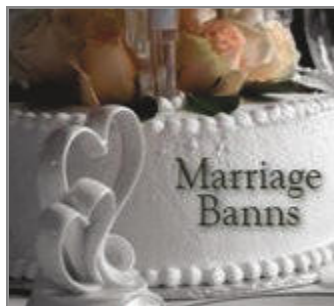

A PRIEST NEVER RETIRES

At the end of this month, I am supposed to retire. I don't think I will.

I have been a priest for 44 years. That's not my job; that's my vocation, the way Jesus wants me to get to Him. In a similar way, Jesus calls a woman and a man during the Sacrament of Marriage to approach Him together. Those folks cannot retire from their vocation as wife or husband. Furthermore, for those blessed that way, neither can they retire from being someone's mom or dad. That's not a job; it's a vocation. So is the priesthood. A priest cannot retire.

Still, Cardinal Cupich told me he accepts my retirement. Is he confused? I don't think so. The Cardinal is routinely recognizing that the time limits on the jobs within the years of my priesthood have expired. Since I was ordained into my vocation in 1977, I have held six different jobs given to me by the agents of my Holy Orders, the Archbishops of Chicago – Cardinals John Cody, Joseph Bernardin, Francis George, and Blase Cupich.

Six jobs were connected to my Holy Orders:

(1) Twice I was, like our newest priest Father Robert Ryan, an Associate Pastor – at half-city/half-suburban St. Eugene Church in Chicago on Foster Avenue, 1977-1978; and at lively St. Paul of the Cross parish in Park Ridge, 1990-1993.

(2) I was a high school seminary faculty member at Quigley North, 1978-1990 with specific assignments as Disciplinarian; teacher of Speech (and sometimes English, History and Religion); and baseball coach. (3) While teaching, I also did the parish ministry of a resident priest at the wonderful Our Lady of Victory Church in Chicago's Jefferson Park neighborhood. Sadly, OLV will close this month.

(4) At two different times, I was a dean, the organizational deputy for Vicar/bishops (Thad Jakubowski, Ed Conway, Frank Kane), 1995-2001 and again 2002-2010.

(5) Three times over 25.5 years I was pastor of a parish – St. Francis Borgia on Addison Street at the western brink of the city, 1993-2001; Holy Name Cathedral, the Archbishop's Church, and the downtown center stage, 2002-2016; and St. Joseph in Wilmette, 2016-2018.

(6) Since the beginning of 2019, I have worked as a Senior Priest, a title that acknowledged the mileage on the Roman Collar I have comfortably worn for over two-thirds of my life. Time is up on each of those six jobs. It is from those assignments that I will retire on June 30.

So, what will I do now? Where can you find me? Our pastor Father Wayne Watts has agreed to let me continue to occupy my apartment in the St. Joseph rectory and to be included on the Sacramental schedule that defines the

vocation of parish priesthood as I have lived it since I was 25 years old.

I will pray with Jesus's disciples in and around Wilmette at the altars, in the confessional, at the baptistry's shore, alongside the sick bed, arm's reach away from the new bride and groom, over the graves of the faithful departed, and atop the pulpit. My term limit at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier will depend mostly on my health.

I am just about 70 years old. Some really good medical pros with offices nearby expertly help manage the Type-I diabetes that has been my 50-year partner. Another new group of doctors is trying to re-focus the fuzzy eyesight that has rolled in during the last year limiting my driving ability. Then there is a group of north suburban neighbors, friends with whom I regularly meet so we can remind each other how cunning, baffling, and powerful our common illness was/is and remember how we need to admit that our condition, like everyone else's, is day-to-day. For the sake of my health, I am glad there is a spot for me in the neighborhood of Saints JFX.

Thanks to the kind folks on the Parish Council and the Women's Club who suggested a Mass celebrating my retirement and maybe as much of a party as the pandemic boogeyman would permit. Thanks even more to those same people for letting me decline such an exercise. This written article was my compromise to making my retirement public.

Now it is time for me to go back to doing some priest-work in our familiar section of the Lord's vineyard. When the calendar flips to July, don't be surprised that I will be doing the same thing in the same place. A priest never retires.
