Dear Friends,

Today's scriptures tell us to leave selfishness aside and let humility, gratitude, and pure charity move us. Pope Emeritus Benedict's first major papal writing, *Deus Caritas Est*, or *God is Love*, continues that theme of giving ourselves out of love for God. Where charity is, we are told over and over, God is! As we gather this weekend to worship the Lord, let's pledge to make God visible through our charity this week, month, and year, especially to the most marginalized, lonely, and forgotten of our world.

We can make God visible through our acts of charity in this parish and beyond. We are doing that at Saints JFX, as we work to provide tax credit scholarships to the students (here and) at Saint Thomas of Canterbury. The need in our school has been met by generous donors who gave early in the year to cover Saints JFX's need for the 2022-23 school year. We turned our eyes to Saint Thomas of Canterbury in June, becoming aware of their great need.

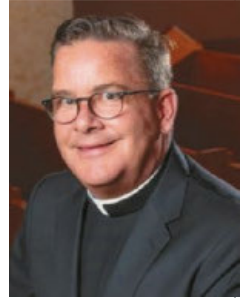
***This is where we stand  
with the Sharing our Gifts Campaign.***

Our original goal was to raise \$600,000 to cover the students on the waitlist at Saint Thomas. We raised a match pool of \$300,000 during the month of June. Over the course of the summer, parishioners donated another \$250,000.

Principal Christine Boyd has since informed us of an additional \$200,000 in financial need as the student enrollment increased at STC, every new student being eligible for aid. Our new goal is \$800,000.

With \$250,000 remaining to meet the new \$800,000 goal, to incentivize us to meet the need, a generous couple from Saints JFX pledged an additional \$100k as an increase to our match pool to get us there. This leaves \$150,000, or 50 parishioners donating \$3,000 in tax credit dollars per parishioner (for a net cost of \$750), to deliver a full year's tuition for a student. **You can start the process by contacting Katie Taylor at [katie@empowerillinois.org](mailto:katie@empowerillinois.org).** How great would it be for us to ensure that every child at STC could get a Catholic education using the amazing Tax Credit program! It's the best bang for your buck in philanthropic support.

Jesus, in today's Gospel, urges us to look in the mirror and see what we see. The things Jesus said, and the way Jesus lived made people of his day uncomfortable. One book I read referred to his manner of life as the "upside down values of the Lord." As he walked the streets and taught in the towns of Judah, Jesus turned long-standing values and norms on their heads. He gave a new commandment. He showed a new way to live. Scholars call this Jesus' preferential option for the poor.



That option hasn't changed throughout salvation history. Centuries before Jesus walked the earth and welcomed the poor and the marginalized in his midst, the psalmist wrote, "God, in your goodness you have made a home for the poor." God does have a home for the poor. Jesus' own mother said the same in her Magnificat as she entered the house of Elizabeth. Mary said, "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord... You have cast down the mighty from their thrones and have lifted up the lowly... You have filled the hungry with good things and the rich you have sent away empty." Jesus learned from the scriptures and from his mother the importance of serving the poor. He challenges us to do the same.

When we recognize, in a spirit of humility (which the Gospel calls us to today), that all that we have and all that we are comes from God, we owe God a debt of gratitude. Out of that same gratitude, we must share what we have with those who cannot repay us.
