Dear Friends,

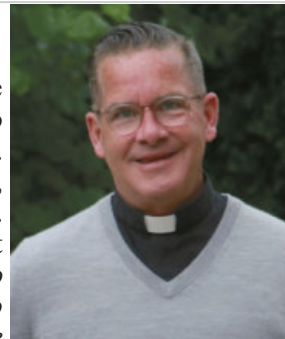
We gather this weekend for the second Sunday of Lent. As we do, we join Jesus on the Mountain of the Transfiguration, and I echo Saint Peter who says, "Rabbi it is good that we are here." It is good that we are here today, celebrating Holy Mass as part of our Lenten observance. In fact, I often encourage my friends to try to come to Mass more frequently than once a week during Lent. It's a great way to start the day, at 6:30am at SFX or at 8:30am at Saint Joseph. Many, many of you have accepted that invitation and are making daily Mass part of your Lenten practice. It is good that we are here.

"If God is for us, who can be against us?" The rhetorical question posed by Saint Paul in today's second reading presumes a great fact. God *is* for us! Sometimes it's easy to notice that fact. Other times it's more difficult. Today's readings remind us of God's mercy and love - and of God's great plan for humanity. Aware of Abraham's fidelity, God spared Isaac. Paul tells us that God did not spare Jesus. He handed himself over for us all. He delivered Jesus so that Jesus could deliver us from death. He gave us Jesus so that Jesus could speak words of comfort, challenge, and mercy. What we're called to do is simple: LISTEN!

As we continue our journey, we need to clearly hear the voice that came from the cloud that tells us, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." We often spend a lot more time talking, in life and in prayer, than listening. We want to make our point rather than understand another's. We fill our lives with useless noise that blocks out the voice of the Lord. We spend much of our time running from this place to the next that we don't allow ourselves even a moment to hear his voice. This Lent let's make a point to listen to what our Lord is saying to us.

Take some extra time in the morning or the evening in quiet. Turn off the television. Mute the cell phones and silence the computers. Stop swiping, surfing, and scrolling for a while. I know as well as you do that is a tall order for modern day Christians. Another great way to listen to the Lord is to spend some time in your day in church. One can access either of our beautiful churches anytime between the hours of 8:30AM and 3:30PM. Make a visit. Spend some time with our Eucharistic Lord. Allow Jesus to speak to you this Lent.

For us to be transfigured, to be transformed this Lent, we need to let our Lord work on our hearts. We need to eliminate the babble, the voices that compete with God's. The collect for today's Mass says it well when we pray, "*O God, who have commanded us to listen to your beloved Son, be pleased, we pray, to nourish us inwardly by your word, that, with spiritual sight made pure, we may rejoice to behold your glory.*"



We have ten adults in in our midst who have listened to the voice of the Lord, have been nourished inwardly by the word, and have responded with commitment. These adults, participants in the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, joined hundreds of others from throughout the Archdiocese of Chicago last Sunday for the Rite of Election. At Holy Name Cathedral, Cardinal Cupich welcomed them and reminded them that not only are they welcome in the Catholic Church, but that they are needed.

As I sat in the congregation at Sunday's liturgy, one of a few Rites of Election, gratitude and joy filled my heart. The sheer numbers and diversity of the candidates and catechumens (literally hundreds of them!) from Cook and Lake Counties, adults who have made a conscious choice to join our Church, impressed me as it does every year. Jesus is speaking and good people are listening to his voice. I ask you to continue to pray for the elect of our parish. Welcome them, encourage them, and allow their courage and their faith to inspire you. We will share their names, their photos, and their stories as Lent unfolds and as they prepare for the Easter Sacraments. Know that I am praying for you too!
