Dear Friends,

Conversion. Metanoia. Renewal. God calls us to all of those. During these challenging times in our country and our world -and even in our Church, with the racial, political, and ecclesiological divides, name calling and finger pointing, and the unprecedented number of natural disasters, one might be tempted to question God's ways, God's love for us or God's power. Where is God in all of this? How does God allow all this suffering? What does God think about the divisive language that fills our airwaves and social media? I return to my aforementioned three terms. Conversion. Metanoia. Renewal. God's "fair" ways allow for all these.

Hurricanes, earthquakes, floods, and fires are not God's way of punishing us. Really, this physical evil comes because of the sinful state that our world is in. God gave us freedom. We choose the good - mostly. When we choose evil (which we all occasionally do) evil enters the world and manifests itself in disasters (physical evil) and in other world maladies such as violence, anger, racism, division, hatred, and bigotry (moral evil). Then the cycle continues. So whose ways are unfair? What can we do?

Those questions demand self-reflection and invite conversion. When we commit to conversion and to metanoia, God waits and is ready to help. Our first reading reminds us of the generous mercy of God. He gives us second chances and third chances and on and on. God so desires our closeness yet gives us the freedom to choose to intentionally move ourselves away from sin and toward God's mercy. It tells us, too, that God will judge us on our choices. I hope this reading doesn't instill fear, but rather inspire conversion, generosity and good choices.

In the second book of the Bible, penned in the sixth century BC, in a passage that is often overlooked, we hear who our God really is. Exodus 34 states, *"The LORD came down in a cloud and stood with him there and proclaimed the name, "LORD." So the LORD passed before him and proclaimed: The LORD, the LORD, a God gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in love and fidelity, continuing his love for a thousand generations, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion, and sin."*

Jesus came to make that graciousness, mercy, patience, fidelity, and love manifest. To know Jesus allows us to experience first hand, up close and personal, the love of the God we cannot see. The Church (you and I) must be the sacrament of Jesus' selfless love. Our world desperately needs us to make God's love visible.



God loves us - always has and always will. So let's commit to conversion, metanoia and renewal. We can do that in so many ways. We can stand against bigotry. We can help those suffering from the disasters that befall them. We can commit to our local and Universal Church. We can put on the same attitude that is in Christ. Paul tells the - and us,

*Brothers and sisters: If there is any encouragement in Christ, any solace in love, any participation in the Spirit, any compassion and mercy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing. Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, each looking out not for his own interests, but also for those of others. Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ.*

The invitation of Saint Paul really calls us to unity, to break down barriers, to move out of our silos. We have come a long way at Saints JFX in our work toward unity. We still have a long way to go. With two worship sites and two school campuses, **we are Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier Parish and are Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier School**. We, in the Family of Faith Program, are inviting both families with children in the public school *and* in our parish school to participate in a program to deepen faith of all their members – and all our members. We are breaking barriers and moving out of silos. Even now, some people still grumble. Some hang on to the past without allowing themselves to see the blessing of the present and the hope of the future. When we put on the attitude that is in Christ, God fills us with joy and hope.

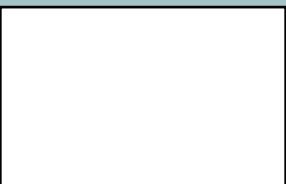
