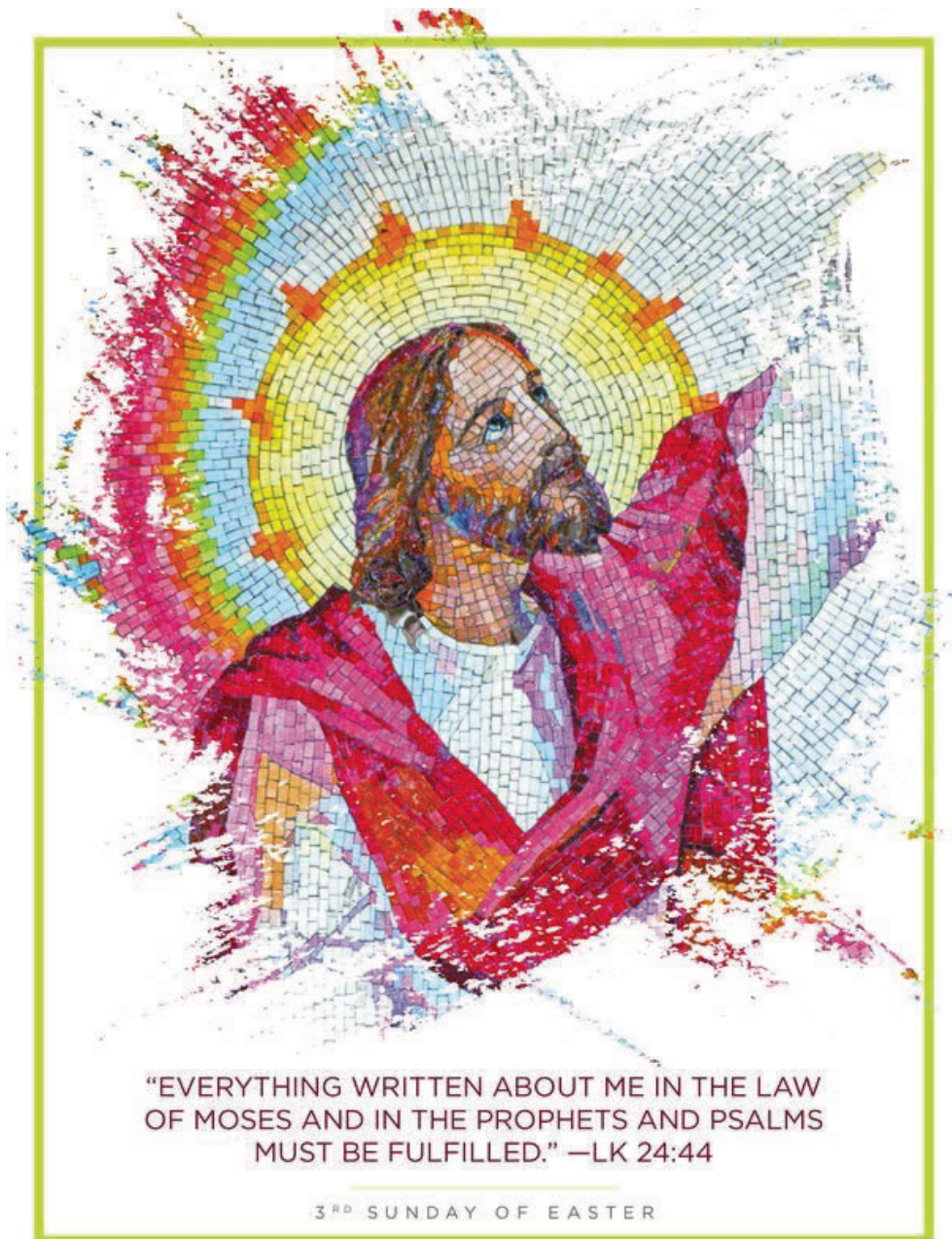

Dear Friends,

Happy Easter! We gather this week to celebrate the third Sunday of Easter. As we do this, the Gospel gives us another post-resurrection appearance of Jesus. In fact we hear some of the final words that Luke has Jesus say. Immediately before he takes them to Bethany, the place of the Ascension, Jesus tells his disciples, and Luke allows us to hear the words today, "You are witnesses of these things."

The disciples received the Holy Spirit that Jesus promised, and they somehow, despite their own physical and moral weakness, mustered the strength to be witnesses. They did as the Lord commanded them to do; they preached of the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus. They called people to repentance and told of the forgiveness the Lord offers. People heard their message, and many followed them. We hear of their great success in the Easter season's first readings that come from the Acts of the Apostles.

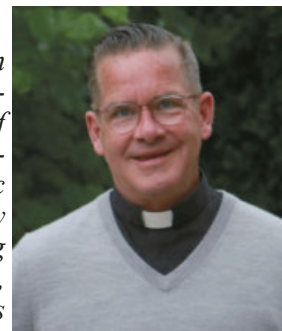
Today's selection from the Acts of the Apostles portrays a confident Peter. Just three weeks ago, in the Passion Gospels we watched as Peter denied Jesus three times. We sensed his fear and self-protective stance. We heard him shout, "I do not know the man!" Today he is standing firm and courageous. He confronts the leaders of the people and calls them to conversion. Having experienced a conversion himself, and having received the Holy Spirit, he lost his fear and selfishness and began really living his life for Jesus. He invited others to do the same. Once converted himself, he challenged others, even some of Jesus' most powerful detractors to do the same. He tells them (and us), "Be converted and your sins will be wiped away." That's a pretty nice promise.

Last week, the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith issued a lengthy document on human dignity. It is worth reading. It touched on many topics affecting the modern world of adults and children. The section on social media struck me. I share some excerpts here with the hope that adults will speak to children about the power and danger (and permanence) of social media.

Digital Violence

Although the advancement of digital technologies may offer many possibilities for promoting human dignity, it also increasingly tends toward the creation of a world in which exploitation, exclusion, and violence grow, extending even to the point of harming the dignity of the human person. Pope Francis stresses that "it is not healthy to confuse communication with mere virtual contact. Indeed, 'the digital environment is also one of loneliness, manipulation, exploitation, and violence, even to the extreme case of the

'dark web.' Digital media can expose people to the risk of addiction, isolation, and gradual loss of contact with concrete reality, blocking the development of authentic interpersonal relationships. New forms of violence are spreading through social media, for example, cyberbullying....Respect for others disintegrates, and even as we dismiss, ignore, or keep others distant, we can shamelessly peer into every detail of their lives. Such tendencies represent a dark side of digital progress...We need constantly to ensure that present-day forms of communication are in fact guiding us to generous encounter with others, to honest pursuit of the whole truth, to service, to closeness to the underprivileged and to the promotion of the common good.



As we reflect on the power and danger of social media, I encourage you to consider mercy. Jesus invited, throughout his earthly ministry, all people to trust in the mercy of God and to be merciful as God himself is merciful. Jesus spoke of mercy often and even more often exhibited it in his dealings with others. Reflecting on mercy, and our own need to experience it, witness to it, and share it, some of us struggle with the concept of anyone – even God – being able to forgive us. Francis tells us that God never tires of forgiving us. He is so convinced of the mercy of God, and he encourages us to trust in and avail ourselves to that mercy. Let's let mercy come alive in us, in person and online.

Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) is the main consultative body of the parish and exercises shared responsibility for the Pastoral life of the parish with the Pastor. This includes defining parish goals, setting broad strategies for implementing those goals, and evaluating the parish's success in carrying out the Church's mission.

The council represents a cross section of the parish. Meetings are held on the 3rd Monday of the month, September - June. In addition to monthly meetings, members are asked to serve on sub-committees such as Stewardship, Hospitality, and Youth Faith Formation. This past year, one of our key accomplishments was the completion of a parish-wide survey.

Terms are 3 years, and the preferred number of members is 12. PPC has in-person meetings on the third Monday of the month at 7:30 pm. Work involves around 5 hours a month. Please contact the parish office at officessjfx@ssjfx.org to request the link to apply.

Finance Council assists the Pastor in discharging his responsibilities in the administration, management, and stewardship of the financial affairs of the parish. The Finance Council works with the Pastor and the Director of Operations in preparing and approving the annual budget, overseeing and approving major capital expenditures, and producing and communicating the Annual Report of the Parish Finances to Parishioners. Furthermore, the Council is charged with reviewing the operating results and providing important guidance in the financial management of the parish.

Meetings are held on the 4th Monday of the month, September – June. In addition to the monthly meeting, council volunteers are asked to work on sub-committees to actively work on Parish finance projects. Terms are 3 years and the preferred number of volunteers for the Finance Council is between 9 and 12.

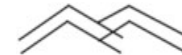

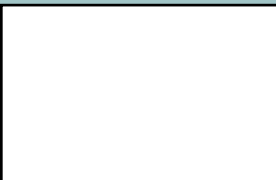
