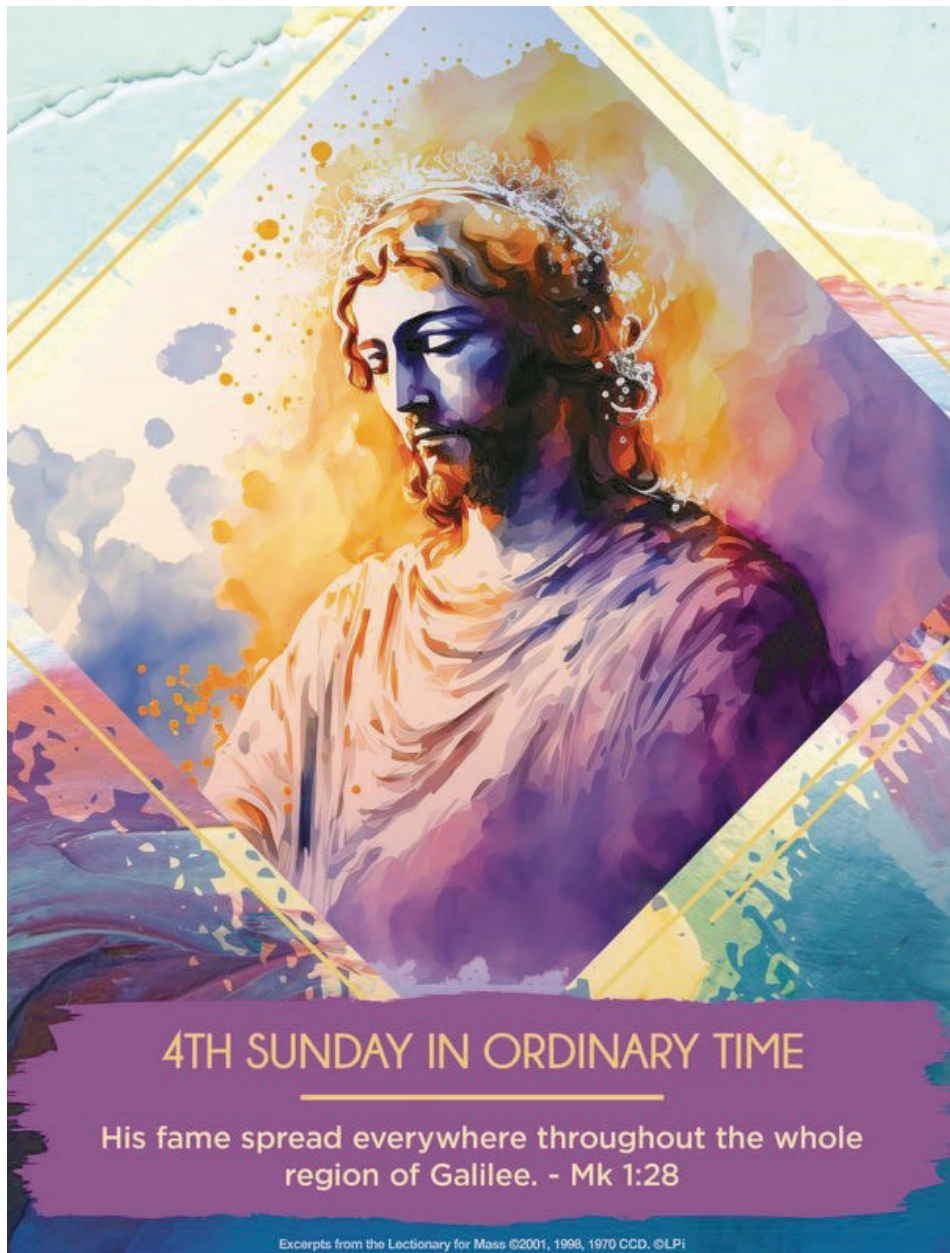

I share with you some of the great ways God is working in our awesome community.

Catholic Schools Week

As we begin Catholic Schools week, and as we open the application process to the public, I want to acknowledge the school staff for the great work the team does, from the administration to the teachers to the office staff to the maintenance team. Something great is happening here. Our school continues to draw interest from many families, from Wilmette and beyond. Perhaps the news of our successful graduates has reached the community; maybe the enthusiasm of our school families and the great community we have built has extended to the Village of Wilmette. For whatever reason, we are known, and demand for space in our school soon will exceed the seats available, as we commit to small class size and great student teacher ratio – and have no intention to grow larger. We also strive to make those who call Saints JFX School home committed followers of Jesus Christ and active participants in the life of this great parish, a parish that wholeheartedly supports the school – its largest ministry.

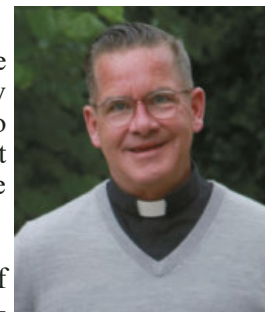
As I write this, we have hundreds of students from the existing school community already reenrolled - pretty good for the last-minute Wilmette crowd! Several prospective families have expressed interest in joining our school community. The news continues to spread! Great things are happening at the Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier School!

Annual Catholic Appeal

I'm praying that every household and school family will respond generously and make a substantial pledge to this year's **Annual Catholic Appeal**. Cardinal Cupich reminds us that as Catholics in today's world that we have been entrusted with great responsibility. Responsibly and generously let's share our gifts.

The Theme for this year's Annual Catholic Appeal, "Together at the Table," reminds us, in this year dedicated to the Eucharist, that joining around the table of the Lord is the source and summit of the Christian life. The Body of Christ sustains us in all we do. When we gather at the table, we are made whole.

I have been a long supporter of the ACA; in fact, I give half of my personal yearly budgeted gift to Saints JFX via the ACA. I do it that way for a number of reasons. Ask me sometime, and I will tell you why.



Our parish goal for the ACA, 7% of our Sunday and Holy Day collections, is just under \$165,000. Anything over that amount comes back to us as a rebate. We use the rebate dollars to complete unbudgeted capital projects or to add to our capital fund. The 2023 goal was \$168,121. So far, with a couple of weeks to go in the 2023 campaign, we have collected \$223,000. We used (or are using) the rebate money to complete many great capital projects over the last several months.

The One Plan

The Saints JFX One Plan steering committee and Parish leadership met on January 12th for another working session to refine the long-term Parish vision based on extensive analysis and the results of the community engagement done to date. The Lakota Group, the steering committee, and Parish leadership will work to refine the vision and come back to the community in early March for a presentation of the One Plan and to provide an opportunity to gain community input on how the Parish should prioritize campus improvements moving forward. We will use all the information gleaned in the One Plan Process to educate a Capital Campaign, hopefully to be launched in the beginning of the new fiscal year.

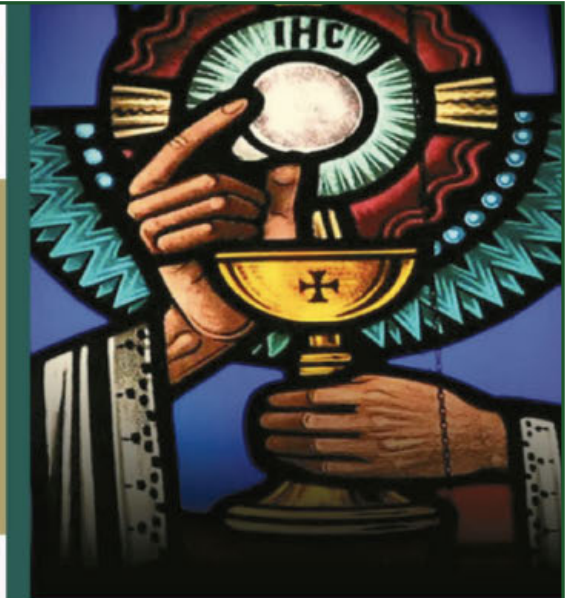

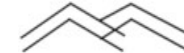
