my hope is that it will next year. As part of our transition to PushPay, we are also migrating to a new backend database called ParishStaq which connects to PushPay. The database will have a parish facing component that will allow better collaboration across the parish. One of the things I am most excited for is the Group feature. Right now our Men's Club is helping us work out some of the bugs, but the idea is that our groups will have a local, unified platform for communication, collaboration, event sign-up, and more. It's my hope that this will become a significant tool which continues to foster community. Please keep an eye out for more details in the coming months!

Speaking of PushPay, our new fiscal year began on July 1st. As you might imagine our expenses continue to rise. For the next fiscal year, we are projecting that our expenses will increase by just over 5%. In order to remain a healthy and vibrant parish, I would ask that you consider making a meaningful increase in your annual contribution. With your continued support, we can and will continue to do great things. I look forward to another year of not only challenges but great success!

Saints JFX is moving away from the traditional "Sunday YFF/RE/PREP classes" to a new program called Family of Faith. This week we continue to present frequently asked questions and answers to share information about the program. Please do not hesitate to contact Dana McKenna at dmckenna@ssjfx.org if you'd like to receive the registration link or more information about the program.

Q. What if we don't understand the material?

A. Call, e-mail, or visit us in the parish office and we will help you. As a parish, it is our ministry and priority to support you in your vocation and role as a parent.

Q. Do we have to turn anything in?

A. There is a year-long project every family completes. Throughout the year parents will share at the Tuesday parent meetings the progress of their family project. Families will support and share with one another ideas related to the project. At the end of the year there will be an opportunity for families to share their end project with the Family of Faith community.

Q. Can I bring my children with me to Parent Meetings on the first Tuesday of the month?

A. You can certainly bring your children to the Parent Meeting on the first Tuesday of the month. We will have activities for them while we take the time to teach you, our parents, the theme for that month.

Q: Is there a lot of time and work involved for families?

A: No. There are two lessons to teach each month, along with a variety of family and child activities. Each lesson takes about 30-45 minutes and requires minimal preparation from the parent. The once-a-month parent educational session will include icebreakers, presentation notes, discussion questions and answers, and step-by-step instructions for activities. Our group leaders will help you know, understand and explain your faith, so that you can pass it on to your children in a personal way.

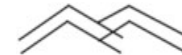

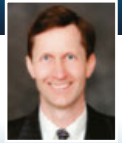
