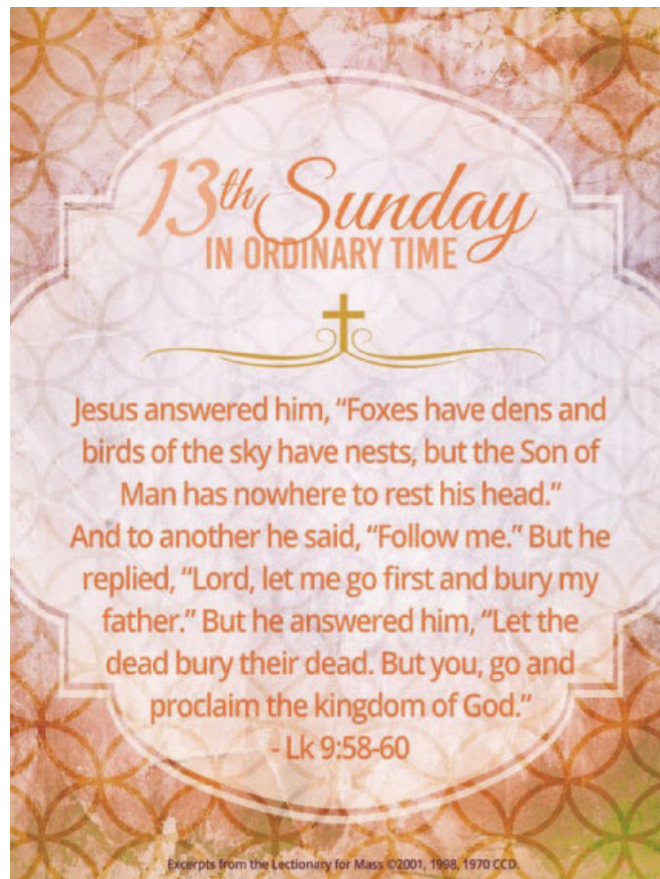

Dear Friends,

Two powerful words in today's Gospel strike me. "Follow me." Jesus uses this command, or invitation, thirteen times in the Gospels. As we hear the words today, in the midst of all that is happening in our Church and in our world, it is wise to heed those words and when we do, we can produce great fruit.

When you hear those words, what does the hearing evoke in you? A guide invites us to follow. When we are lost and seek directions, a kind fellow traveler urges us with those words. When someone wants to lead us to something great and perhaps unimaginable, that person uses those words to entice us and summon us.

We are much more likely to follow one whom we know and trust. The destination must hold for us promise and excitement. We need to be willing to sacrifice radical independence and individualism so that the other may lead us. Following requires humility and cooperation. It demands a belief that we are on the road together. It requires trust.

Our God desires closeness. Throughout salvation history, God reminds us, through the law and the prophets, that we are God's people, and He is our God. When humankind fails, God remains steadfast. When we make false gods, God waits and watches for us.

So often, though, we can be like those invited to follow in this week's Gospel. How often do we make excuses when asked to participate in something important? Recently, I asked someone to participate in an important ministry of our parish. Before I got half the sentence out of my mouth, I could see her face distorting and her head shaking. The excuses flowed out. The answer was "no." I accepted the "no" and we continued to other conversations.

The very next day I received a call from the same person. She had reflected on the ask and decided to change her mind. It took her a bit, but she must have realized the importance of participating in the life and ministry of Jesus' Church. Maybe she heard his voice that night as he said, "Follow me."

Missionary discipleship demands our "yes" to God's call, to following Jesus. In order that the crucial mission of the Church continues, we need more people to engage, to participate, and to rid ourselves of the excuses human nature reveals to us that get in the way of our "yes."

In his book *Rebuilt*, Father Michael White talks about this tendency in parish life. He describes his experience of moving his parishioners from *consumers* to *missionary disciples*. He invited the faithful in his community to

realize that the parish was indeed the responsibility of all the parishioners and wanted them to know that they were not simply customers, but fellow disciples on the journey, answering Jesus' call to follow.



I often tell my wedding couples that the Church, and particularly Saints JFX, isn't just like a gas station, where we pull in, get what we need, and take off. We are pilgrims on a journey, walking together in a spirit of synodality. We are in this together, each invited in his or her own way to answer the invitation to follow Jesus. When we answer the call, we grow close to the Lord who wants us close. We then, can enthusiastically invite others to join us. Evangelization, then, becomes the work of the entire parish.

At Saints JFX, the Stewardship Committee is answering that call - and inviting others to join. Some major initiatives are the revival of the Welcome Committee, the creation of parish "areas" (where we divide the parish into smaller sections to create more intimate gathering groups), and the solicitation of area leaders and party hosts. As we enter the new academic year, with a focus on engagement, we will be looking at reestablishing the Men's Club and focusing on Women's Club membership.

Solidly engaged with one another, building a strong community, walking together on the road, we can collectively say "yes!" when Jesus says, "Follow me."

Share Our Gifts with Tax Credit Scholarships

Illinois' bipartisan Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program provides need-based scholarships for students to attend K-12 private schools, like our sharing parish partner St. Thomas of Canterbury. Donors who give through our scholarship granting partner Empower Illinois in support of these scholarships receive a 75% state income tax credit on their gift and can direct their donation to St. Thomas of Canterbury.

And there has never been a better time to take advantage of the Tax Credit Scholarship Program.

A generous group of parishioners have pledged gifts for a Cornerstone Match to help clear the waitlist of students eligible for tax credit scholarships at St. Thomas of Canterbury School. Gifts made to St. Thomas of Canterbury through the Share Our Gifts campaign will be matched \$1 for \$1 to clear the waitlist of students, which means that **for every dollar you donate an additional dollar will be donated to St. Thomas of Canterbury, our Sharing Parish School.** But we must act fast! 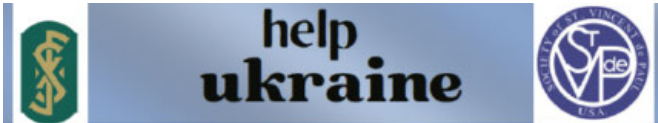

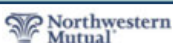
