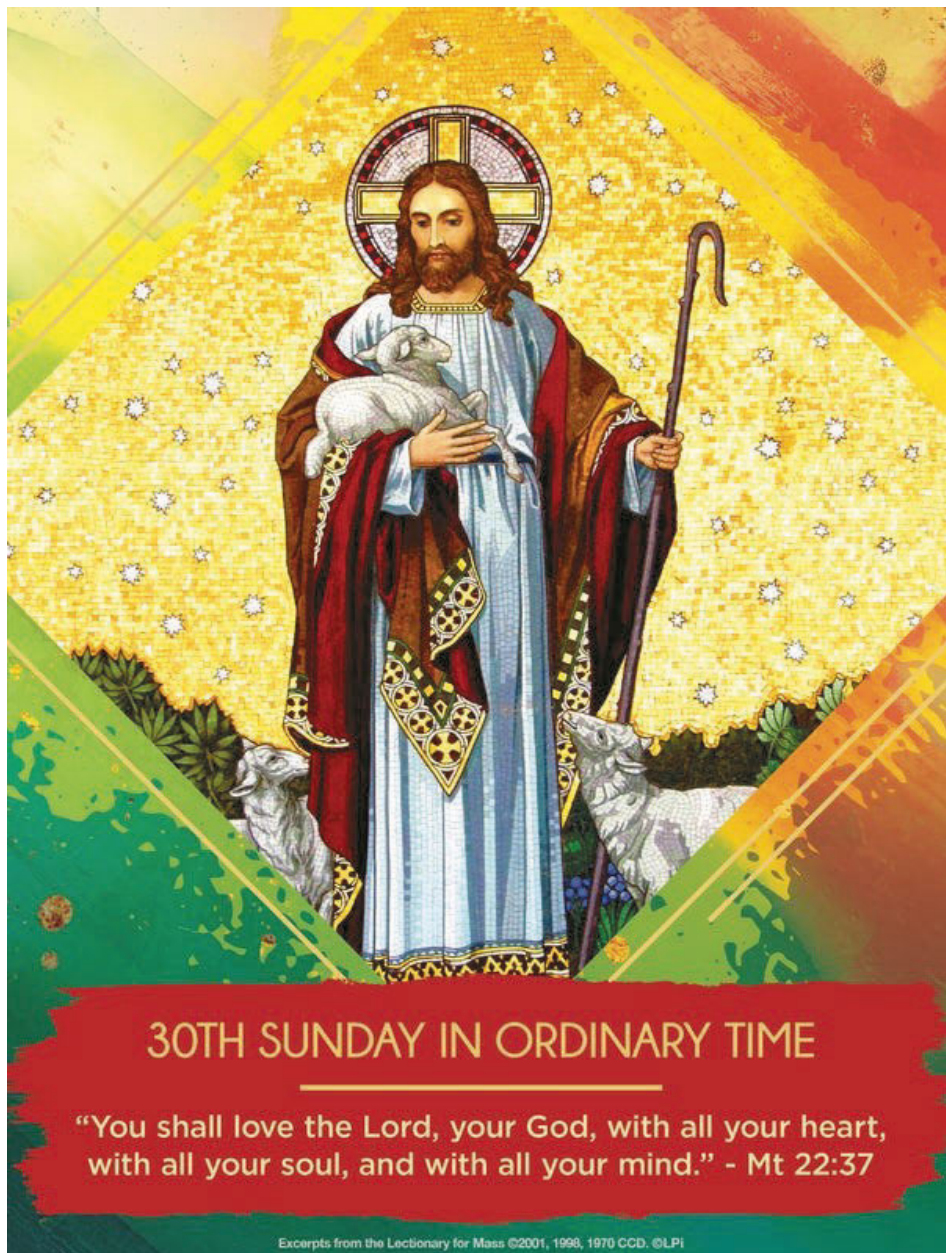

Dear Friends,

Whenever I read the Gospel we hear today, and others, like it, I wonder why they were testing him. Throughout the Gospels, Jesus reminds people of his will and mission, and his desire to accomplish the Father's will. For some reason, they cannot buy into a plan that makes them uncomfortable. So, they try to find fault. They attempt to trip him up. They close their heart to the message. Jesus shows us how to remain strong and to accomplish God's will by the way we live our lives. Jesus doesn't ask any questions. He answers the scholar of the law's single question with a double response. Love God and love neighbor

Today, the scholar of the law asks Jesus what command of the law is greatest. Maybe he did it to justify himself. Maybe he was testing Jesus's own knowledge of the law. I perhaps he wanted Jesus to make a big mistake, so that he and others would not have to abide by the teachings of Jesus. Jesus does not allow the question to throw him off course. He uses the opportunity to teach those who listen, and all of us. The law is based on total love of God and of neighbor. Everything flows from love.

With all that is happening in our world, and in our Church, this message is more prescient than ever today. In so many areas and encounters, harsh judgment, bitterness, exclusivity, and anger prevail. The war in the Middle East, and its ripple effects throughout the world, demonstrate this lack of love and understanding. Last Sunday, just miles from here, the lack of love and understanding reared its ugly head. Protesters supporting the two sides of the argument clashed on the corner of McCormick and Touhy. Tear gas filled the air and gun shots rang out. Watching the video clips from the event, one can see and feel a real lack of love - motivated by hate, and by fear.

Although no gunshots or teargas appear during the Synod in Rome, one can sense, similar lack of love, likely motivated by fear. Following the Synod on social media wearies is the heart. The unloving, unchristian remarks made in the comments sections make me wonder about the unity of our Church, and our failure to trust in the Holy Spirit. These comments do not provide evidence of love of God, or neighbor. We can disagree with our neighbor, but we must love in word, and deed. We must also trust that the Holy Spirit guides and protects our Church. When we trust, we rid ourselves of fear, and love can prevail.

More than 2600 years ago, the divinely inspired Book of Exodus challenged the people of God. In today's first reading, we are reminded how God calls us to live. Looking at the reading through the eyes of Jesus, who read the prophet quite often, we see that the God invites us to be people who, first and foremost LOVE, especially those who are downtrodden or needy. We can do this because God has shown us how to love. He comes to us in our neediness and loves us unconditionally. Jesus Christ makes this love manifest. Saint Paul tells us, in our second reading today, that we are called to be imitators of the Lord. Thus, God calls us to love God - and our neighbor, with the same love, that Jesus has for each of us - quite a challenge.

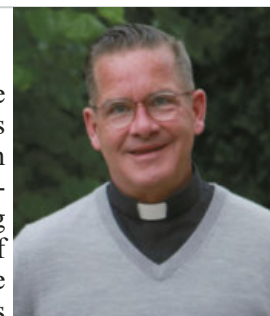
Jesus's love, unconditional, and open to all, shows us the mercy of God, and invites us to live that love in our broken world today. It starts small, in our human relationships at home, at work, at school, and in our recreation. At sporting events, or at cocktail parties, Christian charity must prevail. It takes work. It takes self-discipline. It challenges us to tear down walls and invite all. Cliques and social, climbing at the expense of another push the love of God out of our hearts and our minds. I am reminded of the song All Are Welcome. We sing,

Let us build a house where love can dwell, and all can safely live, a place where saints and children tell how hearts learn to forgive.

All are welcome. All are welcome. All are welcome, in this place.

Our Church - our local Church and the Church Universal - needs renewal. It's up to us to renew it. When we take up the challenge, we really will be loving God and loving our neighbor!
