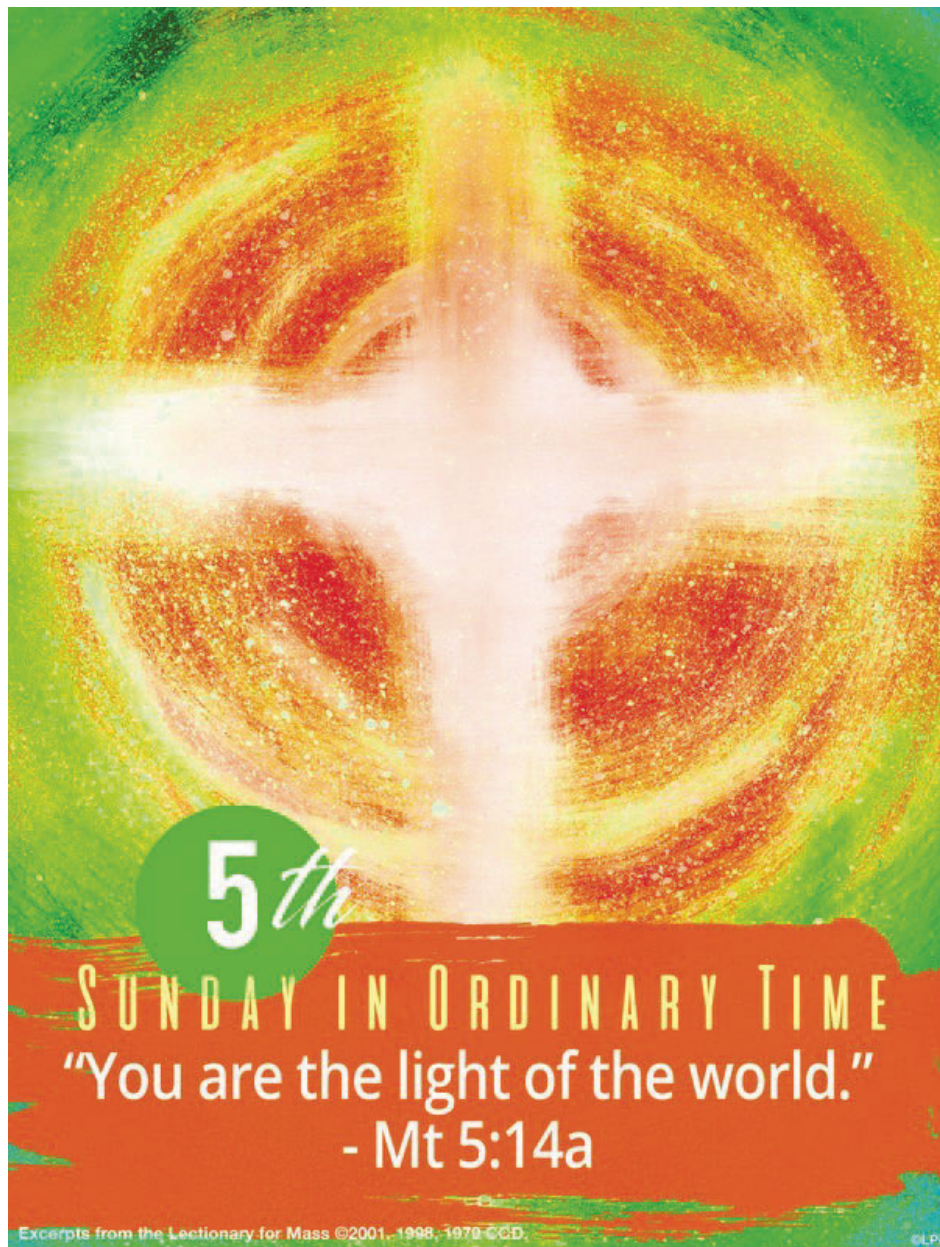

Dear Friends,

Wow! God is so good! I say that because of the beautiful Scriptures that spur us to action, and because of the many ways the people of Saints JFX respond to that urging. Isaiah proclaims that when we live mercy, light can come out of the darkness. The Psalmist reminds us that the just one is a light in darkness to the upright. Paul tells us to know and love Christ so that the power of God can be at work in us. And Jesus, telling us that we are the light of the world, commands us to let our light shine before all.

I write this missive in the middle of Catholic Schools Week. As a product of 21 years of Catholic education and as a child of a Catholic school teacher (my eighth-grade teacher) I thank God for the dedication of all the stakeholders in our Catholic school. I thank God for all who support Catholic education, especially you, Saints JFX parishioners, who support the school through your offertory collections. We have over 700 students across both campuses of Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier School. We have something special here.

I credit the Catholic educators who have sacrificed much to teach in our school (and in all Catholic Schools) and to share their faith. They let the light of their faith and love shine on our students. They season our school with the salt of goodness. I am especially indebted to the one who leads our school, and who will lead us during the 2023-2024 school year.

Christine Elliott shares her light. You may remember that we engaged a search committee a few years ago to find someone to lead our school. After the long search, my prayer was answered. At the beginning of the search, I encouraged Christine Elliott to throw her hat into the ring. Eventually, Christine said she would join the process and the search committee welcomed her addition with great acclamation. The committee unanimously recommended to the school board and me that Christine be hired to lead our school. And hired she was!

Christine, with her expansive experience in Catholic education, told us a couple of years ago, in the midst of a global pandemic, "I want to emerge from the pandemic and lead the school with peace and grace." Shining the light of Christ and leading with peace and grace, Christine has led our school to the great spot in which we find ourselves. With grace and peace, we do what we do, knowing each child by name and calling each to follow Christ. So, as we end Catholic Schools Week, I

hail and acclaim our interim principal, who has agreed to lead us for another year, Christine Elliott!

Isaiah commands, "Share your bread with the hungry; shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own. Then your light shall break forth like the dawn..." At Saints JFX, we respond to Isaiah's call. Our parish mission statement reminds us, "*We honor the traditions of our parish and welcome all to unite in prayer and the Sacraments. Loved by God and guided by the Holy Spirit, we share the good news of Jesus Christ through joyful worship, faithful formation, and dedicated service.*" I'm grateful that these words ring true - here and now. We welcome all; we unite; we share and serve.

Yes! God is good! He gives us these comforting and challenging words of Sacred Scripture to embolden us on the important mission of the Christian. Allow these words to pierce your heart. Hear them. Reflect on them. Own them. Make them yours. Do the corporal works Isaiah prescribes. Shine the light of your love on all people all the time. And let this church proclaim, from floor to rafter, that all are welcome in this place! When we do that, light will shine on this darkness. God's goodness prevails – always!

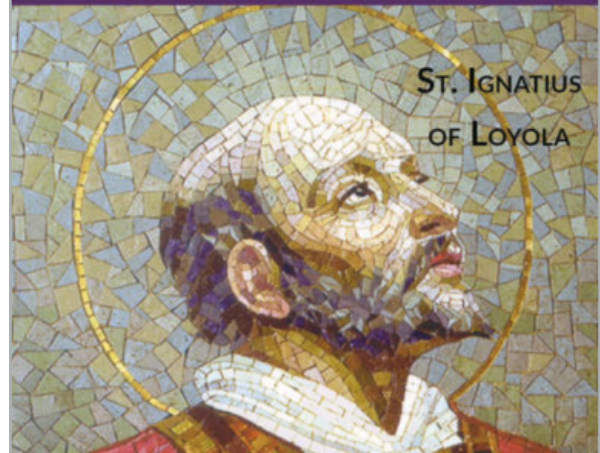
