Dear Friends,

He is risen! Alleluia! Seven days down, 43 to go! Hopefully, you are continuing to bask in the joy of Easter. I sure am.

Last weekend, as we celebrated the Holy Triduum, we experienced amazing crowds, despite pandemic protocols. For the Easter Masses alone, over 1,500 people joined us! That number astonishes me. I mentioned at Mass that the crowds are coming because we the people of Saints JFX are doing what Christ commands: we are announcing the Good News! I thank you for participating in the work of evangelization. Did you invite a friend? Did you encourage a family member to join you here? Did you pass along the schedule of services to a neighbor? If so, I thank you. The work of Evangelization belongs to all of us. The great things that happen here are a direct result of good and generous people investing in a community they call their own.

Speaking of investing in a community... Today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, describing the ideal Christian Community of the Early Church, urges me to say a word or two about stewardship, about sharing what we must to benefit the Church, the community, and the poor.

Saint Luke, in The Acts of the Apostles writes, *The community of believers was of one heart and mind, and no one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they had everything in common. There was no needy person among them, for those who owned property or houses would sell them, bring the proceeds of the sale, and put them at the feet of the apostles, and they were distributed to each according to need.*

I hope we can learn from the example of the early Church and that those of us who are "holding back" will be inspired to give a little more. I'm not asking you to sell your homes; I'm asking you to consider your gift. Many of us have considered our gifts and are giving in amazingly generous ways. You know who you are, and I thank you for being good stewards. To the others a simple plea, think about budgeting an increase in your giving, and consider electronic giving through www.givecentral.org.

Today we mark Divine Mercy Sunday. We received the message of Divine Mercy from a 20th Century Polish Sister, and instructions on the practice of Divine Mercy from a 20th Century Albanian Missionary Sister. Like the women at the tomb who told the good news of the resurrection of Jesus, Sister Faustina did the same in her life and invited us to know God's love and mercy, to live God's love and mercy and to proclaim God's love and mercy to all we meet.



Sister Faustina had visions of Jesus, who spoke with her and encouraged her to invite others to trust in his love and mercy. Her messages written in her diary have touched many hearts and changed many lives. A few years before her death, Jesus appeared to Sister Faustina and invited her to paint a picture of the Divine Mercy. In her diary, she wrote, *"In the evening, when I was in my cell, I became aware of the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand was raised in blessing; the other was touching the garment at the breast. From the opening of the garment at the breast there came forth two large rays, one red and the other pale. In silence I gazed intently at the Lord; my soul was overwhelmed with fear, but also with great joy. After a while Jesus said to me, 'paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the inscription: Jesus, I trust in You.'"*

Sister Faustina painted the image. Those messages strongly influenced the Popes we remember: John Paul II, Benedict, and even Francis. When St. Pope John Paul canonized Sr. Faustina on April 30, 2000, he also, on the same day, surprised the entire world by establishing Divine Mercy Sunday (the feast day associated with the message) as a feast day for the entire Church. The feast day falls on the Second Sunday of the Easter season. Her influence on Pope Francis so motivated him that on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday of 2015, he promulgated the Bull of Indiction (a proclamation) announcing the Year of Mercy. Six months later, when he celebrated Mass in Cuba, in the sanctuary, the image of Jesus of Mercy could be seen, along with the words, "Jesus I trust in you."

As the message penetrated the hearts of the popes, allow it to penetrate yours. Trust in Jesus, in his power over sin and death, above all in his mercy. Let us humbly approach God, as Saint Faustina invites us, and say, *"For the sake of his sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world."*
