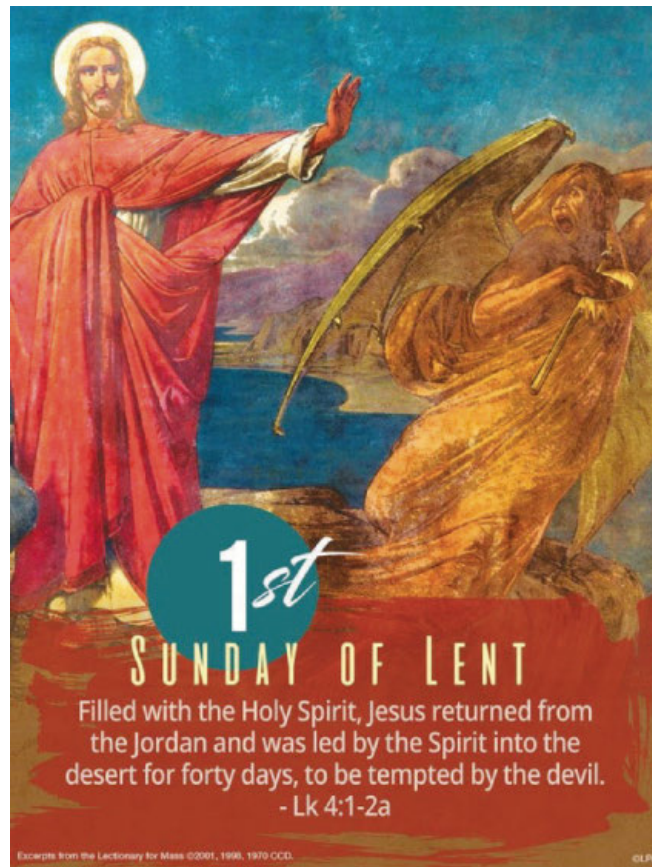

Dear Friends,

Worthy conduct. In the collect of today's Mass, the part of the Mass we used to call the "Opening Prayer," we implore our God to help us in our yearly observance of Lent to grow in understanding of the riches hidden in Christ and to pursue the effects of those riches by "worthy conduct." When you hear those words together in a context of your Catholic Christian faith, what comes to mind? When I hear "worthy conduct," I immediately go to the words we say before communion, "Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed."

Pursuing Christ's riches is not always easy and doesn't come without its share of temptations to take another easier route, one that serves the self rather than our Lord. So, we pray for worthy conduct. To me, the following words describe conduct that is worthy: Christ-centered, generous, kind, selfless, courageous, trusting, other-centered, faithful, and full of hope.

As *Church* (yes, that means you... and me), we begin a holy season. Wednesday we were told to pray, fast, and give alms. During this holy season let's pursue with worthy conduct the riches of Christ... And pray with all our power that the Holy Spirit continue to guide his holy Church.

Worthy conduct requires doing good. Pope Francis last week published his annual message for Lent. In it, he reminded us that, "*Lent is a favorable time for personal and community renewal, as it leads us to the paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. For our Lenten journey in 2022, we will do well to reflect on Saint Paul's exhortation to the Galatians: "Let us not grow tired of doing good, for in due time we shall reap our harvest, if we do not give up. So then, while we have the opportunity, let us do good to all" (Gal 6:9-10).*

The Pope writes, "*Let us not grow tired of praying. Jesus taught us to "pray always without becoming weary" (Lk 18:1) We need to pray because we need God."*

At Saints JFX, as we strive to make this Lent holy, especially through increasing our life of prayer, allow me to invite you to come to daily Mass at 6:30 am at SFX or at 8:30 am at Saint Joe's. It is a great way to start the day. I began my commitment to daily reception of the Eucharist during Lent as a middle school student. It changed my life

forever. Every Tuesday, after the 8:30 am Mass at Saint Joseph, we have a holy hour of Eucharistic adoration and benediction. On the evenings of the Fridays of Lent, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 7:30 pm at Saint Joseph Church. Please join us.



The Pope writes, "*Let us not grow tired of uprooting evil from our lives. May the corporal fasting to which Lent calls us fortify our spirit for the battle against sin. Let us not grow tired of asking for forgiveness in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, knowing that God never tires of forgiving."*

At Saints JFX, this Lent, we will have seven opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We will also provide opportunities for the children in our Youth Faith Formation and Parish School programs to avail themselves to the Mercy of God in the Sacrament.

The Pope writes, "*Let us not grow tired of doing good in active charity towards our neighbors. During this Lent, may we practice almsgiving by giving joyfully (cf. 2 Cor 9:7). God who "supplies seed to the sower and bread for food" (2 Cor 9:10) enables each of us not only to have food to eat, but also to be generous in doing good to others."*

At Saints JFX, this Lent, we will find ways for all members of our parish, young and old, to roll up their sleeves and live the Gospel call to charity. Our Saint Vincent DePaul conference continues to do great work. We will also, throughout this season, have an opportunity to contribute to our almsgiving efforts through a Give Central link on our website and our thrice weekly eblasts.

Let's make this Lent special. Let's pursue Christ's riches with worthy conduct. Let's not grow tired, with the Holy Father and the Holy Spirit to guide us.

From the Loft

This Sunday, the choir will sing at the 10:30 Mass at St. Joseph. At the offertory, they will sing the traditional "God So Loved the World" as they have done for the past many years during the first week of Lent. This will be very familiar to most of you.

Note that the Gloria is not sung during Lent, and at the Gospel acclamation, we sing "Praise and Glory to You" rather than singing "Alleluia". This is in keeping with the Lenten tradition as a time of preparation...our music is more meditative as we anticipate the joyful season of Easter and the resurrection, still 5 weeks away.

Finally, please mark your calendar: The Interfaith Prayer Service, originally scheduled for January, has been rescheduled for Monday, March 28th at 7:00 pm. The location will still be at St. Joseph, and is a part of the Wilmette Sesquicentennial celebration.

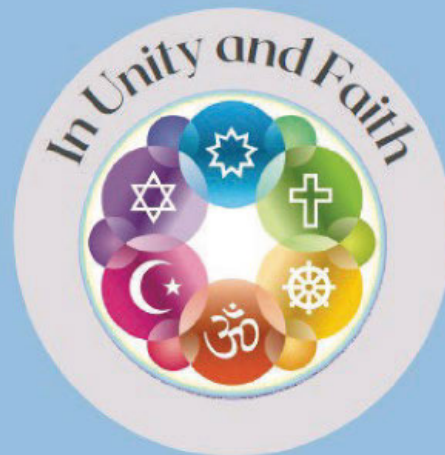
