





A Tri-Parish Event:

Saints Joseph & Francis Xavier, Saints Faith, Hope and Charity and Divine Mercy Parishes Each October, all parishes in the Archdiocese of Chicago are asked to take a physical count of the number of people attending each weekend Mass (commonly referred to as "October Count"). The count is one factor that the Archdiocese considers in planning for the year ahead; it's one factor that we use at the parish level as well.

The most recent pre-pandemic official count done was in October 2019. No count was taken in 2020 due to attendance limitations. We were very thankful to be able to lift Mass attendance restrictions in June 2021 and be able to once again take part in the October Count. We are very happy to report that our attendance numbers have increased by approximately 35% per weekend since 2021.

Average attendance numbers at our weekend Masses in October 2022 are as follows:

8:00am: 122
9:30am: 244
10:30am: 220
11:30am: 123



In addition, our recently added 4:45pm Sunday Mass is off to a strong start, with average attendance of 243.

Transforming a Roof Into a Home

The formerly homeless "Millers" had recently been provided with a roof over their heads in Wilmette's subsidized housing, but that was it. They had no furniture except an ancient mattress on the floor, and no income to buy food or prescriptions because of a delay in accessing their social security benefits. Without a car, they couldn't get to the physician Mrs. Miller needed to see for her disability.

The Millers called the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, St. Francis Xavier/St. Joseph Conference's hotline and asked for help with Uber gift cards to go to the doctor and the local food pantry. When our representatives delivered the Uber cards and observed the living conditions of this couple, we recognized that far more was needed.

We obtained a second-hand couch, dresser and lamp that were not being used in the Saints JFX parish office and arranged for delivery. Next, we negotiated with a local mattress store and purchased a mattress, box spring and bedding. The next time we visited the Millers, the roof over their heads had been transformed into a home and they had applied to their congresswoman's Constituent Advocate Office to obtain their benefits.


