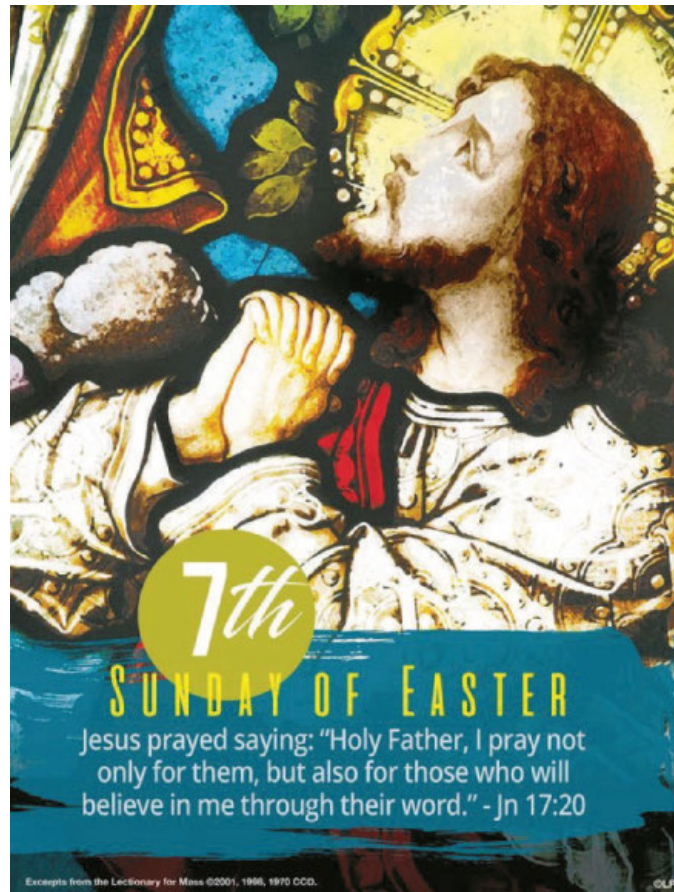

REMEMBER AND HONOR

Dear Friends,

As I read today's readings and Gospel, a few things strike me: the name of the person to whom Saint Luke writes in the Acts of the Apostles, the prayer Paul has for the people of Ephesus, and the reaction of the disciples after the ascension of our Lord. First, the recipient of the Luke's word in the Acts of the Apostles is Theophilus, lover of God! As we hear these words, we must ask ourselves, "Am I a Theophilus? Do I love God? How do I show it?" Paul prays that the people of Ephesus, and all who hear his word, receive a spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in a knowledge of God. That's my prayer for us too. Lastly, the disciples returned to Jerusalem with great joy and constantly were praising God. As we commit to the New Evangelization, those disciples can be our inspiration. Their joy and worship attracted. So will ours.

On Tuesday, the teachers at our parish school were the "leaders" of our weekly school Mass. Each Tuesday, a different grade or class leads. Tuesday it was the teachers' turn. We celebrated a beautiful Mass. James Cahill, our middle school history teacher, led the students in song, Jonathan Metzinger accompanied him beautifully on the piano. The eighth graders beamed with excitement, maybe still left over from their recent trip to Washington, DC, maybe in anticipation of their end of year activities and this Friday's upcoming graduation. Our second graders sat right up close, so that they could be among the first to receive Holy Communion, still novel and exciting for them. We were living the great joy and continual praise described in today's conclusion of Saint Luke's Gospel.

About forty minutes after we ended our Mass, joyfully singing the recessional hymn, 1,342 miles south of where we happily celebrated Mass, in Uvalde, Texas, an 18 year-old gunman entered a school and mercilessly killed 21 people; nineteen innocent children and two of their teachers. As I reflect on the juxtaposition of those two events, both sorrow and gratitude fill my heart. I cannot get over the number of horrific attacks on young people by young people with guns. I have no desire to make anything political about these events in this column, but with my whole heart I believe that we as Christians must work for an end to gun violence. We must work for justice and work for peace. Every day at Mass, I pray for an end to gun violence. I guess I must pray harder – and maybe do something more. WE must pray harder. WE must do more.

On Wednesday, our own dedicated teachers received this message from our incredibly grace filled, and faith filled principal, Christine Elliott. As I read her short note, I thanked God for the blessings of this great faith community we call Saints JFX.

Good morning,

I know that many of us went to bed last night with heavy and broken hearts. The loss of 19 children and 2 adults is tragic and mind boggling. The idea that any child or adult in a school setting could fear for their safety is just plain wrong. The array of emotions we are all experiencing is vast and real due to another senseless act of violence.

So today we will listen, pray, lead with empathy and reassurance, and guide. There is no good way to answer the question of "why did this happen?". Some of our children will be scared, others confused, and some will have very little knowledge about what happened.

You are the best of the best, and I do not say that lightly. We will wrap our children in love and reassure them that they are safe. We will hold each other up. We will pray and advocate for peace and change. If you need anything AT ALL, please don't hesitate to reach out to any of us.

On this Ascension Day we can renew our own commitment to evangelization, we can remember that Jesus has sent us the Holy Spirit to guide us and inspire us. So, let's commit to spreading the Good News, to work for peace, to listen, pray, lead with empathy and reassurance and guide.

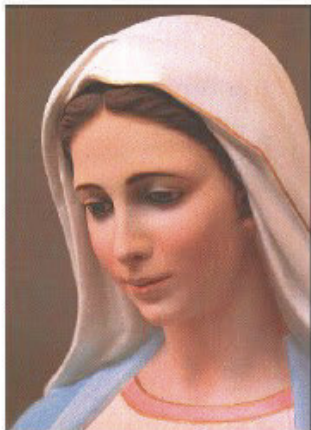
