

Dear fellow parishioners,

Greetings from MaryClare Birmingham, your new Coordinator for the Ministries of Care and Bereavement! Many of you know me already because my husband and I have been members of this parish since 1994. I come to this role after serving four years as Executive Director of Kolbe House Jail Ministry. That experience is more relevant to Care and Bereavement than you might think. Despite the difference in circumstances and environments, at the heart of both is a ministry of presence, of compassionate accompaniment to someone separated from the community or suffering a loss, hurting, faced with a difficult reality. Through the Ministries of Care and Bereavement we enfold the sick, the infirm, the grieving, and their loved ones into the embrace of our parish, and together we encounter the merciful love of our Lord Jesus in the Eucharist. In short, we walk with another in love, aware of His loving presence in our midst. What a wonderful mission we have!

Before I go on, let me thank my predecessor, Ana Alda-Falcon, for her leadership and devoted service. We are blessed she continues to participate in this ministry. I thank those volunteers who kept the ministries running smoothly as parish roles shifted and reorganized, particularly Kathy Stauber, Nancy Lou Kelly, and Shelagh Donoghue. Mary Kay Gorman has been amazing, covering so many bases so graciously for bereavement ministry. Lastly, huge thanks to all ministers who have served throughout the summer. This parish is richly blessed with generous and capable people!

I rejoice to tell you that this summer, after suspension during pandemic followed by slow and careful reengagement, both ministries have returned to unrestricted service. Our Ministers of Care visit patients in Evanston Hospital and seniors living in the Citadel, Artis, and Mather Place, and we see folks who need home visits because attendance at Mass isn't possible. We are fully available to assist with funerals and bereavement.

This good news means we need more people in our ministry corps! I know many shrink at the thought of this work because they think it must be depressing. (If you ever want to bring conversation to a halt, tell people you are a bereavement or a jail ministry coordinator.) In truth, it's just the opposite – it's uplifting and grace-filled. Most of our ministers came to this work because they experienced the ministry personally. They had an ailing loved one who

was visited at home or in hospital and saw what these visits meant to them. Or they needed help to plan a funeral, and people to listen during that difficult time. Or they knew someone who served in this ministry, and they saw how much they loved the work. Those experiences motivated them to join. Their own joy in the work makes them stay. Most of our ministers serve for years and years. People don't do something for years and years if it's depressing. They do it because it's filled with grace and love and brings us closer to Jesus.



How does that happen? It happens because we meet Jesus in every encounter. He said, *I was sick and you visited Me.* We bring Jesus in the Holy Eucharist to the sick and infirm but truly, He is already there in the person we visit. In like manner Jesus blesses the bereaved and the minister as we walk through the funeral process together. *Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.* He joins us just as He joined the disciples walking to Emmaus.

Over time we hope to build our capacity to serve. Our goal is to offer a continuum of care to the infirm, the grieving, and their caregivers so we can accompany each person wherever they are on their journey.

I invite you to join us in this work of love! **Come hear the details at our 30-minute information session at St. Joseph parish office this Wednesday, August 23, at 7:00pm.** We'll tell you about the roles you can choose from, the training, and the commitment we ask for. Don't stay away if there are times of year when you can't participate – we can accommodate seasonality in your schedule. Mark your calendar and come check it out! If you can't come Wednesday, call me and we'll talk. I'm happy to meet *you* wherever *you* are in *your* journey!

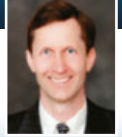
