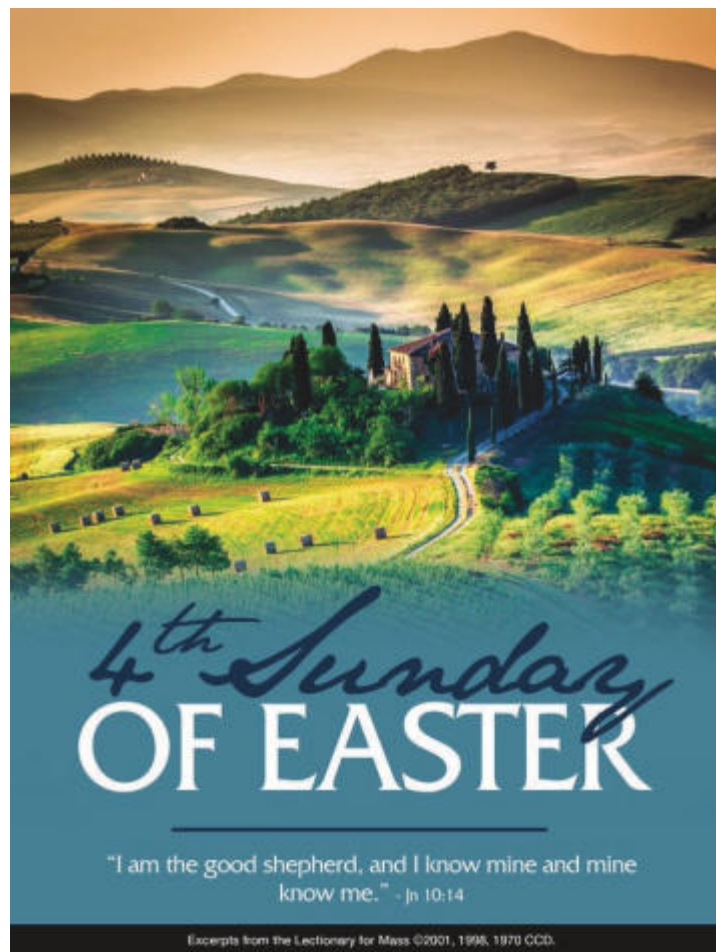

Dear Friends,

What a week we have had – in the country and in our city. In the midst of the Easter season, as we sing alleluias and songs of Christ's victory over sin and death, we experience terror, tragedy and the continuation of ideological polarization. We join our prayers with the people of Minneapolis and its surroundings as they mourn their losses and strive to heal from the horrible wounds suffered. We stand with the people of Indianapolis as they recover from a mass shooting in a distribution center there. And we unite with the people of the City of Chicago as we continue to unravel another police-involved shooting (hopefully without harsh judgement on any of the players).

As we do all this, we tell ourselves that this evil cannot be the victor. Christ wins. By virtue of his death and resurrection, which we celebrate with full enthusiasm these 50 days, Jesus carries us with him in his victory. Our shared baptism with Jesus makes us God's children. Saint John tells us that in today's second reading. "Beloved: See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God. Yet so we are." Over and over again we need to remind ourselves of this, especially during times of trial and tribulation. You are a child of God. I am a child of God. People we love and people we fail to love are children of God.

We, Jesus' flock, God's children, must truly listen to the message of God that comes to us from the Good Shepherd. He tells us clearly in today's brief Gospel passage, "I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep." Because of God's mercy and Jesus' obedience we are told that no matter, what we will never perish. It requires, though, that we listen to him. We cannot know him unless we listen to him.

How do you listen to him? Sometimes I think we spend so much time in our relationships, including our relationship with Jesus, *talking*. I was at a conference recently where the speaker reminded us that God had a purpose in creation. He created us with one mouth and two ears. They should be used proportionately. We live our lives often as if this were the opposite -- that we were created to talk twice as much as listen.

To share in the victory, we need to quiet ourselves and allow Jesus to speak to us and to lead us in the direction he wants us to go. Taking five to ten minutes a day in real silence allowing the Lord to speak to us will produce great fruit. In the silence of our hearts, he will reveal love and mercy, and will remind us that we are called to participate in the mission of the risen Lord.

If we listen, we will hear that he calls each of us to discipleship. Disciples participate in the mission of Jesus. The mission of Jesus is a life-giving mission that promotes peace and justice. If we listen and follow, we will never perish; no torment shall touch us. If we listen and we follow we will inherit eternal life.



Practically speaking, what will that mean for us today? Listening, discipleship, and promoting peace and justice requires humility, bravery, and conviction. When we realize that ours isn't the most important voice to be heard, that ours isn't the only opinion that matters, that ours isn't the only way, then we can truly quiet ourselves to hear his call.

In order to respond to the call, we must gather courage to say yes to the Shepherd's plan and let go of our own. And when we decide to truly follow the Shepherd, we must remain convicted that he is the victor who shares with us that great victory, and that everyone is a child of God. That conviction will sustain us in difficult times like the ones our country and city experienced this week.
