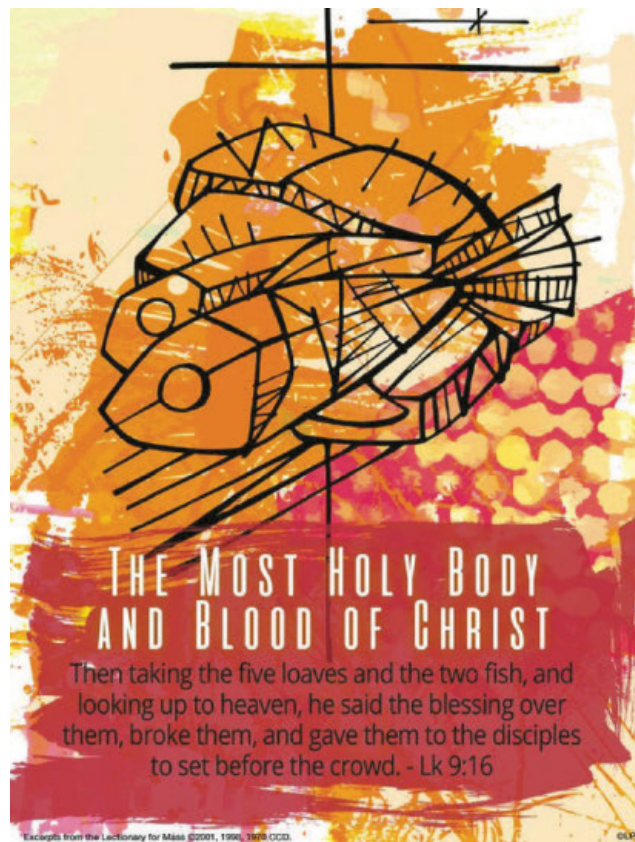

Dear Friends,

We're surrounded by angels and saints!

First it was the small window of the angel that caught my eye (the third window to the right above the altar). Or perhaps the angel caught my eye! The window depicts Archangel Raphael, leading Tobias, son of Tobit on the road to Media. (It's a great story). With further gazing, I realize all the small windows show the Archangels at work. On Raphael's right is Uriel, with the Book of Wisdom. To the far left is Archangel Michael battling a dragon (Satan), and then Gabriel announcing the news to Mary of Nazareth. It tough not to stare at them; especially when the light is bursting through. They offer me comfort, a sense of protection, guidance, and a desire to trust. They are the Archangels after all! The windows offer something beautiful for us to contemplate and learn from.

The four larger than life figures in stained glass above the small windows are also images of the four Archangels: Michael with his sword, Gabriel with his trumpet, Raphael with his staff and Uriel carrying the Book of Wisdom. They gaze back at me. Art does capture us. Why did it take me so long to identify these characters?

The four statues beneath the windows are Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. All carry scrolls and/or a writing instrument. Above their heads, small mosaics reveal their symbols: man, lion, ox, and eagle, respectively. These symbols of the evangelists are taken from the first chapter of Ezekiel. (I confess, I would have missed the mosaics if I had not been exploring the sanctuary with Fr. Harnett!) The statues are beautifully illuminated with lights behind them, as the gospels illuminate our lives. The evangelists are surrounded by six exquisite marble angels.

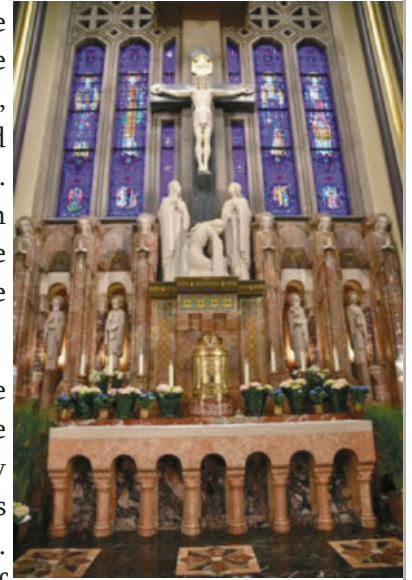
On the left and right side of the sanctuary are the white statues of Peter, holding the keys, and Paul with a sword. Closer to us is Mary, on the left, and Jesus, the Sacred Heart to the right.

And these are just some high points of the sanctuary! Did you know there are 114 angels scattered around St. Joseph Church? Both of

our parish churches are filled with rich with artistic representations to teach, remind and inspire us about the treasures of Christianity.

We are surrounded with images that share our faith history. We just need to notice, and let it sink in; together, we are the Communion of Saints. All of the people who have prayed and received sacraments here; those blessed with the incense of our funeral rite are present as well. This strikes me as being one of the most beautiful teachings of our faith. It is our ancestry in our midst, joined with our presence right now and touching the future with faith that is fully alive and full of hope. We gather with Jesus, on the cross, the center, core and commonality of our belief, and his Blessed Mother, the beloved disciple and Mary Magdalene and all the angels and saints and you my sisters and brothers in this holy sanctuary. All for the glory of God.

Illinois' bipartisan Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program provides need-based scholarships for students to attend K-12 private schools, like our sharing parish partner St. Thomas of Canterbury. Donors who give through our scholarship granting partner Empower Illinois in support of these scholarships receive a 75% state income tax credit on their gift and can direct their donation to St. Thomas of Canterbury.

And there has never been a better time to take advantage of the Tax Credit Scholarship Program.

A generous group of parishioners have pledged gifts for a Cornerstone Match to help clear the waitlist of students eligible for tax credit scholarships at St. Thomas of Canterbury School. Gifts made to St. Thomas of Canterbury through the Share Our Gifts campaign will be matched \$1 for \$1 to clear the waitlist of students, which means that **for every dollar you donate an additional dollar will be donated to St. Thomas of Canterbury, our Sharing Parish School.** But we must act fast! 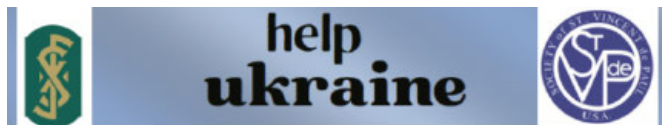
