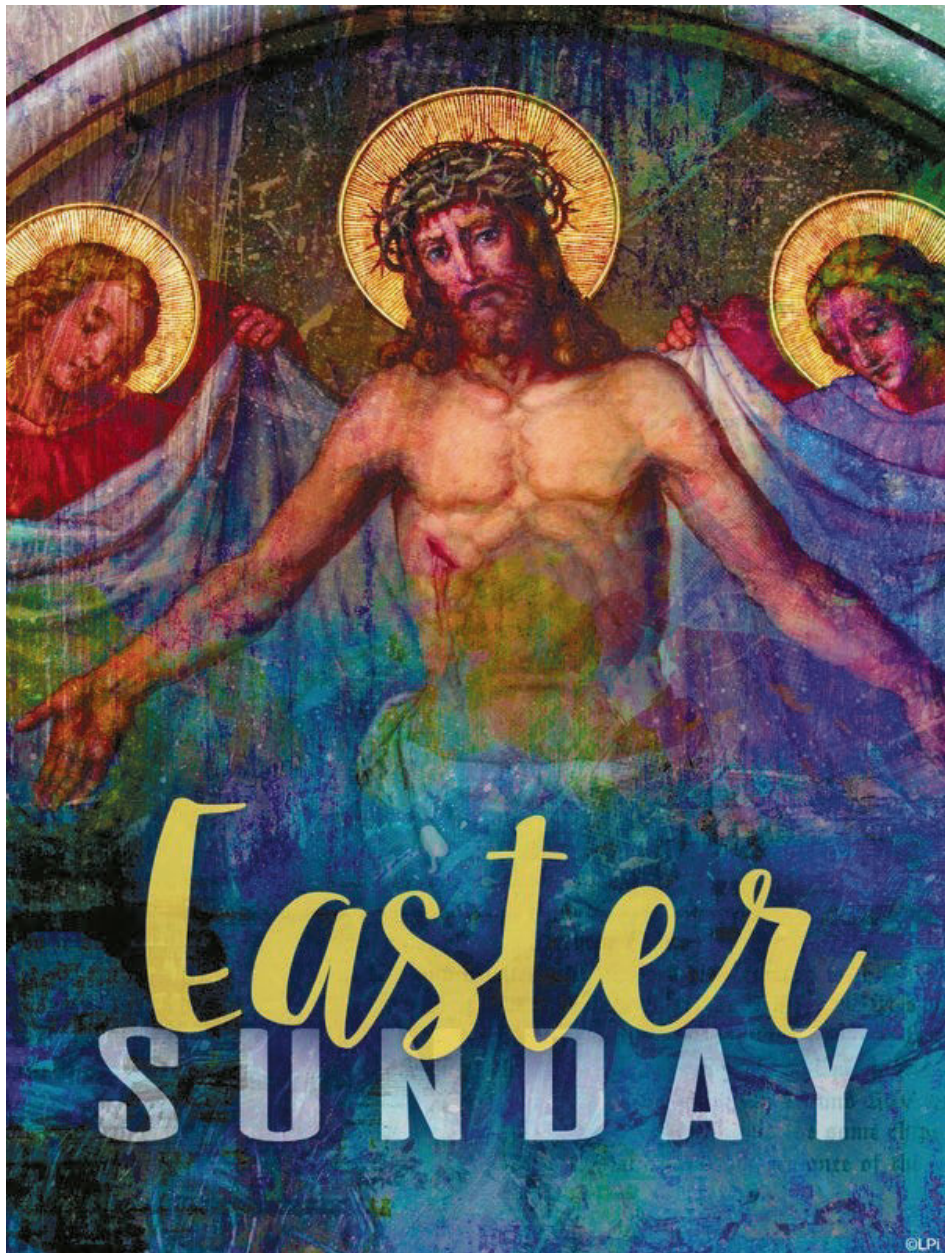

Dear Friends,

Happy Easter! At the Easter Vigil, after hearing the seven beautiful accounts from the Hebrew Scriptures of God's hand in Salvation history, we listen to Saint Paul's confident address to the people of Rome. He says clearly, *"If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him."* The past few days, even weeks, we have witnessed in the Gospels a sense of competition, between good and evil, between life and death, between God's ways and the ways of the world.

The competition between light and darkness heightened during the Paschal Triduum. From the Last Supper, to the crucifixion, to the tomb, one might think that Jesus was losing the contest, that evil was conquering good. In these difficult socio-economic times, it might be easy to believe that the story ends on Friday. From the streets of Chicago to our country's borders, to the worn torn places in Eastern Europe and the Middle East, just to name a few, God's people need a win. So many people, this year more than ever, are feeling like they are on the losing end, that they really could die, or have died, with Jesus. It would be easy to list the many who are suffering from war, corruption, poverty, violence, and famine.


The fact remains. In Baptism, we all die with Jesus. We die to original sin; we die to an old way of life. That death offers, as Saint Paul tells us, life. On this Easter weekend we rejoice and sing our long-lost alleluias because of the life offered. At the beginning of the passage from his letter to the Romans, Saint Paul asks, *"Brothers and sisters: Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?"* He goes on to remind them, and us, of God's divine reasoning. *"We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life."* Jesus Wins! So do we.

I lived with a wise old priest for many years when I was pastor of Saint John Berchmans. Father Reicher spoke softly but often had good things to say to the people of the parish. One message he often proclaimed is the importance of celebrating Easter. He lauded Catholics' ability to keep the holy season of Lent, with their fasting, praying, and almsgiving. He suggested that we should put at least as much energy into observing the celebration of Easter as we did in observing Lent. Through the nearly two-month season of Easter he would remind us to keep celebrating and observing Easter. We are an Easter people. Easter defines us as Catholic Christians. Allow this time, between now and Pentecost to fill your hearts and your lives with confidence, hope, and mission.

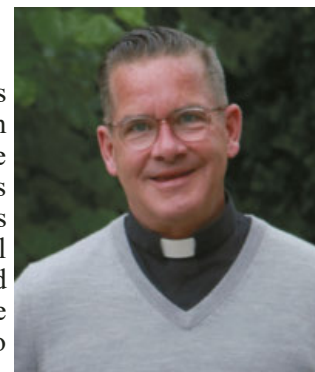
Today, Easter Day, God raises us to new life in Christ, to share in the victory. He calls us to live Easter joy. He grants to us Easter hope. Joyful hope. That's what this day offers: Joyful Hope. That's what this world needs. Perhaps the joyful hope that Easter offers, lived out so well by this great community, attracted the fifteen people to join the Catholic Church, and this faith community, on Holy Saturday. I welcome the neophytes with an assurance of my love and prayers, and with pride and joy. I'm proud of this community for attracting so many to join us and I am joyful because this cohort of neophytes will bring many gifts that will build up the body of Christ.

If you are here for the first time this weekend, please know that you are welcome here. All are welcome at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier. Consider making this parish your spiritual home. The people of Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier are truly alive in the love of Christ. Great things happen here. Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



### KNOW THE SPECIAL GRACES OF DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The extraordinary graces for Divine Mercy Sunday, April 7, that Jesus promised to St. Faustina offer “complete forgiveness” of sins and punishment and only require that we receive Holy Communion in a state of grace on Divine Mercy Sunday, with trust in our Lord's great mercy. The plenary indulgence offered by the Church (St. John Paul 2) for the carrying out of certain types of Divine Mercy Sunday devotions include making your Confession not more than 20 days in advance of or after participating in the Divine Mercy Sunday activities, praying for the intentions of the Pope and praying the Divine Mercy public devotions on the feast day. Both of these indulgences can be received and even apply the plenary indulgence to a soul in Purgatory!

The message of mercy is that God LOVES us-all of us-no matter how great our sins. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others.

“Anyone who says this chaplet will receive great Mercy at the hour of death.” Say it for the dying, or those who have died...it is never too late!

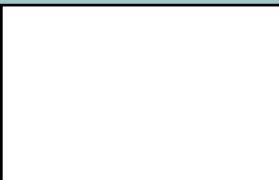
